## BUILDING TIMES AND SET-UP

### NOTE: BUILDING HOURS

The Mississippi Horse Park arena will be unlocked/available for exhibitors Friday 11 :00 am until 8:00 pm, Saturday-7:00 am until 8:00 pm & on Sunday 7:00 am until 7:00 pm.

### GROOMING

On Friday, the Reserved and Open grooming areas will be available for set-up beginning at 12:00 noon NO EXCEPTIONS! PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE WHEN SETTING UP AS OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS WILL BEGIN AT 1 :00 PM FRIDAY.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS AND ABIDE BY THESE TIMES! STACK CRATES to provide sufficient grooming space for everyone.

NO DOGS ALLOWED OVERNIGHT due to no security inside the building during the night hours. Private X-pen set-ups will be designated in the back covered area (North end) of the arena. ANY PRIVATE X-PENS SET-UP UNDER COVER ON THE SOUTH END OF THE ARENA WILL BE REMOVED.

The south end of the building is the emergency exit and handicap parking only. Vehicle must be identified by a handicap tag or placard. Brief loading and unloading will be allowed, but ALL unauthorized vehicles parked in this area will be towed away at the owner's expense.

**Additional exhibitor parking is available on the North side of the Horse Park. Follow the signs directing you around the barns to the back of the Arena.**

RV Parking will be handled by the MS Horse Park Mgt. See page 11 for specifics.

## **MS Horse Park**

### ***NEW RULES DUE TO COVID-19:***

- Social distancing will be required and strictly enforced throughout the weekend. All individuals and/or family groups should maintain a physical distance of 6 feet or more between others at all times and wash hands frequently. There will be hand sanitizer stations located throughout the building for you to utilize.
- Facial coverings are required when entering the building. Please bring your own mask/face covering or you will not be allowed inside the building. This applies to everyone. If anyone is not following the rules, they will be asked to leave and/or disqualified.
- Indoor arena capacity will be limited to a 25% capacity inside at a time. Please limit your time in the building. When seated inside the building, leave open rows and seats beside any individuals or family groups. Please exit as quickly as possible when done.
- Facility showers/restrooms should be limited to only those who do not have any other showering options. If you normally use the facility showers/restrooms for convenience, but do have a shower in your trailer we ask that you use your personal accommodations for this event.
- Please note that Starkville/Oktibbeha County has a mask ordinance in place requiring them to be worn in all businesses including restaurants.

### **COVID-19 SAFETY REGULATIONS**

- PLEASE NOTE: An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. Communicable diseases can be extremely contagious and/or lead to severe illness and death. Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks to severe illness and death. Event attendees voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to communicable diseases. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risk related to exposure to COVID-19 and any communicable disease related to humans and canines.
- Due to the constantly changing requirements, we will post the most updated information related to rules in the Judging Program and on the Foy Trent websites.
- In order to have the shows, we must follow rules and guidelines that allow everyone to be safe and remain healthy. Please help us by complying with these rules and guidelines and encouraging each other to do so. Please do not confront others who are not complying with the rules, but instead report it to the show chairs and club presidents so that they can handle the situation. We all want to continue to have shows and that is best accomplished by complying with the rules.

### **EXHIBITOR/ATTENDEE RULES:**

- Please follow these guidelines to make sure we have a safe and fun weekend:
- If you are sick, if you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 with-in 14 days prior to our shows – DO NOT COME.
- If you are at high risk, if you do not feel safe, if you do not feel comfortable, if you are scared or if you feel we should not be having these shows –DO NOT COME.
- If you want to have a good time, wear masks or face coverings, practice social distancing and show dogs then COME AND HAVE A GREAT WEEK-END AT OUR SHOWS!
- Please be respectful of others, adhere to the rules and listen to all Site Control and Show Committee Members, and above all... HAVE FUN!!!
- Handlers/Agents: Make sure all your clients list you as agent on all your dogs in order to avoid any potential issues.
- The shows will be closed to the general public. Anyone attending the shows must either be an owner, exhibitor, handler, handler assistant, judge, club members, any hired professional (photo, video, superintendents, stewards, etc.). Any family members or friends attending the show must enter with an owner or handler of the dog (first time entering) and get an access pass.

- All attendees must follow facility, local, state, AKC, and CDC guidelines as described here. These guidelines will be the MINIMUM standard. If the facility, local, state, AKC, and CDC guidelines are stricter at the time of the show then those stricter guidelines will be the minimum standard. Please check the Foy Trent Dog Shows websites for the most current information.
- If you have recently been exposed to another person who has symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19 within the previous 14 days or feel sick or unwell or have any symptoms of COVID-19, DO NOT ATTEND THESE SHOWS. Symptoms include coughing, sneezing, fever, sore throat, recent loss of taste and/or smell, as well as a number of others. Please consult the CDC website or state health agencies to determine whether you have symptoms.
- All show workers, judges, committee members, and attendees will be required to complete a daily self-assessment and sign a waiver before admission to the show site. At the time of admission, a colored wristband will be given to the person and must be worn at all times and events that day.
- Sanitizer, wipes, and other items at the judges' and stewards' tables are for their use only and NOT for other attendees.
- There will be no community use catalogues or pens available. Please know your dogs' numbers when picking up armbands. Catalogues will be available for purchase at designated club tables.
- Crates are only allowed in designated crating areas ringside for 15 minutes before and after breed judging. Everyone adhere to the six (6) feet social distancing.
- Groups will not be allowed to gather around the building.
- Chairs will not be provided. You are welcome to use your own chair at ring side if needed during breed judging.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The RESERVED AND OPEN Grooming Areas in arena will be available to exhibitors at 12:00 NOON on Friday. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best In Show Judging on Sunday.

No dogs left overnight in the building. NO EXCEPTIONS! THE BUILDING WILL BE LOCKED AT 8:00 PM, FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS.

In accordance with Sections 1 & 2 of AKC's Dealing with Misconduct, the Show Committee reserves the right to retain Event Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive. The Show Committee will obtain photographic proof of damaged hotel rooms. The exhibitor will be responsible for picking up after their dogs at the motels/hotels. No bathing/grooming of dogs in motel rooms.

**PARKING REGULATIONS:** DO NOT BLOCK THE EMERGENCY ENTRANCE ON THE SOUTH END OF THE ARENA. VEHICLES THAT ARE PARKED IN THE TOW-AWAY AREA WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE. LOADING/UNLOADING WILL BE ALLOWED WITH VEHICLES LEFT RUNNING.

CRATES MUST BE STACKED in designated areas only; this will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors will be held responsible for clean conditions in & around their crates in the grooming area. No saving grooming spaces. No grooming tables allowed on arena floor (as per mg!).

**NO EX-PENS ARE TO BE SET UP IN THE BUILDING. PRIVATE EX-PEN SET-UP AREA IS DESIGNATED ON THE ROPED-OFF, BACK COVERED (NORTH) END OF THE ARENA. ALL PRIVATE EX-PENS SET-UP IN THE FRONT TOW AWAY ZONE (SOUTH) END WILL BE REMOVED.**

Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks or toilets is strictly prohibited.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs and themselves on the grounds. Supplies will be available for pickup.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children on the day of the show. No strollers will be allowed on arena floor.

Any & all damages caused by the exhibitor, exhibitor's dogs or children will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor.

No unentered dogs on show grounds.

Restrooms & showers that are located in the center of Barn 3 are available for exhibitors at the Horse Park. Wash racks available for bathing dogs are located at the south end of Barns 1 & 2 and in the center of Barn 3.

For your safety, the facilities are patrolled by the Mississippi State University Police Department during the weekend.

**REMINDER TO ALL SMOKERS:** Mississippi State University restricts smoking and use of tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, pipes, smokeless tobacco, e-cigarettes, snuff & chewing tobacco) on Mississippi State University property which includes the MS Horse Park buildings and surrounding property. Smokers are to confine smoking inside their personal vehicles while on MSU property. All public buildings in the City of Starkville are smoke free.

## DIRECTIONS TO MISSISSIPPI HORSE PARK & AGRICENTER

**Highway 82 West** - Traveling West on Highway 82, take the Highway 12 West exit. Turn left onto South Montgomery Street (CVS Pharmacy is on your right). Follow South Montgomery approximately 3.5 miles. At traffic light, turn left onto Poor House Road. We are located 0.8 miles on the left.

\*If you have an RV or trailer, you can go past Highway 12 and take the Highway 25 South exit toward Louisville to avoid town. See Highway 25 directions below.

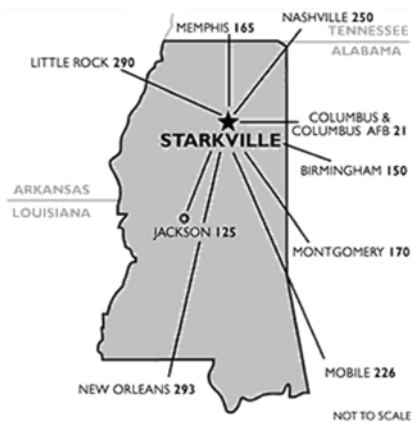
**Highway 82 East** - Traveling East on Highway 82, take the Highway 25 South exit toward Louisville. Turn left onto Longview Road (it turns into Poor House Road). Look for brown Mississippi Horse Park signs. Continue straight for approximately 2.5 miles. You will cross over Old Highway 25 and South Montgomery Street. After you go through the traffic light at South Montgomery, the Horse Park will be 0.8 miles on the left.

**Highway 25** - From Highway 25 South, turn left onto Longview Road (it turns into Poor House Road). From Highway 25 North, turn right onto Longview Road/Poor House Road. Look for brown Mississippi Horse Park signs. Continue straight for approximately 2.5 miles. You will cross over Old Highway 25 and South Montgomery Street. After you go through the traffic light at South Montgomery, the Horse Park will be 0.8 miles on the left.

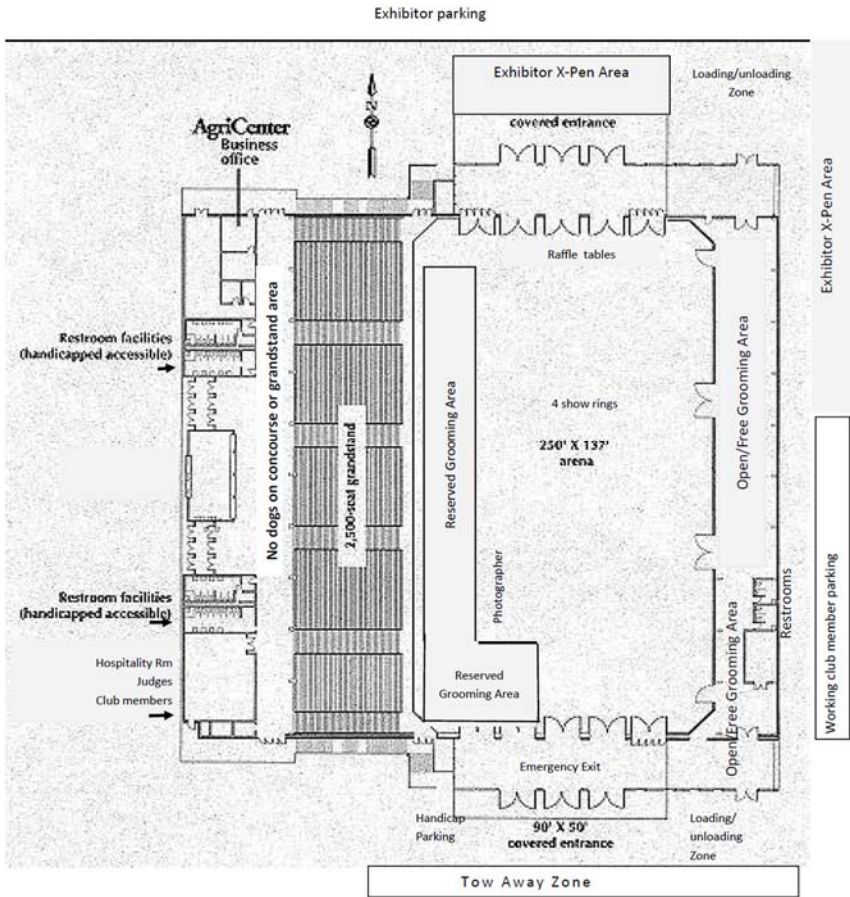
**Alternate 45** - Follow Alternate 45 and take the Highway 82 West/Starkville exit. Follow Highway 82 into Starkville. Take Highway 12 West exit. Turn left onto South Montgomery Street (CVS Pharmacy is on your right). Follow South Montgomery approximately 3.5 miles. At traffic light, turn left onto Poor House Road. We are located 0.8 miles on the left.
