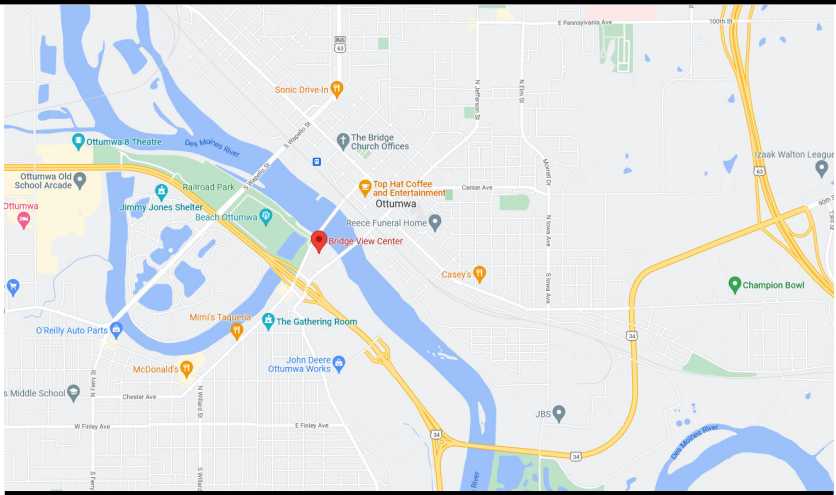

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at **3:00pm** on Friday, **July 7, 2023**. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, **July 9, 2023**.

The building will be available Friday, **July 7, 2023 (3:00pm — 10:00pm)**, Saturday, **July 8, 2023 (6:00am — 10:00pm)** and Sunday, **July 9, 2023 (6:00am — Immediately following Best in Show)** No Early Entrance will be allowed. Doors will be locked at **10:00pm** each night and re-open at **6:00am**. Dogs may be left in building overnight. **AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

No exercise pens in building.

Campers and trailers may park overnight — 50AMP, **\$50.00** (limited electrical hook-ups available) Send reservation early. See reservation form on page 16.

Smoking is **NOT** permitted in the building **ANYWHERE**.

Food service available in building—all day Friday, Saturday & Sunday, including evening meals.

Dog show exhibitors—Enter the building at the southeast door and ramp. No dogs in carpeted areas.

The use of flexi-leads on show grounds (indoors or outdoors) during show hours (**6:00am — 6:00pm**) is prohibited

No private exercise pens. This includes puppy pens. **All crates, including wire crates must be stacked.**

No soft sided crates are allowed.

Saving of space by roped off areas, empty crates or others means are not allowed in grooming area or in the parking lot.

Public exercise pens will be provided and must be attended by owner or handler while in use, please bring your own scooper to clean up after your dog.

Please make sure all grooming equipment is turned off and cool (not hot) before leaving your grooming area.

Ringside crating will be permitted during breed judging, but must be removed immediately after judging of your breed. The Show Chair reserves the right to ask that any or all crates be removed at any time.

Any damages to motels by exhibitors can result in disciplinary action by an Event Committee.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Bathing of dogs in the public restrooms is prohibited. There is an outside bathing area.

PLEASE OBSERVE AND RESPECT HANDICAP AND FIRE LANE SIGNS. ALL VIOLATES MAY BE TICKETED AND FINED.

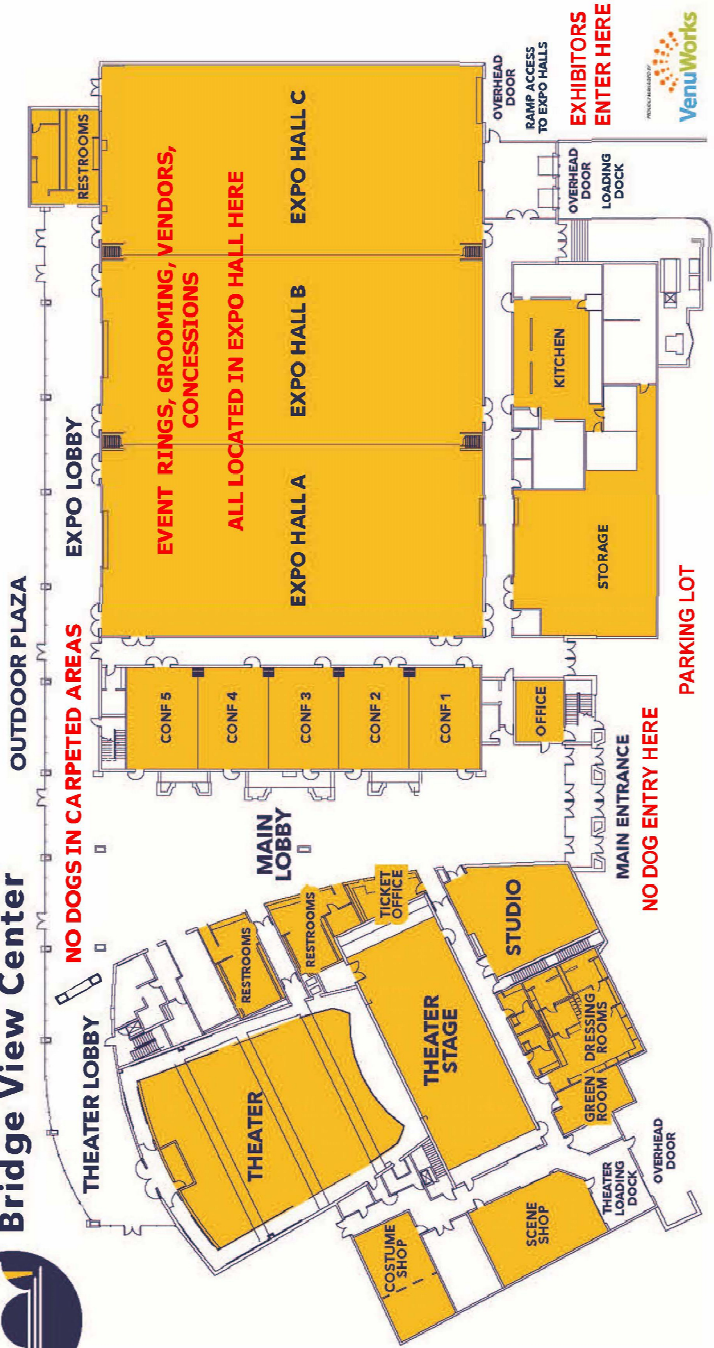

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport:

conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
