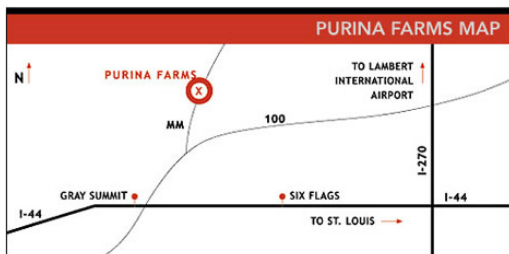

DOGS IN ROOMS PER SBCA RULE

Effective with the 2012 National Specialty, the SBCA established the following rules that attendees must follow in order to keep their dog(s) in guest rooms of the host hotel. "Guest room" definition includes, but is not limited to: rooms, condos, suites, or units, no matter how many bedrooms are involved. Dogs must be crated at all times while in a guest room. Appropriate measures must be taken to protect the carpet and surrounding areas under and near the crate. The guest agrees to take full financial liability for all damages by the pet including but not limited to: odor, damaging furniture or any part of the room, urination, etc. This includes other parts of the hotel where the dog may have to pass through to get to the rooms, i.e., the hallways and elevators. The room is to be inspected by a hotel associate and a designated member of the Show Committee before the deposit is credited or returned.

SBCA POOP FINE POLICY Any person who does not pick up after their dog on any part of the show grounds and hotel site for the National including but not limited to the ring area, parking lots, grassy areas and event sites, shall be subject to a \$50.00 fine. This notice will be printed in the Premium List as well as posted on the Show's website. Further notices will be posted throughout the show site, including placing flyers in any hospitality bag or registration handouts. A full copy of this policy can be obtained from the Corresponding Secretary. The Show Committee, if necessary, will obtain a list of offenders of either of the above policies, and submit the list to the Board and the SBCA President will write a letter of reprimand to the offenders.

THIS SPECIALTY WILL BE HELD INDOORS

Bring appropriate clothing for rain, sun or cold temperatures.

CASH PRIZES MUST BE COLLECTED IN THE RING AT THE TIME OF WIN.

NONE WILL BE DISTRIBUTED LATER.

ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF THE SHOW. NONE WILL BE MAILED.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation: will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS – SHOW SITE

● RV parking in the upper lot of the Purina Event Center will be available Monday, October 24, 2022 after 12:00pm. All RV and Day parking vehicles must vacate the RV Parking area by 9:00 AM on Sunday, October 30, 2022. Lower RV lot is available Saturday, 10/22/22, after 12:00pm. The Show Site will be available for RV/CAMPER PARKING ONLY at \$35.00 per day (Upper Lot)/ \$20.00 per day (Lower Lot). SPACE WILL BE RESERVED. RV/camper parking in designated areas only and will be directed by grounds personnel. No hookups will be run inside building. Electric (30 amp and 50 amp) will be available through the hook-ups in the Purina Event Center lot. Preferred arrival time for RVs is Saturday after 12 PM.

The building will be available to exhibitors at 1:00pm on Monday, October 24, 2022.

The building will be open at 6:00am Tuesday, October 24, 2022. All doors will be locked at 6:00 pm Monday through Saturday nights. Dogs may not be left overnight any night during the Saint Bernard National. There will NOT be overnight security.

Dogs and Equipment must be removed from the show site by 6pm on Saturday, October 29, 2022.

CRATING & GROOMING: Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms. NO Ex-Pens allowed inside building at any time. **NO CRATES MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY ON THE FLOORING SURFACE IN THE GREAT HALL. THERE MUST BE PLASTIC OR A RUG UNDER THE CRATE. ALL GROOMING TABLES MUST HAVE RUBBER OF PLASTIC CAPS ON THE END OF THE LEGS OF THE TABLE.** No cones are allowed inside building.

NO SOFT CRATES, PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS, 3X3 PUPPY PENS OR MATS PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING. SCOOTERS ARE PERMITTED FOR HANDICAPPED INDIVIDUALS ONLY.

All Grooming areas will be monitored by the grounds committee. Any excessive use of space will be corrected by the Show Committee. Grooming space is a privilege that can be withdrawn from those who do not follow the rules, regulations and instructions of the Saint Bernard Club of America, Inc.

All grooming inquiries and/or issues arising at the show site will be reviewed and resolved by the show chairman.

NO CONES PERMITTED INSIDE BUILDING OR OUTSIDE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked car on the show grounds, the clubs will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved.

No un-entered dogs. No catalogs will be given away.

No advertising or flyers may be placed without permission of the show-giving clubs and Purina Farms.

The Saint Bernard Club of America, Inc. does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

No Flexi-Leads

● **NO SMOKING (including electronic cigarettes) IN ANY OF PURINA FARMS BUILDINGS.**

● **NO EX-PENS** allowed on the grass around the Events Center or in the Event Center. This includes the Gateway Hall.

● All food and beverages must be purchased through the on-site food concession. Purina prohibits exhibitors bringing their own food or beverages into the Event Center. The Checkerboard Café is located close to both the Great Hall and Gateway Hall and offers a wide selection of food including daily specials and comfortable seating for 60 people. Violators will be reported to the AKC.

● **ACCESS** - The front gate is manned by a security guard from 6a.m. – 6p.m. to allow access to the property. Gates may be closed outside of these hours, but access to and from the property is still possible by pushing a call button at the gate or calling security at 636-221-1428. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave. Please note that quiet hours on the property are 11p.m. – 6a.m. Exhibitors with RVs coming in or leaving during that time should be respectful of other campers and be as quiet/non-disruptive as possible.

PARKING: All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. NO day parking on Level A, B, C or D - RV parking lot.

Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No Ex-Pens or Crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed on grass areas. No cones allowed in parking areas. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. **NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.**

- **Overnight RV** parking is by reservation only. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense. Refer to information in the RV Parking Reservation Form.
- **Day Parking** in the RV parking area is prohibited. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense.
- **Day Only Parking** is limited to the designated hard surface parking lots.
- **Handicapped** parking is available in areas marked.
- **All dogs** must be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).
- **Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Rabies Vaccination** Certificate - Missouri requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted.
- **The Clubs, Purina, the Superintendent** and their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or spectators, their family, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

EXHIBITORS & GUESTS

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance."

These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. No person or dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center. "If your child is in a stroller, keep a respectful distance from dogs, particularly dogs whose heads are at the same level as your child. Be very careful when near dogs so that you don't run over tails or feet or bump into them. Be sure your child does not reach out to touch a dog without owner's permission. No cones allowed inside building. No firearms allowed on Purina Property. No outside food or beverage is allowed in the Purina Event Center or other venues. Violators will be reported to the AKC. No Smoking (including electronic cigarettes) in the Building. No helium balloons allowed in either Hall. No glitter or confetti allowed in the facility. No Duct Tape to be used in the facility. Only painter's tape or gaffer's tape may be used.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
