EXHIBITOR AND GUEST INFORMATION WHILE STAYING AT PURINA FARMS:

The Event Center will be available to exhibitors at 6:00 a.m. on Monday, September 11, 2017. No outside food or beverage is allowed on the Purina Farms property. Violators will be reported to the AKC. No Dogs may be left Overnight in the Event Center Monday through Wednesday as there is no Security Guard on duty. Ringside Crating in the Great Hall for Obedience, Rally, and Agility. Crates must have a mat under them in the Great Hall.

Any dog staying overnight in the building (Thursday through Saturday nights) must have a note card on its crate clearly displaying a cell phone number of the owner and/handler in case of emergency. Exhibitors may not be in the building after the building closes for the night at either 10p.m. or 11p.m. as noted in the premium.

Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited in buildings.

Weapons of any kind, illegal drugs and fireworks are not permitted on the premises.

Alcohol may not be brought to the Purina Farms Visitor Center.

No exercise pens will be allowed around the grassy perimeter of the entire Event Center.

All dogs are required to be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).

No dogs should be left unattended in the off-leash exercise areas or the public outdoor x-pens around the property

Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to ONE PARKING SPACE. No cones allowed in parking areas. NO PARKING IN ROADWAYS or next to building.

No dogs to be left in cars or vans with windows closed. In case of emergency clubs reserve the right to remove overheated dogs from vehicles by whatever means necessary. No dogs to be left on grounds unattended overnight.

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance". These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. No dogs allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center. There will be no baby strollers, cones or firearms allowed in the Purina Center.

Best of Breed Competition

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show.
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show.
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show.
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.

In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dog Class, 7 years and under 10 years **Veteran Dog Class, 10 years and older**
(same for Veteran Bitch Classes) (May be Spayed or Neutered)

Lure Coursing Dog/Bitch Classes - This class is open only to those dogs that have received a title in any recognized coursing organization. Dogs with a JC title only are not eligible. Entries may **not** be spayed or neutered.

The first place Winner of these classes, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.

BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By Exhibitor from the Bred-By Exhibitor class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Bred-By Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By Exhibitor class are eligible for the Best Bred-By Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

BEST PUPPY COMPETITION

RULES: During regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Puppy class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from Puppy class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for the Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete. **NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.**

BEST VETERAN COMPETITION

RULES: During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed/Variety Competition unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from Veteran class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for the Best Veteran Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete. Neutered and spayed dogs and bitches may compete. **NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.**

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Stud Dog may be entered in the Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class - A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made and must be entered in another class. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class" if more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2." Please submit brace entries together.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

Master Class

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

(American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card.
