JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

Awards of Merit will be awarded after Best of Breed judging is completed, to Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers in Best of Breed competition that exemplify the breed's characteristics. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed. The dogs selected for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are not eligible for an Award of Merit. At judges discretion, up to four (4) awards will be awarded in the Best of Breed competition, which shall include move-ups, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, first place in Veteran Dog Class, and Veteran Bitch Class.

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revised 09/02)

- All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Best Puppy in the Regular Puppy Classes

The First Place Winners from the individual Regular Puppy Classes (6-9 mos. And 9-12 mos.) will compete for the award of Best Puppy in the Regular Classes. Best Puppy competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes

The First Place Winners from the individual Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes will compete for the award of Best Bred-By-Exhibitor. Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

Best Veteran in the Veteran Classes

The First Place Winners from the Veteran Classes will compete for the award of Best Veteran. Best Veteran competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

Best Hunting Retriever in the Hunting Retriever Classes

The First Place Winners from the Hunting Retriever Classes will compete for the award of Best Hunting Retriever. Best Hunting Retriever competition will follow Best of Breed judging.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veterans 7-10 Class – Class for dogs and class for bitches seven (7) to ten (10) years of age or older.

Veterans 10 & Older Class— Class for dogs and class for bitches Ten (10) year of age and older.

Veterans Note: 1st place winners of Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in any other classes at this show. Ribbon prizes will be awarded for first through fourth place. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered.

Hunting Retriever Class— Class for dogs and class for bitches that have a Working Certificate (WC), Working Certificate Intermediate (WCI) or Working Certificate Excellent (WCX) from the NSDTRC (USA) or an AKC Junior Hunter title (JH), Senior Hunter title (SH) or Master Hunter title (MH). Winners of the above non-regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, will compete for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and a minimum of two (2); maximum of four (4) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Note – Chapter 11, Section 8, of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, provides that neutered dogs may be entered as the Stud Dog.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Full particulars for each dog entered must be given on individual Official AKC Entry Forms. Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. *Please identify which dogs are members of the brace on each entry form. If more than one brace designate "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice Junior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information; otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

NO REFUND FOR BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON

Beginner Novice Class. The Beginner Novice Class will be for dogs that have not won the BN title. Dogs entered in Beginner Novice A or Beginner Novice B may also be entered in any other obedience classes.

Veterans Class. The Veterans Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

Brace Class. The Brace Class will be for two dogs of the same breed that are eligible under these *Regulations* and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled (***the coupling device will not be less than 6 inches in overall length***). ***Whichever method is used will be continued throughout all exercises.*** A separate official entry form will be completed in full for each dog entered.

Please identify which dogs are members of the brace on each entry form. If more than one brace designate "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.

ALL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES INCLUDING PUPPY, VETERANS AND BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES HANDLER:

The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner:

- Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this or any other show in the previous two years.
- Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

Sweepstakes are open to Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever dogs and bitches that are at least 6 months old, but not more than 18 months old on the day of the show and are not champions of record. Entry shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class". Handler: The handler of a Puppy Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as defined by the AKC as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos, Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos,
Junior, 12 Mos & Under 18 Mos

Veteran Sweepstakes Class and age division must be indicated on the entry form. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes only or as an additional class. Handler: The handler of a Veteran Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as defined by the AKC as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

7 years & under 10 years
10 years & older

This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog.

BEST VETERAN PERPETUAL TROPHY

An etched crystal of a toller coming out of the water with a duck. The Hoch Memorial Trophy is offered by Dee Nichols (KD's Kennel) and Laura White (Cinnstar Kennels) in memory of Robert Hoch through the NSDTRC (USA). This trophy is offered on a three-time win basis, with permanent possession of the trophy going to any person/owner who wins the trophy three separate times, not necessarily with the same dog.

HIGH IN TRIAL PERPETUAL TROPHY

A silver cup trophy on a base. The Lonetree Kennel High in Trial Trophy is offered by Lonetree Kennels through the NSDTRC (USA). BREEDERS' CLASS Description

The Breeders' Class is an AKC "Special Attraction" to showcase successful breeders and offered only at Independent specialties. This class is unique in that the Breeder or Co-Breeder enters the class. The basis for the awards in this class is the consistent superior quality of the breeder's entry.

The entry is 3-4 dogs. The individual dogs comprising the entry must be from at least **two different combinations** of parents, must have one breeder in common, but do not need to be owned by the breeder. Each individual dog must have its own handler, but the breeder is not required to handle any of the dogs. Each dog must be entered in a regular class (includes BOB). The fee is submitted and paid for by the breeder to the club, **not** to the superintendent. The breeder **MUST** be present to accept the award.

- The unit consists of 3 - 4 Tollers. A breeder may enter as many unit combinations of 3 - 4 Tollers as desired (each costing \$40.00/unit to enter). Individual Tollers cannot be members of more than one unit.
- All members in the unit **MUST** be entered in another regular or non-regular class at this show. Any Toller in a unit who is not entered in another regular or non-regular class at the specialty will prevent the entire unit from being shown.
- The 3 - 4 Tollers comprising each unit entry **MUST HAVE ONE BREEDER/CO-BREEDER IN COMMON**. For example, Joan Smith enters the following unit of 4 dogs: Dog #1 bred by Joan Smith; dog #2 bred by Joan Smith and Tom Jones; Dog #3 and #4 bred by Harry Brown and Joan Smith.
- All members of the unit will be judged to the breed standard.
- Each member of the unit must have its own handler.
- The breeder must be present ringside to accept an award but is not required to handle any entrant.
- The unit must represent more than one litter and no more than two entrants shall have identical parentage.
- The breeder need not be the owner of any of the dogs.
- Unit entries must be made on their own form and sent directly to the club with payment or entered on-line with payment made at checkout.
