DIRECTIONS TO ANIMAL EMERGENCY CLINIC NORTH EAST: Turn right (west) on Will Clayton Pkwy toward Eastex Frwy/US 59. Turn right (north) on the feeder street & enter Frwy northbound. Exit Townsend Blvd. Go left (west) over the Frwy. Turn left (south) on the feeder street. Birchridge is located between Chair King & Hobby Lobby. Turn right (west) onto Birchridge. Travel to the end of the street. The clinic is on the right.

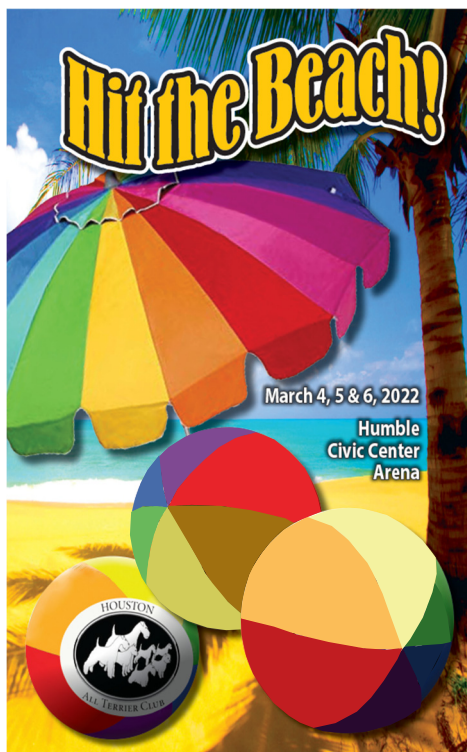

Attention Exhibitors

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 5:00 pm on Thursday once all the vendor vehicles have exited the area. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday. Vendors will be allowed in at 1:00 pm to allow exhibitors in the building by 5:00 pm. **All vehicles must be out by 4:00 pm.**

The Houston All Terrier Club & the Baytown Kennel Club, Inc. do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

NO PUPPIES UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS EXCEPT THOSE ENTERED IN THE 4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION. THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

NO DOGS ALLOWED OFF LEAD, PER AKC RULES & REGULATIONS, (EXCEPT WHEN REQUIRED DURING JUDGING) ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

NO FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES. YOUR CONTINUED COOPERATION IS EXPECTED & APPRECIATED!

1. **PARKING:** After unloading, all vehicles will park in the areas indicated. No parking is allowed adjoining the loading & unloading areas. Vehicles not moved after 20 minutes will be towed at owner's expense. NO PARKING AROUND ARENA. NO RV OR VEHICLE HOOK UPS. MOTORHOME/ RV PARKING IN NORTH LOT (LOT#2) ONLY. NO GENERATORS ALLOWED TO RUN DURING SHOW HOURS IN OR AROUND THE ARENA OR IN THE PARKING AREA EAST OF (BEHIND) THE ARENA. Vehicles will be towed at owner's expense. Parking spaces are on a first come basis. No spaces may be saved. This is intended to be a self-policed area.

2. **ABSOLUTELY NO CONES** ALLOWED IN PARKING LOT #1 IN FRONT OF THE BUILDING. These will be moved by Security Officer and/or Show Committee. NO EXCEPTIONS. LOT #2 - NORTH LOT (MOTORHOME PARKING LOT) allows saving of spaces.

3. **CRATING & GROOMING:** The Show Committee will mark all crating space. NO EX-PENS INSIDE THE BUILDING. Space in the building, grooming area & parking will be available on a first-come basis. NO space may be saved by roping off, using mats or any other means.

4. **NO ELECTRICAL CORDS** ALLOWED IN THE AISLES.

5. **THE SHOW COMMITTEE** RESERVES THE RIGHT TO LIMIT EX-PENS. PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF YOUR FELLOW EXHIBITORS.

6. Exhibitors **MUST** stack crates. All crates & equipment must be placed inside designated areas as provided by the club.

7. No dogs allowed in any restrooms & NO washing of animal food containers/bowls in restrooms.

8. Each exhibitor is responsible for clean conditions in his/her area. This WILL BE strictly enforced by the Show Committee, which will be making rounds to check ex-pen size, stacking of crates, number of grooming tables & cleanliness of setups.

9. As a courtesy to exhibitors, a special holding area will be provided during the judging of your breed, available 20 minutes prior to ring time & 10 minutes after. Immediately following judging, **DOGS & CRATES** must be removed to regular crating. A member of the Show Committee will move any dogs left unattended to the regular crating/grooming area. A member of the Show Committee will monitor this area.

10. You are reminded to bring clean up equipment, as constant maintenance of your grooming area will be required. This is intended to be a self-policed event.

11. Parents will be held responsible for the conduct of their children.

12. Neither alcoholic beverages nor glass containers may be brought onto the show site.
