The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches
Winners of the following classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition if
undefeated in any other class at this show.

Veteran (7 yrs & over)

Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to enter Veteran classes

Gun Dog Class - For Dogs and Bitches that have an AKC Hunting title and/or an IWSCA Working Certificate and/or Working Certificate Excellent and/or an AKC Field Trial Title.

Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition.

The Stud Dog shall be considered one entry and requires one entry fee – this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee, if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Stud Dogs and Brood Bitches may be spayed or neutered.

Generations—The entries in the Non-Regular Class represent 3 generations of an Irish Water Spaniel pedigree in each “Entry”. They are to be exhibited from the oldest to the youngest. In the Generations Class, each entry is judged on the merits of all 3 of the dogs (Example: dog, sire, grandsire). Entries in this class need not all be of the same sex. Spayed/neutered dogs may be exhibited in this class. At least one dog, from each entry in this class must be entered in a regular conformation class. In this Generations Class, each entry is evaluated on the merits of all the dogs presented and the overall consistency on maintaining the standard of the breed through the multiple generations.

A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog.

Each Dog comprising each Generations entry MUST be designated at time of entry.

Awards of Merit

The Irish Water Spaniel Club of America offers Awards of Merit at its National Specialty Show in recognition of the quality dogs that are in serious contention for the top breed awards. It excludes the Best of Breed winner and the Best of Opposite Sex winner that by virtue of their placements have already been recognized. It is entirely the judge's decision whether to give all of the Awards of Merit, only some, or none. The number of awards that may be made is determined by the size of the entry based on the # of dogs competing in the Best of Breed ring including entered Champions of record, any move-ups, Veteran Dogs, Veteran Bitches, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch x 10% rounded up, with no consideration as to sex. AOMs should not be confused with Select Dog and Select Bitch which are AKC awards toward Grand Championship status and are to be awarded per AKC rules.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank **MUST** be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

Sweepstakes

Requirements & Classification

Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Water Spaniels who are at least six (6) months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Specialty Class at the regular entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time, on the same entry form as for Regular Classes. Indicate your "Sweepstakes" Class and age division in the space for "Additional Classes".

Sweepstakes Classifications

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos • Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos
- 12 Mos & Under 15 Mos • 15 Mos & Under 18 Mos

Division of Entry Money as Prizes for Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes

Thirty-five (35%) percent of the total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses.

The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

20% between Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite to Best in Sweepstakes

Best in Sweepstakes: 60% **Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes: 40%**

Remainder to be divided as follows:

- First Place in Each Class 40% of Entry Fee for Class
- Second Place in Each Class 30% of Entry Fee for Class
- Third Place in Each Class 20% of Entry Fee for Class
- Fourth Place in Each Class 10% of Entry Fee for Class

All money not claimed as prizes due to absence shall revert back to the club.

Veteran Sweepstakes

Requirements & Classification

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Water Spaniels who are at least seven (7) years of age on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in the regular Specialty classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided. Entrants need not hold a Champion of Record title to compete.

Veteran Sweepstakes Classifications

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Veteran 7 Yrs & Under 9 Yrs • Veteran 9 Yrs & Under 11 Yrs • Veteran 11 Yrs & Older

Obedience & Rally

REFUNDS: Bitches in Season: Refund of entry will be made for Bitches entered in Obedience and Rally Classes who come in season after entries close. Request in writing must be submitted to the Show Secretary with certificate from a Veterinarian no later than 30 Minutes before regular class judging of that trial.

Classes with jumps will be judged in ascending height order beginning at 12". "Dog" means either sex.

Qualifying Score Required For All Obedience & Rally Prizes
