Best of Breed Competition

Puppy Classes are Divided

The **Amateur-Owner-Handler** class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans Classes – Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years and over. **Veterans**

Note: If a dog is entered in both Veteran Class and Best of Breed and is defeated in Veterans, the dog can NOT be shown in Best of Breed. Entry fee \$30.00 as first entry and \$22.00 as additional entry. Veterans may be spayed or neutered.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY

PARADES – Please provide us with a short biography regarding your dog to be used as part of their introduction.

E-mail these biographies to: Hannah Kolzow at hkolzow@yahoo.com. Due Date is July 15, 2010. Be sure to tell us which parade(s) your dog is entered in and include the following information: Dog's Call Name, Age, Dog's Birthdate, AKC Reg. No., Dog's Registered Name, Owner(s), Breeder(s), Sire, Dam, & Brief Resume. For the Parade of Juniors, also include the name and age of the Junior Showmanship exhibitor.

Parade of Champions – This non-competitive class is open to all Havanese who are 6 months of age or older and who have obtained their AKC Championship Title prior to the entry closing date. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. Entry fee \$14.00

Parade of Obedience, Rally and Agility Titleholders – This non-competitive class is open to all Havanese who are 6 months of age or older and who currently hold Obedience, Rally and/or Agility Titles. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. Entry fee \$14.00

Parade of Juniors – This non-competitive class is open to all Havanese who are 6 months of age or older, who are currently shown in Junior Showmanship. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. Entry fee \$14.00

Parade of Therapy Dogs – This non-competitive class is open to all Havanese who are 6 months of age or older and who are certified Therapy Dogs. This class is designated in recognition of all Havanese currently involved in this important work. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. AKC registration or ILP number not necessary to enter. Entry fee \$14.00

Parade of Rescue and Companion Dogs – This non-competitive class is open to all Havanese who are 6 months of age or older and who have been rescued (through HCA or some other bona fide Rescue Program) or spayed/neutered companion animals. Each entrant will receive a Rosette. AKC registration or ILP number not necessary to enter. Entry fee \$14.00

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES – NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY

Stud Dog Class – Class for Stud Dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Entry only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Entry fee is \$30.00 if the Stud Dog is not entered in another class, or \$22.00 as an additional class. Notation must be made on entry form.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

Brace Class (two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner) – Will require a fee of \$30.00 for the Brace Class as a first entry (Unit) and \$22.00 as an additional entry (Unit). The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.
