#### Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

#### CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

**No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.**

Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the Bred by Exhibitors class winners following the judging of Best of Breed & Award of Merit competition. Only dogs not defeated in Bred by Exhibitor classes are eligible to compete.

\*Chapter 11 Section 8 "Rules applying to Dog Shows provide that a neutered male or spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran".

### **PARADE OF VETERANS (National only)**

There will be a Parade of Veterans. A brief description of the dog's history, which could include show or performance career accomplishments, and / or influential dogs in their pedigree, for example, will be announced as the veteran enters the ring. Each veteran entered in the parade will be awarded a rosette with the dog's name printed on it. Parade entrants need not be entered in any competition. **Entry Fee - \$10.00.**

### **PARADE OF RESCUE (Regional only)**

There will be a Parade of Rescue. Each rescue entry should include a brief history of the dog which will be announced as the entrant enters the ring. Parade entrants need not be entered in any competition. **Entry Fee - \$15.00.**

### **NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (National only)**

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for the Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch classes will be for Stud Dogs or Brood Bitches and two of their get or produce. Stud Dogs or Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch class and must be shown in the ring with their get or produce. The owner of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the get or produce. The award is based upon the merits of the get or produce. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get/Produce must be entered in a regular class.

**Stud Dog Class:** For Dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show.

**Brood Bitch Class:** For Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches in this show.

**Brace Class:** For Two Cavalier King Charles Spaniel (a unit), irrespective of sex with at least one common owner. Dogs may enter another class or for Brace Class Only. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify (Brace Class) in the additional classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class specify (Brace Class Only) in the Dog Show Class section of the form.

## Monetary Awards

In the American Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, Inc. Futurity Stakes there will be 35 cash wins: The three (3) individuals (the Breeder, the Owner and the Owner of the Sire at the time of nomination) partaking of these awards for a total of 72 monetary awards, won by 32 different Cavalier King Charles Spaniels.

1. Twenty percent (20%) shall be deducted from the total nomination pool and entry fee purse to be used for "Futurity Stakes" expense. This will be known as the General Expense Fund. The fund shall be used to cover expenses incurred by the Futurity Stakes, i.e. judges, printing, mailing, etc. Since the administrative and judging expense will vary from year to year, an excess of funds in any given year shall be carried forward to use in future years for Futurity Stakes only. The remaining funds will be known as the total purse.
2. Twenty-five (25%) shall be deducted from the total purse and is to be awarded as follows: 15% to the Best in Futurity, 5% to the Best Senior and 5% to the Best Junior in Futurity. The 15% of the Best in Futurity shall be divided – 50% to the recorded breeder(s) of the winner, 50% to the recorded owner(s) of the winner. The 5% awarded to the Best Senior and Best Junior in Futurity is to be divided – 50% to the recorded breeder(s), 30% to the recorded owner(s) and 20% to the owner of the sire or owner of the semen at the time of mating, for each winner.
3. The remaining seventy-five (75%) of the total purse shall be divided according to the percentage of the total entry represented by the number of Cavaliers entered in each class. As an example: Total Futurity Stakes entry = 100, entry in 6-9 Months Bitches = 10; therefore  $10/100 = 10\%$ . As a result – 10% of the remaining purse is awarded in the 6-9 Months Bitch Class.
4. Rosettes shall be awarded for placements of First-Fourth in each class. Additionally, Rosettes shall be given to the Best in Futurity, Best Senior in Futurity and Best Junior in Futurity. The cost of each will be covered from the General Expense Fund or through sponsorship. Trophies may be given but the General Expense Fund will not be used for this purpose. Trophy solicitations for the Futurity Stakes shall be the responsibility of the Trophy Chairperson for each American Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club, Inc. National Specialty.
5. Monetary awards which are provided at the time of the National Specialty but are not claimed during that period shall be applied to the Total Futurity Stake for the following year.

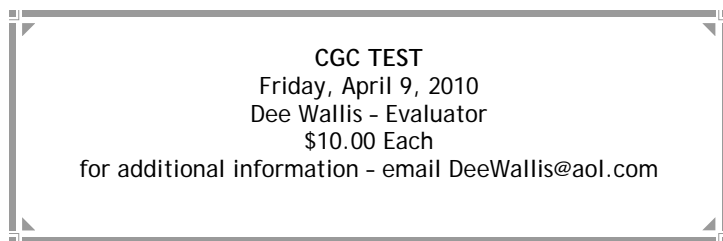

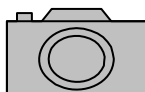
