

Puppy Bred by Exhibitor Adult 6 months & under 9 months 9 months Open Twelve to Eighteen Months WINNERS Bred by Exhibitor Puppy

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

The above classifications are provided for all breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, (i.e. age, color, or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Veterans Class: 7 years of age and older. *Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying To Dog Shows" provide that a neutered male or a spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran. Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition.

Best Puppy

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos and under 9 mos and the 9 mos and under 12 mos. classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. **Example**: an entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-by-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of breed Competition judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example**: an entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Veteran

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the winners of the Veteran Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed competition judging unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: an entry from the Veteran Class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Veteran Class are eligible for Best Veteran Competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for the first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
