From the West—I-90 east toward Erie, PA. Take OH-306 North, Exit 193, toward Mentor. Take OH -2 East towards Painesville. OH-2 East becomes N Ridge Rd/US-20. Continue 5.7 miles on N Ridge Rd to McMackin Rd. Turn left onto McMackin Rd. In 1.7 mi. turn right onto Chapel Rd. Bill Stanton Community Park is on the left.

From the East—I-90 west toward Cleveland, OH. Take OH-528, exit 212 towards Madison. Turn right on River St/OH-528N. Follow OH-528 to Chapel Rd. (Rt. 528 becomes Hubbard Rd. upon crossing Rt. 20 intersection). Turn left on Chapel Rd., drive approximately 1.8 mi. Show site is on the right.

Grooming Area

Grooming space for Pembrokes will be under the Tent near the show ring. THERE WILL NOT BE POWER PROVIDED AND GENERATORS WILL BE PERMITTED. All generators will be required to be placed 6' outside of the grooming tent. The club will provide designated areas with protection around the area to protect generators from cars pulling in and out to unload. Bathing Stations will be located close to Grooming Tent. There is no potable water available.

Access to the show site and grooming tent: Access to the show location and grooming tent will be available at 3:00 pm. on August 23rd.

RV Parking

All campers & motor homes park in the designated camping area. Only self-contained units are allowed; no tents allowed for overnight stays.

There is NO electrical service. Be prepared to use onboard or external generators as needed. Access to the RV area will open at 1pm on Thursday, August 23rd for Pembroke exhibitors. The Sugarbush Kennel Club will limit parking to designated areas only.

All spaces are 25' by 50' and will be marked off to comply with Health Department regulations. No entry is permitted between 8:00 PM and 6:00 AM. All show and local parking regulations must be observed or vehicle will be towed at owner's expense.

There is no dump station on the grounds. No potable water available. No holding tank or gray water dumping permitted on the site. Pump-out service will be available on Sunday morning; the fee is \$40.00 (cash only). Sign up at the announcer's table by 4:00 pm Saturday.

There are a total of 70 spaces available for the weekend. Advance reservations are encouraged. Fee for the weekend is \$30.00 in advance or \$40.00 at the gate. No refunds after August 10, 2018. No daily camping rate. Please use reservation form or e-mail Sue Bell (dbell1@neo.rr.com) using RV in the subject line to obtain a space in the Pembroke reserved area.

General Show Information

THE PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI CLUB OF THE WESTERN RESERVE reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES under the grooming tent; crates must be stacked; Ex-pens allowed only outside the grooming tent.

POP-UP TENTS will be allowed in designated areas only.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO FLEXI LEADS, No Halti-type collars, or pinch collars on the show grounds.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Clubs and the Event Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up. **AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

THE PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI CLUB OF THE WESTERN RESERVE and the Superintendent/Event Secretary are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows.

The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committees will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS EVENT hereby waive any claim for damages against the Clubs, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

DOGS FOUND IN AN UNSAFE environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip) will be removed to safety by Club officials or security personnel. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be investigated by the Event Committee.

FOR THE WELL-BEING of all exhibitors & dogs, the Show Committee reserves the right to limit the use of generators in some areas.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show grounds at any time while the Show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audio tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

THE PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI CLUB OF THE WESTERN RESERVE and the Event Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors, handlers, and spectators, but will assume no responsibility for any personal injury or death to any person, or theft, damage or loss of personal property, nor injury or death of any animal either at or on the show grounds and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children at these events.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENRANTS AND SPECTATORS TO THESE EVENTS ENTER & ATTEND ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK. There shall be no offering for sale or breeding dogs.
