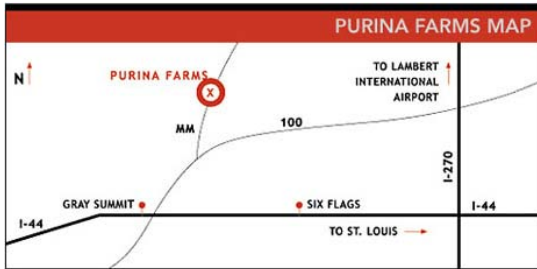

All agility, conformation, obedience and rally competitions will be in the Great Hall at the Purina Event Center. Herding will be outside at the Purina Herding & Trial field on Hwy MM which is accessible through the Purina front entrance. Food concessions, vendors, show office and show committee tables will be in or close to the Great Hall. All reserved grooming spaces, dog bathing, and handler changing rooms are in the adjacent Gateway Hall. The General Membership Meeting and the Judges Education Seminar will be in the Founder's Room on the second floor of the Great Hall.

•**Access** - Access to the Purina Farms property is available from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If the gate is closed outside of those hours, there is a button on the front gate that can be pushed, which contacts Security, who can then open the gate.
