Crates will be allowed ringside 15 minutes prior to judging and must be removed immediately following the judging of that breed.

There will be no private ex-pens in the Free Grooming Area.

The Show Committee reserves the right to regulate all grooming areas. No dogs allowed in restrooms.

BATHING FACILITIES: Bathing only allowed in a designated area in the parking lot outside and near the SageNet building. No bathing is allowed in the SageNet building or any other location.

Mid-Continent Kennel Club of Tulsa does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Friday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient.

Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days.

The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors **NO EARLIER** than 12:00 pm beginning Thursday, April 24, 2025. Building will be open from 12:00 pm until 11:00 pm on Thursday, 6:00 am until 11:00 pm on Friday and Saturday, and 6:00 am until 6:00 pm on Sunday. Tulsa Expo Security will be on site throughout show weekend. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately after Best in Show judging on Sunday, April 27, 2025. **Dogs will be allowed overnight in grooming areas.** Dogs & equipment will be the sole responsibility of owners & agents. Mid-Continent KC or Tulsa Expo Square cannot be held responsible for dogs & equipment.

Dogs left overnight in the facility must have emergency contact number posted on crates.

You will be directed to unloading areas for reserved or open grooming. Exhibitors must safely secure extension cords to floor with 3" masking tape in grooming area.

No roping off or saving spaces in open grooming. All spaces will be on a first-come first-served basis. Please keep your indoor & outdoor areas clean.

Show volunteers will have designated grooming space. Show Chair will not enter or handle dogs.

Food service is provided at Tulsa Expo Square concessions locations.

Crates will be allowed ringside 15 minutes prior to judging and must be removed immediately following the judging of that breed.

Obedience exhibitors are responsible for notifying the Obedience/Rally Chair of eligibility for any Special Obedience Awards.

NO SOLICITATION ALLOWED ON SHOW SITE.

Ex-pens must have plastic under them and all debris must be cleaned up. No private ex-pens allowed in free grooming area. Designated indoor ex-pens & outdoor ex-pen areas will be available.

Bathing Facilities: Bathing will be provided in a designated area in the Parking Lot outside and near the SageNet building. Water and tubs will be provided. No bathing is allowed in the SageNet building or any other location. **Keep the area safe and clean!**

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able
 to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
