The Show Committee WILL EXERCISE ITS RIGHT to hold a bench hearing for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of purebred dogs, which includes abuse of the hotel facility  
These rules must be followed at the hotel:

- No uncrated unattended dogs in hotel rooms
- All crates require plastic under them in hotel rooms
- Dogs must be on leashes in public areas
- No dogs in areas where food and beverages are served or consumed.
- Complaints regarding barking / howling dogs must be addressed immediately

## CONFORMATION PRACTICE

Kristen Dowd will be offering a Conformation / Ramp practice session on Monday evening, September 20<sup>th</sup> (exact time TBD) in the Event Center conformation ring. The practice will be divided into two sections:

First hour: two 30 minute sessions drop-in, unlimited / drop in space available for practice with minimal instruction.

Second hour two 30 minute instruction sessions that require sign-up; Effort will be made to accommodate everyone wishing to attend. Instruction will be given for ramp performance, stacking, bating, and general ring performance.

Fee for any 30 minute session is \$10.

Fees for both obedience and conformation practice will be collected on site. Cash Payment or checks made payable to KCA National with memo "KCA National Practice Session. "

## WICKETING

On Monday evening, the KCA Breeders Education Committee is pleased to offer **wicketing** for anyone who would like to know the height of your dog. Participants will receive a signed certificate with the dog's name and measured height.

While there is no size disqualification for Keeshonden, as the Illustrated Standard states, "it is important to maintain quality and breed type while keeping our breed in the medium sized range". So, it is helpful to know what our dogs are measuring.

During the event, the Breeders Education Committee will collect generic information on the sex, height, and number of dogs wicketed and will compare to results from wicketing at the 2019 KCA National. A summary will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

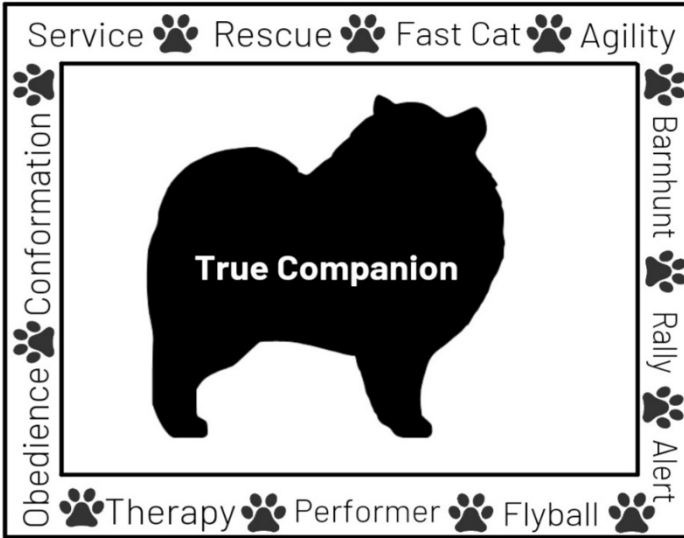
The Keeshond Club of America Annual Meeting will be held on Friday evening, September 24<sup>th</sup>.

**ALL TROPHIES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed. **CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent/Event Secretary and the Clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

**ALL DOGS** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

**THERE SHALL BE NO** drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

**NO FLEXI LEADS**, No Halti-type collars, or pinch collars on the show grounds.

**NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED** in rings during judging only.

**DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Clubs and the Event Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

**DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

**EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

**AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

**EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Keeshond Club of America & Heart of America Keeshond Club** and the Superintendent/Event Secretary are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

**THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD** is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
