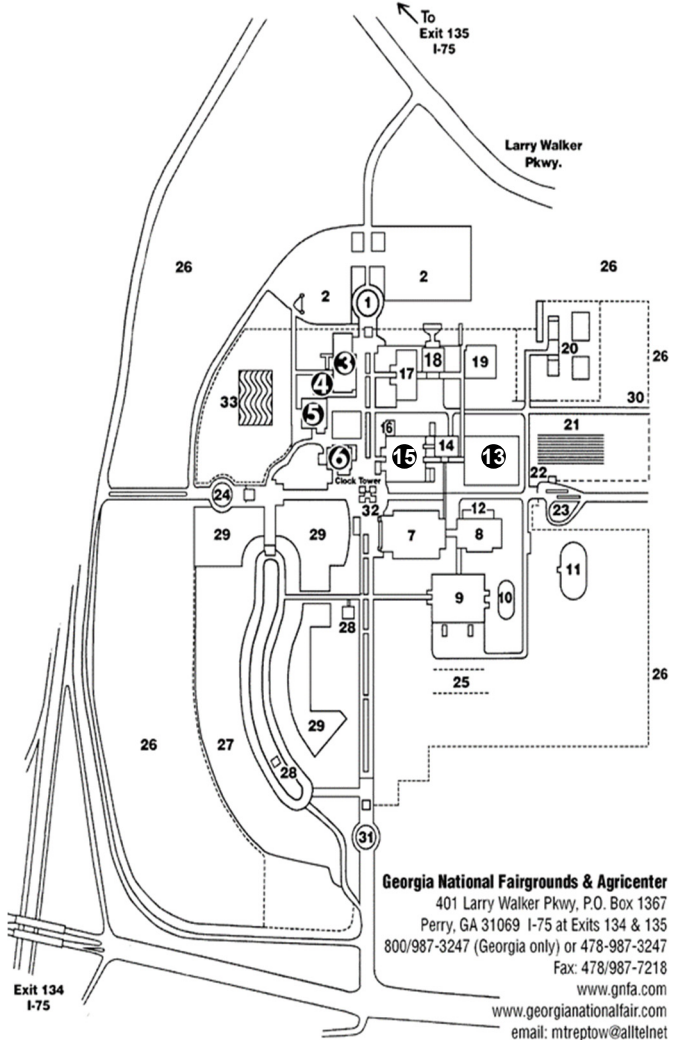

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors for grooming set up at Noon Monday, November 29, 2021. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Monday. See Grooming Reservation forms for details of Paid and free grooming rules.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs everywhere on the show grounds, which includes the entire Fairgrounds.

Location of grooming will be announced in Judging Program. Area available to exhibitors at noon on Monday the 29th.

Bathing facilities will be available. Dogs may be crated & left in the building overnight. Security will be that provided by the Fairgrounds. Your dogs may be left in the building at your own risk.

NO SAVING SPACES.

ONLY STACKABLE CRATES ARE ALLOWED IN GROOMING AREAS - NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES!

CRATE STACKING IS MANDATORY.

CRATES SHALL BE MARKED WITH CONTACT NAME AND PHONE NUMBER FOR EMERGENCIES.

Temporary crating against wall will be allowed where space is available. This space may be used ONLY during individual breed judging. Dogs and crates must be removed after Best of Breed judging. NO crates allowed in aisles. The Show Committees reserve the right to remove crates of anyone not adhering to these guidelines. Dogs may not be left in the McGill overnight.

No exercise pens allowed in any building. No living rooms, no mats, crates must be stacked. No play pens or double strollers. No soft sided crates in grooming area.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only, except in the designated practice ring. Practice ring for Conformation practice in McGill Bldg.

Please observe all parking signs. Reserved & Handicap spaces MUST be used only by those with valid permits. Vehicles improperly parked will be towed at owner's expense.

Any person who leaves his motel room in disrepair shall be brought before the Event Show Committee to answer charges. Please remember: as customers of area motels, your responsible conduct ensures continued community support.

Agricenter regulations do not allow the use of straw, hay or shavings in exercise pens or campsites. The Show Committees will enforce all Agricenter regulations whether published in this premium list or not.

All Gift Cards issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced Gift Cards will not be replaced.

PERRY AREA HOTELS/MOTELS

In order to get special rates, you must call the motel direct & inform them you are with the dog shows. All exhibitors read the regulations on hotel/motel accommodations.

NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS/EXHIBITORS

WHEN YOU SIGN THE ENTRY FORM, YOU AUTOMATICALLY AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS CONCERNING MOTELS EXTENDING THEIR PLACE TO YOU.

THE FOLLOWING RULES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THE GOOD OF ALL EXHIBITORS CONCERNED.

1. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in motel rooms. This will keep carpets clean & dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide **HIS/HER** own.
2. Dogs must be crated when owner is out of the room. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while in the hotel, lobbies or on hotel grounds. Rooms & lobby must be kept clean of dog debris.
4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his own dog & dispose of waste in designated trash cans. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas & cans are located.
5. Due to the severe clogging problems with the drain pipes, no dog may be bathed in the hotel. Crating & bathing facilities with hot & cold water are available at the show site.
6. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel staff & observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel management and/or the investigative committee. Motel property is considered an extension of the show site!
7. The investigative committee, working with a fair & equitable system, is charged with investigating complaints.
8. Each dog owner/registrant is expected to cooperate with the investigative committee, hopefully settling damage claims on the spot, or else must be willing to furnish information such as insurance policy numbers & other pertinent information as required/requested.
9. Should a hotel/motel, for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forego legal actions against CLUSTER CLUBS & the hotel/motel.
10. As an exhibitor, I am aware that violations may be referred to the **Show Committee** if written charges are preferred. If such charges are upheld by the **Show Committee**, it may lead to suspension from future show privileges.
11. Motel/hotels have the right to charge a deposit (refundable or non-refundable).
