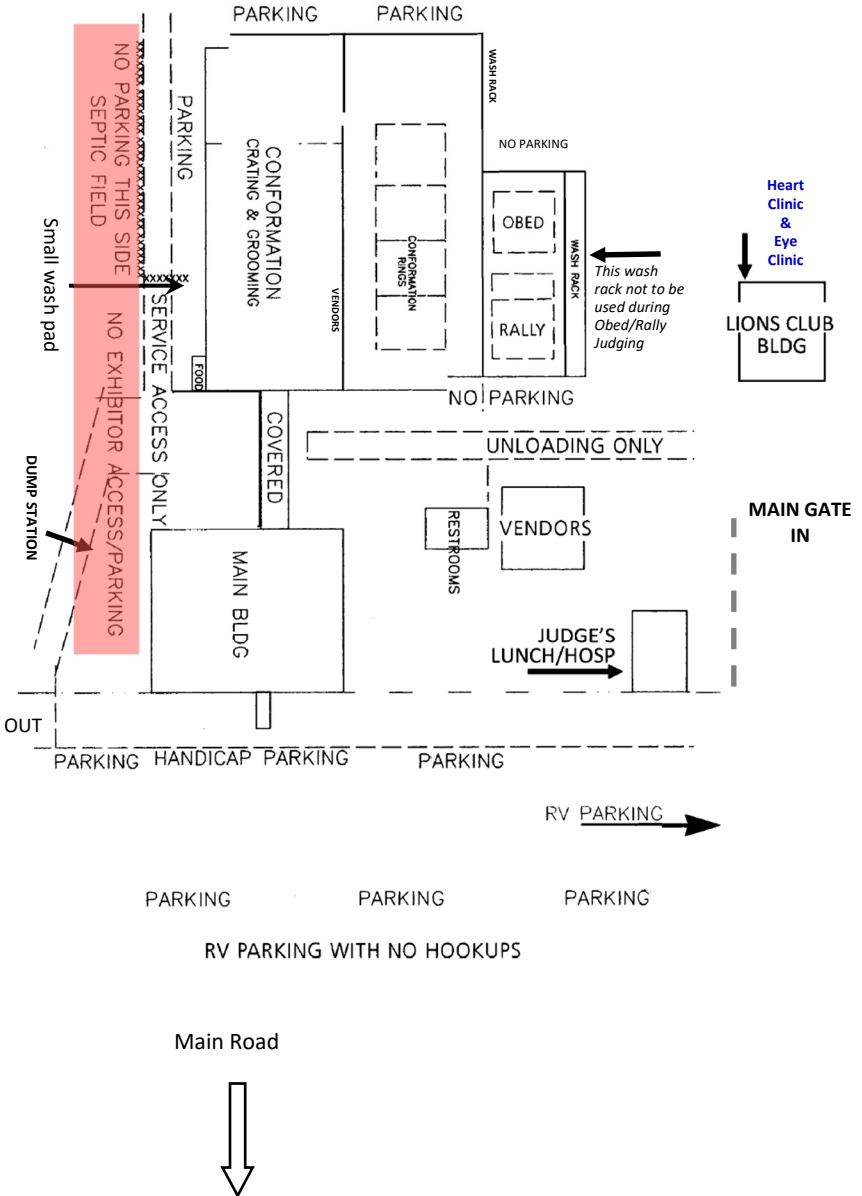

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Texas Hwy 6 to Navasota. Take Hwy 90 N towards Anderson. Go approximately 1.3 miles to FM 3455 & turn left. Show site is on the left.



ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 12:00 noon on Thursday or after the Superintendent completes set-up, whichever is later. Dogs must be removed from the Show Site immediately following Best in Show judging Sunday with the exception of dogs entered and participating in the Spinone Specialty events .

THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO GROOMING OR CRATING SPACE IN THE BUILDINGS. THERE WILL BE DESIGNATED HOLDING AREAS PROVIDED WHILE DOGS ARE BEING SHOWN ONLY.

EX-PENS ARE ALLOWED UNDERCOVER.

NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT OUTSIDE IN THE PAVILION OVERNIGHT!

EX-PENS IN FRONT PARKING LOT MUST BE PLACED ON PLASTIC OR MATS. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER USE. WASTE RECEPTACLES ARE AVAILABLE.

VEHICLES IMPROPERLY PARKED WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

BVVC IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSSES OR DAMAGES TO PROPERTY.

No hair/blow dryers within 50 feet of Obedience ring. No using the dog washing area on the north side of the covered arenas during Obedience judging. There is a smaller wash pad on the south side, outside the covered grooming spaces.

Sheriff's deputies will be on duty for security.

RV parking will be allowed in designated areas only. Please follow directions of grounds personnel. All RV spaces with hook-ups will be assigned. **DO NOT park** without being assigned a space. **SELF PARKING ONLY IN FRONT LOT WITHOUT HOOK-UPS.** Please see form on page 24 for RV Parking Fees (applies to hook-ups and dry camping). **All RVs must display a club-provided "PAID" sign or will be subject to being towed.**

****New parking restrictions at the Grimes County Expo will restrict parking in areas at the rear of the main building.**

NO dumping of holding tanks, grey water or sewage on show grounds, except at Dump Station. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. The City of Navasota & the show-giving club will not be responsible for loss by fire, burglary, theft or any other cause whatsoever to either the vehicle or its contents.

The show grounds constitutes the show building, the outside grounds & all parking areas.

In accordance with sections 1 & 2 of AKC 's Dealing with Misconduct, the Brazos Valley Kennel Club reserves the right to retain Show Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive.

Any exhibitor arguing with officials or exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be subject to Show Committee jurisdiction.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
