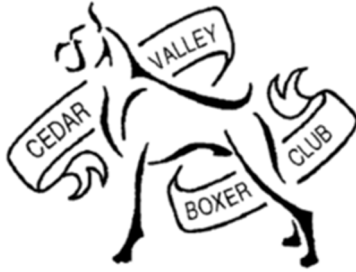

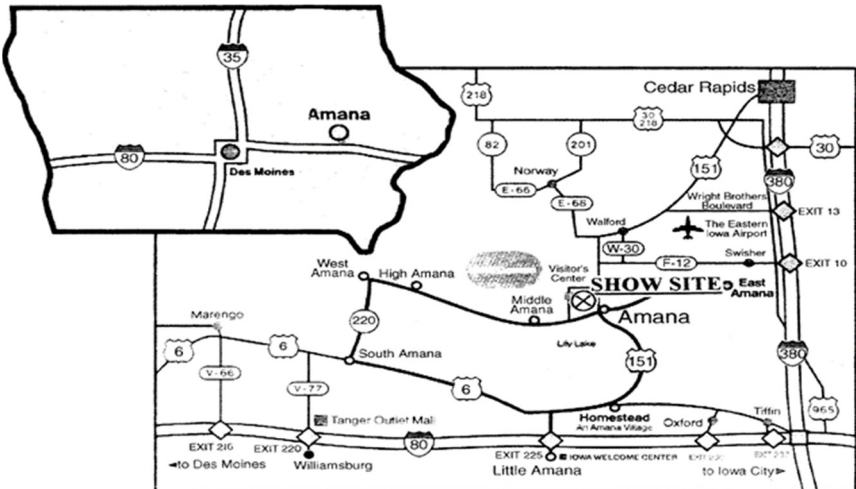

Additional Information For Animal Events

Pet Waste:

Pet Waste is the responsibility of their owner. If the Amana RV Park & Event Center must remove any pet waste from the surrounding buildings or surrounding grounds it will be at the cost to the lessee.

Wood Shavings:

May not be used on the grounds of the Amana RV Park & Event Center

Excessive Barking:

Visitors with loud dogs will be ask to leave the premises & if camping, will not receive a refund.

Leashing Policy:

Pets must be on a leash at all times. Violation of this may result in being asked to leave the park& or the event contract being dissolved

Restrooms:

Pets are not allowed in the restroom or shelter areas. Any event attendee found with an animal in any of the public restrooms will be asked to leave the Park without a refund of any camping fees they may have paid. Further, event attendees may not use the Park restrooms to access the inside of the building while with any animals. Repeated violations may result in the elimination of the event contract & or individual who violated the policy not being allowed back into the Amana RV Park & Event Center.

Please be respectful of all campers & their individual campsites. Do not walk between Campers, across other campsites lots. Use roadways & designated walkways. Reports from the facility of campers not following these rules will result in a bench hearing.

The clubs are taking reasonable steps to ensure a safe & clean environment for these shows & will not be responsible for anyone who contracts any illness during or after the shows. Please stay home if you are sick.

In accordance with AKC policies hotels are an extension of the show site and you will need to be considerate of the hotels and grounds.

Please keep it clean. Complaints from hotels can cause us to lose them for future shows and offending parties will be held accountable in accordance with AKC.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 12:00 pm Thursday.

Grooming tent will be available from 2:00 pm - 9:00 pm on Thursday for general set up. The Clubs may allow earlier set up for those hosting specialties on Thursday. Must receive permission from Show Chairs to set up earlier than listed. The Clubs are not responsible for equipment left overnight and no dogs left overnight in the grooming tent or any building.

Dogs must be removed from the show site one hour after completion of BIS judging on Monday.

ALL POSTED SIGNS MUST BE FOLLOWED

• \$10.00 per day, per car parking fee will be charged or \$30.00 week-end pass.

• RV Parking fees handled by Amana RV Park.

• Food available at the show site during show hours.

• No grooming allowed in the conformation building and no blocking aisles.

• Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping his/her grooming area clean. All waste must be disposed of properly.

• Crating will be allowed in the conformation building during the judging of the applicable breed & must be removed as soon as judging is done.

• No watchman on duty.

• No out of town checks will be cashed by the Tri-City Kennel Club, Inc. or the Cedar Rapids Kennel Association, Inc.

• No space for unentered dogs.

• These clubs reserve the right to gain access to any vehicle where there is evidence of a dog in distress.

• All video-taping requires permission of the Show Chairman.

• All buildings are non-smoking areas.

• Please turn off cell phones when entering the buildings.

The Tri-City Kennel Club, Inc. & the Cedar Rapids Kennel Association, Inc. reserve the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate. All persons attending these dog shows waive any claim from damages against these clubs for such removal.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children at all times.

No dogs may be left overnight in the grooming tent. Grooming tent will be available from 2:00 pm - 9:00 pm on

Thursday for set up. The Clubs are not responsible for equipment left overnight.

Minimal electric available in the grooming tent.

Dogs may be crated by indoor show rings only during the actual time that breed is being shown.

Crates must be removed immediately after the breed is judged.

Due to the new set up, outdoor rings will have crating areas in designated areas only. Crates

must be moved after breed judging, show committee will move or remove any crates in

unauthorized areas or that are left for more than 15 mins after breed judging. Any dogs crated

under the tents that are excessively barking or causing issues for other dogs and exhibitors will be asked to be removed from the tents

NO electric in show tents. No exercise pens allowed in the grooming tent.

All dogs and equipment must be removed 1 hour after Best In Show judging on Monday.

PARKING IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY. RV'S will be assigned by Amana RV Park.

Roping off, the use of traffic cones or crating to reserve a parking space will be charged a fee. Any such set-ups not having paid the set-up fee will be removed.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
