The Club reserves the right to substitute for any unavailable prize with one of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

The show giving club, the show superintendent, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

No banners or posters other than those in vendor spaces or those supporting the AKC, or the ESSFTA will be allowed at the show site. No booths, signage, products, activities, apparel, or communications of any kind that represent pet care products or services of companies other than Purina and its subsidiaries shall be in the Facilities.

All Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning their grooming areas. The Show Event Committee shall take appropriate actions against anyone who disregards published club regulations. This may include holding a bench hearing in connection with the same.
