ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at **1:00 PM** on Wednesday, September 4, 2024 at the discretion of the Show Chairperson.

Dogs MUST BE REMOVED from the show site one hour following Best in Show judging of the Mobile Kennel Club, Inc show on Sunday, September 8, 2024.

All dogs must enter through the entrance designated by Show Staff.

Each setup must post contact information with the phone number of the exhibitor. Forms will be available at the club table and superintendent's desk.

Exercise pens (X-Pens) and washing stations will be in the north area outside the exhibit hall (unless changed by show staff). Indoor X-Pens must be kept clean. All X-Pens MUST have plastic under them which covers the entire area under the pen(s) and have absorbent material between the pen and plastic sufficient to gather any and all dog waste. The clubs reserve the right to revoke the privilege of indoor x-pens if not kept clean.

No charge for electricity for RESERVED grooming area, but you must provide your own extension cords. All extension cords MUST BE taped down securely as to prevent a tripping hazard.

Day Grooming (non-reserved) area may not have power available.

The Clubs reserve the right to substitute an unavailable trophy with one of equal or greater value.

All trophies not claimed each day of the shows become the property of the show-giving clubs. No trophies will be mailed.

All dogs must be kept on leash when not crated or in exercise pens.

Neither the Mississippi Gulf Coast Toy Breed Club, the Singing River Kennel Club of Mississippi, the Mobile Kennel Club, Inc, the Grounds, the City of Mobile nor the superintendent will be responsible for any dogs or equipment. All owners/ agents will leave equipment at their own risk.

Under no Circumstances will dogs be permitted in any restroom facility.

Exhibitors are requested NOT to permit their dogs to urinate on walls, fences, nor equipment at the show grounds. EVENT COMMITTEE WILL BE CALLED FOR ANYONE LEAVING DOG EXCREMENT OR TRASH ON SHOW GROUNDS OR PROPERTY.

Any and all damages caused by the exhibitor will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor. Parents will be responsible for the actions of their children and their conduct.

Crates allowed ringside during their breed judging and MUST BE REMOVED immediately following judging. Abuse of this privilege will result in the club having to ban the use of ALL ringside crating. Please police yourselves in the future.

Firearms or illegal drugs will not be allowed on the show grounds.

All cell phones, pagers and other electronic equipment must be turned off while at ringside and while in the ring.

Selling dogs will not be permitted on the show grounds.

Refreshments: Food and Beverages will be available on the show grounds.

Please use trash containers for disposal. Help us preserve this beautiful show site.

Show Chairman and Event Coordinator have authority to change rules for the safety and comfort of dogs and exhibitors.

We expect all exhibitors to display good sportsmanship and act like Ladies and Gentlemen. **The Event Committee**, in accordance with AKC Rules and Regulations, will deal with violations in this area.

The Clubs and their Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/ grounds, parking / loading/ unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/ canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration that this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
