Notice to Exhibitors & Handlers

- Club Officers, Show Chairman and Chief Ring Steward will not exhibit dogs at these events.
- Car & van parking is \$5 if paid daily. A weekend pass can be purchased on Thursday, Friday and Saturday for \$15, \$12 and \$8 respectively.
- Overnight parking is \$25 per night or \$60 for the weekend; arrivals must be by 9:30pm each day for set-up.
- Electricity is not available on the site nor are there sewer hook-ups.
- Quiet time - generators are to be shut off between 11:30 PM and 6:30 AM. Exceptions are at the discretion of the day's Show Chair.
- **The All-Breed Grooming Shelter provided for Saturday & Sunday will not be available until 8:30 PM Friday due to it being used for Friday's Exhibitor Dinner.**
- Canopies (Pop Up Tents) not permitted outside of Parking areas.
- This is a self clean-up weekend. You are required to take care of your business.
- No grooming tables, exercise pens or crates are permitted under the tents housing rings.
- Smoking is not permitted under the tents housing the rings or the covered all-breed grooming area.
- The health, safety and life of any dog on the grounds is paramount to other property and privacy rights. All vehicle owners on the grounds waive their right to legal actions or damages should it be necessary to rescue dogs from the confines of an overheated vehicle.
- Trophy cards will be given at ringside and it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to claim all awards. Awards not claimed by the end of Group judging will become the property of the kennel club.
- The Lorain County Kennel Club reserves the right to substitute any non-available trophy with one of equal or greater value.
- Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank **MUST** be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

USE OF RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: American Water Spaniels, Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.
