### ROUTES TO THE EVENT SITE

**I-95 or the Florida Turnpike to Southern Blvd.** West to South Florida Fairgrounds. The Florida Turnpike is approximately 1.5 miles from the South Florida Fairgrounds and provides the most direct access. I-95 is approximately 8 miles East of the Fairgrounds.

## Show Chair

The Show Chair has the authority to change rules for the safety & comfort of dogs & exhibitors. All exhibitors are expected to display good sportsmanship.  
The Event Committee will deal with violations in this area.

## Rings & Ringside

Ringside crating will be permitted during breed judging but must be removed immediately after judging. No x-pens inside the arena floor. Show Chair reserves the right to ask that any or all crates be removed at any time.

## Dogs Locked in Vehicles

Action can and will be taken to rescue dogs confined to an overheated vehicle. All vehicle owners on the show premises have waived their right to legal actions or damages regarding dogs confined to improperly vented vehicles. Clubs regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property and privacy rights. We will not page anyone to their vehicle; we will take action!

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS & VENDORS

**The clubs will be in compliance with COVID-19 safety precautions in place at the time of the event.**

Depending on the conditions and circumstances at the time of the shows, we may choose to eliminate Special Attractions and any other events the clubs deem necessary. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding. By entering these shows you agree to do your best to follow all "best practices" in effect during the cluster and that you will not hold either the Club, or The South Florida Fair Grounds liable for any condition that might arise while you are in attendance.

**Camping will be permitted at the Fairgrounds** and will be available to campers starting **Friday, September 25** Full hookups (water, sewer and electric) are available for **\$70.00 per night**. The South Florida Fairgrounds has a **limited number of camping spaces for these events**. The on site spots are **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED**. **ONLY handicapped persons or vehicles** will be allowed access through gate 10. This is the area back of the west expo across from stockade. Handicapped mirror tag, identification card or license plate are required. **Each camping space has electric, water and sewer hookups. Campers must bring their own cords and connections. Please check in with security for your space assignment. X-pens must be set up within your site. All RV parking is handled by the South Florida Fairgrounds and you must follow their rules.**

**Day of event parking:** \$5.00 Enter Gate 12.

**General Admittance Fee:** \$5.00 for non-exhibitors. Children under 12 enter at no charge.

**No crates allowed near rings except during judging of your breed.** Do not block aisles. This will be enforced by the Event Committee. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**No X-Pens allowed** in grooming area.

**No Grooming Tables allowed inside except** for grooming area.

**Grooming Areas** must be Kept Clean. NO SAVING SPACES. NO TAPING OFF SPACE.

**Outside exercise areas:** Dogs should be exercised before coming into event buildings. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

**Absolutely No Smoking in Buildings.**

**No dogs permitted in any restroom!** No cleaning of dog food bowls in restrooms.

**Dogs** must be kept out of all flower beds and posted areas.

**Violators** will be brought before an Event Committee.

**The show-giving clubs,** the show superintendent, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, spectators, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children, or to dogs left overnight in building.

## NO UNENTERED DOGS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS UNLESS IT IS A SERVICE DOG

### ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in *The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1*.

The Dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web Site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. # AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

**Preface:** The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
