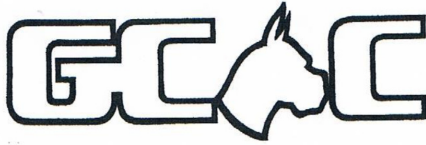

Directions From The North: Follow Rt. 68 South into Xenia until you have reached Ankeney Mill Road. (There is a speedway on one corner and a Dairy Station Ice Cream on the other corner). Turn **RIGHT** onto Ankeney Mill Road—which becomes Fairground Road. After one stop street, our racetrack will be on the right. Turn **RIGHT** to enter the expo center.

Directions From The South: Follow Rt. 68 North into Xenia until you have reached Ankeney Mill Road. (There is a speedway on one corner and a Dairy Station Ice Cream on the other corner). Turn **LEFT** onto Ankeney Mill Road—which becomes Fairground Road. After one stop street, our racetrack will be on the right. Turn **RIGHT** to enter the expo center.

Directions from the East: Follow Rt. 35 West into the center of town. Turn **RIGHT** at Rt. 68 Follow Rt 68N until you reach Ankeney Mill Road (There is a speedway on one corner and a Dairy Station Ice Cream on the other corner). Turn **LEFT** between the speedway and the ice cream store on Ankeney Mill Road, which becomes Fairground Road. After one stop street, our race-track will be on the right. Turn **RIGHT** into the expo center.

Directions from the West: Follow Rt. 35 to the Business Rt. 35 and continue East to the Center of town. Turn **LEFT** at Rt. 68. Follow Rt 68N until you reach Ankeney Mill Road. (There is a speedway on one corner and a Dairy Station Ice Cream on the other corner). Turn **LEFT** between the gas station and ice cream shop. After one stop street you will see our racetrack on the right. Turn **RIGHT** into the expo center.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- **PARKING:** Ample free car parking is available.
- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 8:00 am on Friday, September 9, 2022. Dogs must be removed from the Show Site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday, September 11, 2022.
- No overnight crating permitted
- Grooming in designated areas only!
- No gasoline or diesel generators permitted within 100 ft. of any building in which the show is conducted.
- Use of private exercise pens is not permitted inside the building and are strongly discouraged around the building perimeter.
- Inside crating in designated areas only. Crates must be stacked. No soft-sided crates permitted.
- No crates permitted ring side except crates on dollies, during judging only.
- Dogs must be on leash except when crated or as required for judging.
- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. Trophies not claimed will become the property of the show-giving club. The Club reserves the right to substitute a trophy of equal or greater value.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult on show grounds.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
