***BEST OF BREED COMPETITION** – Undeclared dogs ONLY are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. All Best of Breed Dogs will be judged to their entirety. Bitches do not need to come into the ring to be checked at this point. The Best of Breed Bitch judging will follow to their entirety. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

Grand Champion Competition – The following categories of dogs are entered in this competition:

- Dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed or Best of Variety class.
- Dogs transferred to Best of Breed/Variety which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed.
- Champions that win Non-Regular Classes and become eligible for Best of Breed competition. (Altered or spayed CH veteran class winners at independent specialties are eligible.)
- Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition.

At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to

- Best of Breed or Variety
- Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety
- Select Dog
- Select Bitch

Grand Champion competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed competition.

****Points Available for Reserve****

The Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Bearded Collie Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

- This show will be professionally video recorded by **Dog Show Video Pros**. No other commercial video recording, video recording from a tripod or monopod mounted camera, or any video recording or streaming of large segments of the show will be permitted.
- Submission of an entry form and/or physical presence on the show grounds shall constitute both implied and real consent for both the handler and their dog to be video recorded.
- On Line streaming of show video to Facebook, YouTube, FaceTune, U-Stream, Live Stream or other comparable online outlets is strictly forbidden!
- Violation of these show video policies may result in an Event or Bench Committee hearing.

In addition, the show video company will allow contracted show “win shot” photographer(s) and contracted show “candid” photographers to take professional still photographs only. Such contracted show photographers are **NOT PERMITTED** to record or stream video, however.

Will allow all other individuals (owners, breeders, handlers, spectators, club members, etc.) to record video of their own dog(s) using iPhones, iPads or other **handheld devices only**.

Video recording from a tripod or monopod mounted camera, or any video recording or streaming of large segments of the show by an individual is NOT permitted. Streaming video during the show is strictly forbidden.

In the event of inclement weather (outdoor show) or other extraordinary unforeseen circumstances such as equipment damage or loss in Shipment, videographer's emergency (illness, accident, etc) or unplanned travel delays, that the Video Company will be held harmless in its inability to provide videography services in part or in whole at this event

There will also be Ringside mentoring by BCCA Mentors during class dog and bitch judging, as well as Best of Breed. Awards Of Merit (AOM) – Award of Merit rosettes may be awarded to ten percent of the Best of Breed entry including the winners of the non-regular classes who are eligible for best of breed at each national specialty. The rosettes will not be numbered. The following are not eligible for an Award of Merit: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.

Best of Breed Competition

Non-Regular Classes (involving Single Dog Entries)

Sexually Altered Classes – For dogs & bitches, six months of age or over, that have been neutered or spayed. The dog & bitch winning these classes are *not* eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

Sexually Altered Dog • Sexually Altered Bitch

Performance Classes – For dogs and bitches, 6 months of age and over, that have earned at least one title in any AKC Companion or Performance Event (Agility, Herding, Obedience, Rally or Tracking.) Dogs entered in these classes must not have been neutered or spayed. By virtue of winning these classes, the dog and bitch are eligible to compete for Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other class.

Performance Dog • Performance Bitch

Veteran Classes – For dogs and bitches seven years of age and older. In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8, veteran dogs and bitches may be spayed or neutered at specialty shows. All winners of Veteran Classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. First place winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes will compete for Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch after Best of Breed.

The Following Classes Are Provided For Both Dogs & Bitches
Veteran, 7 Yrs. & under 10 Yrs. • Veteran, 10 Yrs. & under 12 Yrs.
Veteran, 12 Yrs. & under 14 Yrs. • Veteran, 14 Yrs. & Older

Non-Regular Classes (involving Multiple Dog Entries)

NOTE: *As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace Class is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that a "castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Performance Classes or Best of Breed Competition

Brood Bitch Class – Same as Stud Dog, except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "get".

Brace Class – Two dogs of the same breed/variety, regardless of sex, and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

Junior Showmanship

Judge: Mrs. Mary Murphy-East

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

Incomplete or illegible FAX entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4).

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and
