Health Study

Dr. Court of Washington State University is wanting to look into the Chow breed to see if he can identify it as one that is shown to carry the MDR1 genetic mutation, putting them at higher risks with the use of specific drugs, particularly those used for sedation. He is also wanting to check for the genetic mutation thought to be involved in causing reactions resulting in Malignant Hyperthermia. Cheek swabs will be collected and the DNA tested at no cost to the individual or the club, with results given directly to the owners. All information is kept strictly confidential!

To protect the condition of our rooms for future guests, we have implemented a conduct requirements for our dog show guests. There will be a \$100.00 per room pet fee collected from each guest with a pet. This fee is fixed and will not change regardless of the length of your stay. This fee is refundable.

- Dog(s) to remain in crates while unattended in guest room. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under each crate. Guest to supply own plastic.
- No bathing or grooming of dogs in a guest room. The CCCI and hotel have set aside designated areas for grooming and bathing of animals during your stay.
- No sign of animal urine or excrement in the guest room, hallways or elevators.
- No claw/teeth marks on the furniture, carpet or woodwork.
- No excessive soiled or damaged areas.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Class for Dogs and Bitches
Veteran (7 years of age and older)

Dogs/bitches entered in Veterans need not be intact. Winners, if otherwise undefeated are eligible for Best of Breed competition

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (National Only)

Note: Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered as the Stud Dog & spayed females may be entered as the Brood Bitch.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS - For Stud Dogs and at least two and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the AKC Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard of the breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS - Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS - Two dogs with at least one or more common owner. The two dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. Dogs entered in each Brace Class Unit must each also be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class at this show. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc.

First Place only to be awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to First Place.

TEAM CLASS - Four dogs of the same breed with at least one or more common owner, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. The four dogs comprising a Team MUST be named at time of entry. Dogs entered in each Team Class Unit must each also be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class at this show. An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Team MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Team Class." If more than one Team is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be designated "Team No 1, Team No 2," etc.

First Place only to be awarded. A Rosette will be awarded to First Place.

PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS (NON-COMPETITIVE)

The Parade of Champions, Titleholders is open to all Chows with an official title from a registering body (AKC, UKC, Canadian, CH, CD, RA, etc.) your Chow does not have to be entered in any class at the show. Each dog will be presented with a Rosette. Entry fee for parade is \$20.00. Form is on Page 21.

AWARDS OF MERIT - NATIONAL SPECIALTY & REGIONAL SPECIALTIES

Awards of Merit may be given at the judge's discretion to no more than 10% of the total entries of dogs and bitches in the Best of Breed judging. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best of Winners awards are made. A rosette will be given to each Award of Merit winner.

BEST PUPPY & BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR - REGIONAL SPECIALTIES (AM and PM)

Best Puppy & Best Bred By Exhibitor judging will held following Best of Breed for those class winners who remain undefeated. No additional entry fee is required.

***** Points For Reserve *****

At the National Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (National Only)

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767. Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES (National Only)

DIVISION OF PRIZE MONEY APPLIES TO SWEEPSTAKES & VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

After 33% of all entry fees is retained by the Club to defray expenses, the remaining monies for each class will be divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes..... 10% of the total entry fees

Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes..... 7% of the total entry fees

The remaining 50% of the entry fees to be paid out in individual classes as follows:

First..... 20% of the total entry fees for each class

Second..... 15% of the total entry fees for each class

Third.....10% of the total entry fees for each class

Fourth..... 5% of the total entry fees for each class

In cases where less than 4 specimens are shown, the payout will be determined as if the four were shown and the undistributed money shall accrue to CCCL.

SWEEPSTAKES

The Sweepstakes are open to all Chow Chows who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. Champions of Record are eligible. Dogs shown in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes with the regular entry, fee and on the official entry form. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class."

Indicate the Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division.

An entry form for a dog entered in another class & entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Class, "Brace Class or Pairs Class." If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace/Pair must be designated "Brace/Pair No 1, Brace/Pair No 2," etc.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
