Directions to Stateline Animal Clinic (Approximately 35.3 mi/38 min): Turn left (north) out of parking lot onto Hwy 61 N to I-269 (12.3 mi). Take the ramp on the right (MS-304 E toward I-69 N/Memphis), continue on MS-304 (2.7 mi) to I-269 N/MS-304 E toward Memphis (11.4 mi) to I-55/I-69 N toward Memphis. Exit on the right to go north to Goodman Road (MS-302) (7.0 mi). Take the ramp exit 289 to go east on Goodman Road/MS-302 toward Horn Lake/Southaven. Keep right at the fork, follow signs to Olive Branch and merge onto Goodman Road/MS-302 (0.4 mi). At the second traffic light, turn left (north) onto Airways Blvd (0.4 mi). Turn right on Guthrie Drive (0.1 mi) and Stateline Animal Clinic will be on the left.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Note that some GPS software will route you from I-55 through south Memphis on TN-Hwy 61—while shorter, this route is NOT recommended.

FROM ARKANSAS: Take I-40 E across Mississippi River. Take exit 1E onto I-240 S toward Jackson, MS (about 6 miles) which becomes I-55 S toward Jackson, MS at exit 25A (about 14 miles; stay in middle two lanes); this becomes I-55 S/I-69 S at the MS State line. Take exit 283 and I-69 S toward Tunica/Casinos (about 15 miles). Continue on MS-304 W, then merge onto US-61 S (about 12 miles). Turn right on Perry Road and 3873 Highway 61 N is immediately on your left.

ALTERNATE FROM ARKANSAS: Exit I-40 at Brinkley and take Highway 49/US-49 S for about 65 miles crossing into Mississippi; turn left unto US-61 N through Tunica for about 20 miles; turn left onto Perry Road and 3873 Highway 61 N is immediately on your left.

FROM TENNESSEE NORTH: Take I-240 S to I-55 S toward Jackson, MS to exit 283 and I-69 S toward Tunica/Casinos as described above.

FROM TENNESSEE EAST: Take I-40 W toward Memphis. Take exit 24-25 for I-269/TN-385 toward Millington/Collierville/Jackson, MS, then immediately take exit 24A-B on the left toward Collierville/Jackson, MS for I-269. Take the ramp for exit 24A to I-269 S. Stay left on I-269 S toward Jackson, MS, when TN-385 splits off and continue until I-269 S becomes I-69 S toward Tunica/Casinos as described above. Note when I-269 and TN-385 split, stay left on I-269 S toward Jackson, MS.

FROM MISSISSIPPI EAST: Take I-22 W toward Memphis. Take exit 12B-A and stay left to exit 12A ramp for I-269 S/MS-304 W until this becomes I-69 S toward Tunica/Casinos as described above.

FROM MISSISSIPPI SOUTH: Take I-55 N to exit 283 and I-69 S toward Tunica/Casinos as described above.

Dog Days of Summer Cluster Rules

- No outside food or beverages may be brought into the Tunica Arena building, except items for babies. Of course, bait, food and water for dogs are permitted.
- No smoking in the building, covered arenas, dog bathing area, or stall areas. Please put cigarette butts and other smoking waste in receptacles provided near the building entrances.
- Leave flashers on while loading or unloading. No parking is allowed in the loading and unloading areas.
- All RV's, self-contained units and box trucks must park in the designated RV parking areas.
- RV Parking Lots are reserved parking areas. Only those reserving overnight spaces or assigned
 to day-parking by the camping committee are permitted to park there. All others should park
 in the regular parking areas located to the east of the building (on the side nearest Hwy 61) or
 in front of the building (Handicap Parking only).
- Elevators to the second level are located in the front lobby of the show building, providing
 access to the concessions, free grooming and vendors.
- The show grounds for RV parking will NOT be available until after 9:00 AM on Wednesday. If
 you are arriving in the Tunica area prior to this date, then you are directed to go to the Sam's
 Town Tunica RV Park, (800) 456-0711, or the Hollywood Casino RV Park, (800) 871-0711, both
 dog friendly and located in nearby Robinsonville MS.
- Building will be available on Wednesday at 2:00 PM. For safety reasons no one, except for club members, vendors and Cluster staff, is permitted to bring equipment or dogs into the building until setup is complete.
- No saving of space for others is permitted. The Event committee will monitor excessive use of space in order to provide a good experience for all exhibitors.
- Building will be open at 6:00 AM prior to the events and will be locked at 10:00 PM on Wednesday through Saturday nights.
- Grooming is permitted only in designated areas. Observe all aisles as marked and keep them clear.
- Obedience and rally exhibitors may setup and leave their crates and chairs in the area adjacent to that ring, provided the aisles are clear.
- Mats or tarps are <u>not</u> allowed on the concrete in crating areas, except a stress-relief mat at each grooming table.
- For the convenience of exhibitors, crates and tables are allowed close to the conformation rings in designated staging areas 15 minutes before and after scheduled ring times and during the judging or for photographs.
- Dogs may be left in the building overnight on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday
 nights. All owners or handlers leaving dogs overnight in the building MUST leave a clearly
 visible card with emergency cell-phone contact information near the crated dogs. A guard will
 patrol the building and the RV parking lots throughout the night. However, the Cluster
 members assume NO liability for any animals or equipment left in the building overnight.
- · Any dog displaying signs of illness (e.g., excessive coughing) will not be allowed in the building.
- Exhibitors are expected to observe all posted signs and to clean up after their dogs both inside
 and outside the building. Bags are available inside at the Trophy Table for solid waste. Plenty of
 trash cans and waste buckets are distributed throughout the site. Please immediately notify a
 member of the Event Committee or a member of the Custodial Crew, if liquids need mopping.
- Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their setups.
- No private exercise pens in the building.
- Shavings or other comparable materials used in private exercise pens in the parking lots must be swept up, bagged and deposited in a dumpster prior to the individual's leaving the show.
 NO shavings or other comparable material may be placed on grass or dirt.
- Dogs must be removed from the building by 6:00 PM on Sunday night.
- See additional rules and notices under ATTENTION EXHIBITORS and Special Instructions.

Please leave grounds in the condition that you found them. Place all trash in bags and deposit in the trash containers before leaving. The Tunica Arena & Expo Center provides an exceptional site for dog shows and we want to be able to continue using it in the future.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at **2:00 pm** on **Wednesday**. The show building will open for vendors at **9:00 am** on **Wednesday**, vendors should consult their contracts regarding specific move-in instructions and times. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

All vehicles must be removed from the parking areas by **10:00 pm, Sunday**, unless special arrangements are made for RV parking overnight on Sunday.

ELEVATORS to the second level are located in the front lobby of the show building, providing access to the concessions, second floor grooming and vendors. Access to and from the arena floor is marked with signs.

Dogs may be left in the building overnight. The security guard will be present in the building and will patrol the RV Parking area throughout the night. Exhibitors **MUST** leave a 3x5 Inch card with an emergency contact (cell) phone number prominently displayed near the dogs crated overnight. Building will be opened at **6:00** am prior to events and will be closed at **10:00** pm on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday nights. Dogs must be removed from the building by **6:00** pm on **Sunday**.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

GROOMING will be in designated areas. No grooming will be allowed in any other areas of the buildings except the designated areas. All crates must be stacked except in the obedience/rally area. No private exercise pens in the building. Areas near and between the conformation rings are for temporary crating only. Obedience and rally exhibitors may leave crates and chairs overnight in designated areas adjacent to their ring(s).

The Show Committee will tour grooming areas each morning and inspect crates. Any owner whose crates are soiled is subject to an Event Committee Hearing if not cleaned and taken care of immediately.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.

Exhibitors should have a copy of their proof of rabies vaccination available upon request. Dogs may not be left unattended in vehicles, unless the vehicle is specially-equipped with adequate air-conditioning (e.g., motorhomes and recreation vehicles).

All persons attending this Cluster hereby waive any claim for damages against Greater Shelby Kennel Club, the Kennel Club of North Mississippi and the Memphis Toy Dog Club or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

All driveways must be kept open for access by emergency vehicles.

Mats or tarps are not allowed on the concrete except a small stress-relief pad at each grooming table.

No baby strollers allowed in the building.

There will be no charge for exhibitor parking. There is a \$45.00/night motorhome parking fee for electrical and water hookups and \$15.00/night for no hookups. Advanced registration is strongly advised. Please see RV Reservation Form. Security will be provided overnight for RV parking. There are water and electrical hookups at the Arena. Both 30 amp and 50 amp plugs are available. There is a dump station located in the rear RV park.
