RV Parking

All campers & motor homes part in the designated camping area. Only self-contained units are allowed; no tents allowed for overnight stays. There is no electrical service. Access to the camping area will open at noon on Thursday, August 25th for Pembroke exhibitors. The Sugarbush Kennel Club reserves the right to limit parking to designated areas only. All spaces are 25' by 50' and will be marked off to comply with Health Department regulations. All show and local parking regulations must be observed or vehicle will be towed at owner's expense. There is no dump station on the grounds. No holding tank or gray water dumping permitted on the site. Pump-out service will be available on Saturday; the fee is \$40.00 (cash only). Sign up at the announcer's table by 4:00 pm Friday. No potable water available. Fill tanks before arrival. A dog bathing station and showers are available. There are a total of 70 spaces available for the weekend. Advance reservations are encouraged. Fee for the weekend in advance is \$60.00 or \$80.00 at the gate. No refunds after August 5, 2017. Grooming Area

Grooming space for Pembroke's will be under the Tent near the show ring. THERE WILL NOT BE POWER PROVIDED AND GENERATORS WILL BE PERMITTED. All generators will be required to be placed 6' outside of the grooming tent. The club will provide designated areas with protection around the area to protect generators from cars pulling in and out to unload. Bathing Stations will be located close to Grooming Tent. There is no potable water available.

Access to the show site and grooming tent: Access to the show location and grooming tent will be available at 3:00 pm. on August 24th.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

THE PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI CLUB OF THE WESTERN RESERVE reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

NO SOFT-SIDED CRATES under the grooming tent; crates must be stacked; Ex-pens allowed only outside the grooming tent.

POP-UP TENTS will be allowed in designated areas only.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO FLEXI LEADS, No Halti-type collars, or pinch collars on the show grounds.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Clubs and the Event Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

THE PEMBROKE WELSH CORGI CLUB OF THE WESTERN RESERVE and the Superintendent/Event Secretary are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows.

The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committees will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show grounds at any time while the Show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audio tape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.
