*****POINTS FOR RESERVE*****

The Ibizan Hound Club of the United States will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog Entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Regional Specialty is held

The Ibizan Hound Club of the United States will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch Entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Regional Specialty is held

Attention Exhibitors

The Show site will be available to exhibitors at 1:00 pm Wednesday, April 16, 2025 **with the only exception being WORKING members**. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

PLEASE NOTE: The grassy area to the west of (behind) Thompson Hall is reserved RV Parking. Please do not park or set up X-pens on the grass in front of the fence. You may pay for RV Parking if you wish to reserve this space for X-pen set-up. X-pens may be set up on the grass on the South end of the building where Free Grooming is located.

REMINDER TO ALL SMOKERS: The Building is a SMOKE FREE building.

To ensure adequate space for grooming and quartering of dogs, the Club will require all exhibitors to stack crates, limit grooming tables, and comply with any and all limitations as may be imposed by the Building and Grounds Committee or the Superintendent.

NO SOFT SIDED CRATES

ABSOLUTE NO X-PENS OR 3 X 3 FT PUPPY PENS inside of the Building. X-pens will be allowed on the South end of the grass behind & on the side of the Building unless an RV spot has been reserved.

No space may be saved by roping off, using mats, or any other means.

EXHIBITORS and HANDLERS will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates.

Crates may be stacked at ringside during judging only (must be removed immediately following breed judging).

Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks or toilets is strictly prohibited.

No dogs will be allowed in the restrooms.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs on the grounds. Supplies will be available for pickup. This will be enforced.

Per Sections 1 & 2 of AKC's Dealing with Misconduct, the Show Committee reserves the right to retain Event Committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive. The exhibitor will be responsible for pickup after their dogs at the motels/hotels.

NO BATHING STATION AT THIS SHOW

NO GROOMING/BATHING DOGS IN ROOMS.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control & restraint over their children on the days of the shows. No strollers in show buildings.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
