NO BATHING OF DOGS ALLOWED IN HOTEL ROOMS

Bathing stations will be provided at the show site.

Because of the carelessness of some exhibitors, show sites, overnight parking and motel accommodations for clubs all over the US are becoming more difficult to obtain. We ask your cooperation in cleaning up after yourselves and your dogs.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: CSKC Show Committee will exercise its right to suspend any person from all AKC privileges for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of purebred dogs which includes abuse of a motel/hotel facility (Chapter 7, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Registration & Discipline).

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 6:00 am until 9:00 pm on Thursday. The buildings will open at 6:00 am Thursday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday and close at 9:00 pm. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

Group Judging • Groups may be judged two at a time on all three days

*All exhibitors are required to clean-up after the dogs they exhibit which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on the show site. Clean-up supplies will be available at each ring & other locations. **This is a SELF-CLEANING SHOW.***

Grooming in designated areas ONLY. Bathing tubs will be onsite.

No dogs may be left unattended overnight. Dogs must be removed from the building before it closes at 9:00 pm. Neither the club nor the Show Superintendent is responsible for equipment left in the building. There will be no security guards.

Crating at ringside in designated areas only while showing. Dogs & crates must be removed immediately after showing. Crates & grooming tables are not allowed in any other portion of the ring area. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

Photography & videotaping by individuals for their own personal use will be allowed. The Show Committee does, however, reserve the right to regulate placement of cameras to prevent interference with the traffic flow & the exhibiting of dogs. Photography or videotaping for any other purpose, including but not limited to commercial purposes, is prohibited, unless prior permission is obtained in writing from the Show Committee.

Children are to be under adult supervision at all times. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior & actions of their children. **BABY STROLLERS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

This Club will not tolerate any double handling of any breed by any persons. Double handling will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

DO NOT THROW BAIT IN THE RINGS.

There will be no exercise pens allowed in the building. Any square or round wire or solid pens with or without floors will not be allowed.

DO NOT ALLOW dogs to urinate on building walls, posts, gates or trash cans.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR DUE DILIGENCE.

NO unentered dogs allowed on the show grounds during show hours.

We ask that you bring your own RINGSIDE seating.

No Smoking Allowed in any of the buildings.

No vapor cigarettes allowed.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
