Judges' Education Seminar

Following the regular class bitch judging on Monday, June 21st, the BCCA will host a judge's education seminar, led by Nicole Conner. This seminar is a great opportunity for prospective Beardie judges as well as anyone who would like to learn the finer points of our breed standard, judging our wonderful breed, AND want to put your knowledge into practice through hands-on experience. Please come and join us, the fee is \$30, and includes a copy of the BCCA Illustrated Standard. There will also be Ringside mentoring by BCCA Mentors during class dog and bitch judging, as well as Best of Breed. The cost of the seminar is \$30 per person; register by May 5th on the Master Reservation Form available on the specialty website www.bcca2020.com.

Attention Exhibitors

The Show site will be available to exhibitors for set up on Friday, June 18th 2021 AFTER 3pm.

Dogs and all equipment must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed Judging on Tuesday, June 22, 2021.

PARKING

Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No Ex-Pens or Crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed on grass areas. No cones allowed in parking areas. No parking in roadways or next to building.

CRATING & GROOMING

Bathing of dogs is limited to the bathing area, located next to the grooming hall. No dogs are allowed in the bathrooms. Dogs may NOT be left in the building overnight. The Building will be locked at 10 pm and opened at 6 am. No cones are allowed inside the building. NO Ex-Pens allowed inside the building at any time. Please stack your crates and limit the number of tables. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

EXHIBITORS & GUESTS

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance." These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. There are no baby strollers allowed inside the building. No cones allowed inside building. No firearms allowed on Purina Property. No outside food or beverage allowed in the Purina Farms Event Center. Violators may be subject to a Bench Show Committee.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed. Trophies not claimed will become the property of the show-giving club.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

The Bearded Collie Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

BCCA STANDING RULE 8.1.7: Discipline at Show and Hotel Premises. *Anyone who allows a dog to urinate or defecate in the halls of the hotel or in any public or private areas, including their room, or anywhere on the grounds not designated for relief and not cleaning it up will be fined the sum of \$25, made payable to the BCCA by cash or check. If the same person is reported for a second offense, they will be asked to leave the hotel or grounds. The person observing the offense shall report it to the bench committee, which has the power to act. (This applies to the RV Parking lot as well.).*

Hotel & Accommodations

Except for Herding, all of the events for the 2020 National Specialty will be held at Purina Farms. The Wildwood Hotel is our host hotel, but you may choose from among the reasonably-priced hotels nearby.

- BCCA Discount rates - Standard Room - 2 Queen beds at \$115 +tax; 1 King bed at \$125 +tax. Note: These rates are good until May 12, 2021 which is the last day to book at this rate. BCCA guests must call the Wildwood Hotel and ask to be registered under the 2020 BCCA National Specialty room block. The BCCA Discount rate is not applied if you book online. These rooms allow a maximum of 4 dogs/room. There is a one-time, non-refundable fee of \$30 for 1-2 pets and \$60 for 3-4 pets. Check-in time 3:00 p.m. and checkout time 11:00 a.m.
- Amenities: Experience a charming retreat only 30 minutes west of St. Louis at the boutique Wildwood Hotel. PARKING

The Purina Event Center RV parking has four rows with a total of 74 full service hook-ups including 50 amp electric, water and sewer. There is a building next to the RV parking called the "Service Center" that has showers and bathroom facilities along with dog bathing tubs that is open 24 hours a day.

RV parking is available 6/16 - 6/22 in the Overflow lot at \$35 per day, no sewer or water.

RV parking is available in the Purina Event Center lot 6/16 - 6/22 at \$45 per day. All campers must depart by 6 PM 6/23.

All campers must depart by 9:00 AM Wednesday 6/23. Reservations are required for all RV sites and no refunds after 6/1/2021.

RV Rentals from local Purina Farms approved RV rental companies will be placed in Rows C or D depending on length.

Rentals must have in writing that the rental company will pick up the RV before 6 PM 6/23 or the last pre-paid, pre-reserved date or the RV will not be allowed on the property.

Two non-commercial vehicles are permitted to park per camping space in the upper full lot which includes two cars or one (tow) vehicle and one additional vehicle. All additional vehicles must park in the general parking lot.

RV site numbers will be assigned two weeks prior to the reservation.

Upper Full hook-up lot has 20/30/50 AMP electric, water and sewer. Overflow lot has 20/30/50 AMP electric and NO SEWER OR WATER. Sites will be assigned based on size and first come basis. You will receive confirmation via email of receipt for reservation deposit.

RV Policy

The RV area will be considered part of the official show site and exhibitors staying there will be expected to conduct themselves as good sportsmen at all times and keep the grounds clean of dog waste. If complaints are received, violators may be subject to disciplinary action by the show committee. Campers must also adhere to all "Purina Farms Overnight Camping Guidelines". Any issues with rental RV's should be addressed with the RV rental company and are not the responsibility of 2020 BCCA Specialty or Purina Farms.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
