NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. The United States Australian Shepherd Association may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making our entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

Checks for pulled or unacceptable entries will be shredded. No checks will be returned.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The United States Australian Shepherd Association does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

The United States Australian Shepherd Association, their Board, Members and Nestle Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

No outside food or beverage is allowed on Purina Farms property. Violators will be reported to the AKC.

Move-ups

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for herding title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial and that there are open runs available in the class.

Email notice is acceptable.

Livestock

Sheep: Crossbred Barbados/Katahdin. Value: \$100 per head. There will be 5 head per run on the A course.

Ducks: Call. Value: \$50 per head. There will be 5 head per run in all classes and on all courses.

Cattle: Mixed-breed Angus and Charolais Cross. Value: \$1200 per head. There will be 3 head per run in all classes and on all courses.

Exhibitor will pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock caused by his/her dog. Exhibitor will pay the veterinarian bill if the injury is slight.

Entry Method

First Received with preference for Australian Shepherds. All entries will be accepted on the opening date, but only entries for Australian Shepherds will be entered into the trial for the first month. All other entries will be put on a waiting list. On March 1 at 8 am CDT, those entries will be entered in the trial in the order received until the trial limits are reached. Entries received on or after March 1 at 8 am CDT will be entered in the trial in order of receipt regardless of breed until the trial limits are reached.

You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable. A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A or B) and stock you wish to enter for each dog. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope, regardless of the number of classes entered. Envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be treated as invalid entries and returned. Confirmation of entry will be sent via email if an email address is included on the entry form.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

The May 15 trial is open to all AKC herding-eligible breeds nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

The May 16 trials are open to all Australian Shepherds nine (9) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

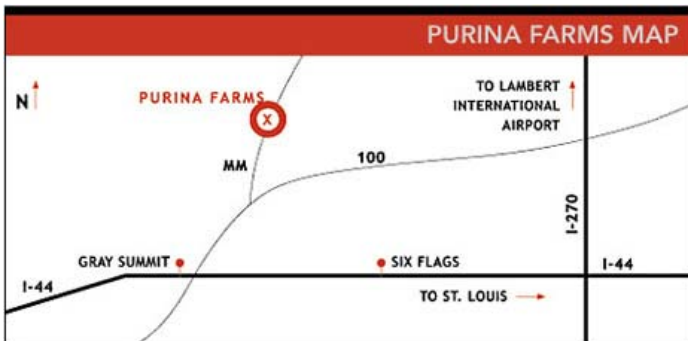
