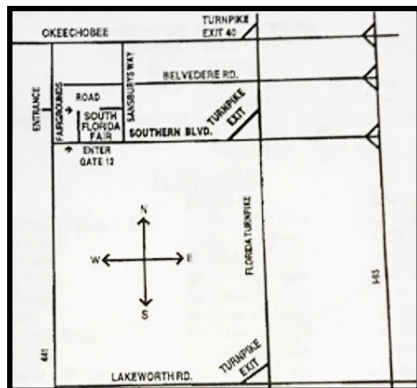
CAMPING SPACE

Attention Exhibitors!!!!

Grounds available from April 27, 2023 through April 30, 2023

Grounds will be available at 2:00pm, Thursday, April 27, 2023. Grounds must be vacated immediately following Best in Show on Sunday, April 30, 2023 unless arrangements have been made with the FLDC Show Grounds.

Gate will open at 6:00 A.M. and close at 11:00 P.M. each night.

Parking: Gates OPEN on 2:00 P.M., Thursday, April 27, 2023. **Parking Fees:** Cars, \$5.00 per day. **RV Parking - See RV pages - CASH ONLY - NO CHECKS ACCEPTED AT THE GATE.** Limited Disabled **Parking** will be available only upon display of a valid disabled placard or license. These spaces will provide roadway access - not closeness to rings.

Please follow parking instructions. Any Towing Service will be at owner's expense.

Any vehicle blocking a Fire Lane or another vehicle from entering/exiting Will be TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

For safety reasons for dogs and children, no children in strollers allowed around rings.

Strictly Enforced - Crates allowed at ringside ONLY during the time that breed is being judged. Crates must be removed after judging of your breed. Dogs may NOT be left in crates ringside after judging of that breed has been completed. No space for unentered dogs. Vacate show site after Best in Show on Sunday unless additional parking is reserved.

Food Concessions available.

Catalogs: Sales begin at 7:00 A.M. NO FREE catalogs.

NO puppy pens or X-pens allowed within the grooming area.

Grooming - Only stackable crates allowed in grooming. No soft sided crates except at ringside. Grooming will be monitored and set up with respect to AKC COVID-19 regulations.

The Show-Giving Clubs, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.

Trophies and Prizes must be claimed and picked up each day of the shows. Prizes will NOT be mailed. Should a trophy become unavailable the show giving club reserves the right to substitute trophies of equal or greater value.

Licensed Medical Professional on Grounds during show hours. **EMERGENCY:** Dial 911 -- Rescue has been notified of event, time and place.

NOTE: NO ALCOHOL, GUNS OR ILLEGAL DRUGS are permitted on the grounds.

No smoking in building.

The Clubs and their Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/ loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

We expect everyone to observe the ethical practice of good housekeeping and good sportsmanship and reserve the right to ask anyone who does not conform to these standards to leave and/or be subject to an event committee hearing.

Generators will not be allowed without proper mufflers.

Dogs entered in these events MUST have an up-to-date rabies vaccination and record thereof available.

No unentered puppies or dogs allowed at ringside.

Soft sided crates only allowed ringside while dogs are waiting to be shown. No dogs are to be left unattended in soft sided crates. Crates must be stacked due to limited space.

No roping off of space. This will be strictly enforced due to limited space.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and/or building or location. Please, obey all posted signs.

Vehicles parked in restricted zones will be towed at owner's expense.

LOCK YOUR CARS - We are not responsible for the safety of automobiles or contents. Owner of automobile and contents thereof acknowledges that he/she is in possession and control at all times automobile is parked.

NOTICE: WAIVER OF RIGHTS - All persons attending these dog events hereby waive any claim for damages against the club, its members, superintendents or facility, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions. Anyone parking in show site parking lots must accept full responsibility for damages should this occur.

The well-being of the dogs and exhibitors is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

DOORS ARE LOCKED FROM 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM

Free grooming will be available **WITHOUT** Electricity.

If you need electric, it can be dropped for \$100.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport:

conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the exhibitor, the judge, the handler, the breeder, while taking part in the sport.
