Everyone is reminded that they are to be respectfully of the show grounds in cleaning up after their dog. Purina has "Poop" stations throughout the event areas for your convenience.

Food and beverages need to be purchased through the on-site food service and catering company. No outside food or beverages may be brought into the Purina Event Center.

No electric appliances, i.e. refrigerators, coffee makers, coolers, etc., are allowed in the show building. No such appliances are to be plugged in to any outlets in the show building.
