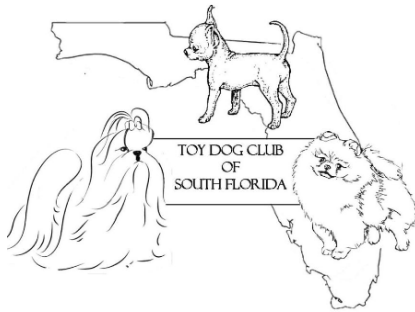

Building and Grooming Area Not Available Before 1:00 PM on Thursday. Exhibitors are required to show their ID to enter the event. No admittance without it each day. Reserved Grooming Area will be available for dogs overnight, but building will be locked

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS AND VENDORS

The club will be in compliance with COVID-19 safety precautions in place at the time of the event. Once you have shown your dog and are no longer needed for continued judging, please leave the building. Depending on the conditions and circumstances at the time of the shows, we may choose to eliminate Special Attractions and any other events the clubs deem necessary. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding. By entering these shows you agree to do your best to follow all "best practices" in effect during the shows and that you will not hold either Club of The South Florida Fairgrounds liable for any condition that might arise while you are in attendance.

Day of event parking is \$5.00. Enter Gate 12.

General Admittance Fee: \$5.00 for non-exhibitors. Children under 12 enter at no charge.

No crates allowed near rings except during judging of your breed. Do not block the aisles. This will be enforced by the Event Committee. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

No Ex-Pens allowed in grooming area.

No Grooming Tables allowed inside except for grooming area.

Grooming Areas must be Kept Clean. NO SAVING SPACES. NO TAPING OFF SPACE.

Dogs should be exercised before coming into event buildings. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

Absolutely No Smoking in Buildings.

No dogs permitted in any restroom! No cleaning of dog food bowls in restrooms.

Dogs must be kept out of all flower beds and posted areas.

Violators will be brought before the Event Committee.

The show-giving clubs, the show superintendent, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, spectators, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or to dogs left overnight in building.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
