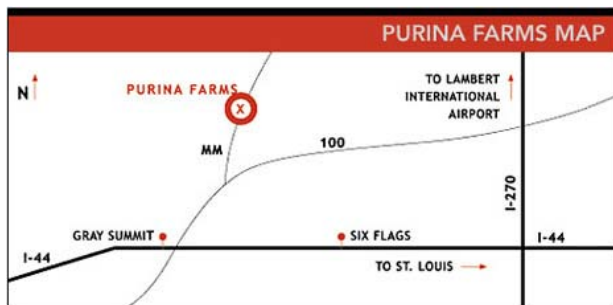

Each judge will be limited to a total of 8 hours of judging time per day.” Obedience & Rally Trials will be limited as follows: Each Judge will be limited to 8 hours of judging each day. When obedience and rally entries are limited, AKC requires that UDX and RAE classes are listed in the premium. Once the trial’s limit has been reached in either Open B or Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial’s limit has been reached in either Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B the RAE class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted. Once the trial’s limit has been reached in Rally Advanced B or Rally Excellent B or Rally Master the RACH class will be considered closed and no additional entries for this class will be accepted.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis will NOT be accepting Rally or Obedience entries for Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, which includes All American/Mixed Breed dogs.

## Best of Breed Competition

## Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

*Note: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed competition*

**Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8, of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males & spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows only.

**Veteran 8-10 years:** A class for dogs and a class for bitches 8 years & under 10 years on the day of the show.

**Veteran 10-12 years:** A class for dogs and a class for bitches 10 years & under 12 years on the day of the show.

**Veteran 12 years and older:** A class for dogs and a class for bitches 12 years or older on the day of the show.

**Versatility/Hunter Certificate Class:** For Dogs or Bitches that have earned a Junior, Senior or Master Hunter title under AKC rules or that have earned a Versatility Certificate (VC) or Versatility Excellent Certificate (VCX) under GRCA rules. (Photocopy of VC/VCX Certificate must be attached to entry.)

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

**Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**

**Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs**

**Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**

**Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Master Class**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Entry blank **MUST** be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

JUNIORS WITH A DOG ALSO ENTERED IN ANOTHER CLASS OFFERED AT THIS SHOW WHO SUBSTITUTE A DOG NOT ENTERED IN THIS SHOW MUST REMIT THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JUNIOR ONLY AND JUNIOR AS AN ADDITIONAL CLASS ENTRY FEE. JUNIORS WHO HAVE ENTERED JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY WHO THEN SUBSTITUTE ANOTHER DOG WILL NOT BE CHARGED A FURTHER FEE.

## AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box at the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group if offered.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.

- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.

- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.

- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

# **SWEEPSTAKES**

**(Please Read All Rules Carefully)**

**HANDLER:** *The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be either the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made. Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter or legal domestic partner. Step children and legal wards are also included in this definition. In-laws and grandchildren are not considered to be immediate family members. No other individual may take the entry into the ring during judging or check-in. The following individuals are excluded from showing an exhibit in sweepstakes unless they are the sole owner registered with the AKC or co-own the entry with a member of their immediate family (as defined above) or a legal domestic partner:*

- Any individual listed as an agent on any dog in any regular or non-regular class at this or any other show in the previous two years.
- Any individual with an Agent number including, but not limited to an AKC Registered Handler Number or Professional Handlers Association (PHA) number.

*To avoid confusion or question, it is recommended that a photocopy of the registration certificate be included with the entry for a co-owned exhibit.*

## **Puppy Sweepstakes Requirements**

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age on the day of the show, and which is entered in any of the regular classes at the Specialty Show (under the same event number) at which these Sweepstakes are held. AKC Champions of Record are not eligible. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

## **Puppy Sweepstakes Classifications**

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Puppy, 6 Mo & Under 9 Mo • Puppy, 9 Mo & Under 12 Mo  
Junior, 12 Mo & Under 15 Mo • Junior, 15 Mo & Under 18 Mo

## **Veteran Sweepstakes Requirements**

Open to any purebred Golden Retriever, eight (8) years of age and over on the day of the show, that is individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). AKC and CKC Champions of Record and neutered or spayed Golden Retrievers are eligible. Entrants need not be entered in any other class. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for "Additional Class".

## **Veteran Sweepstakes Classifications**

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- 8 years & under 10 years • 10 years & under 12 years • 12 years and over

## **Division of Entry Money as Prizes**

(Prize Money for each Sweepstakes event will be determined from the total collected for that event rounded to the nearest dollar.)

Thirty-five (35%) percent of the total entry fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remainder of monies is to be divided in each class as follows.

Best in Sweepstakes .....	20% of the total entry fees

In classes with jumps, the judging order will be short to tall jump height (ascending) beginning at  
4" on Friday and Sunday; Tall to short (descending) beginning at 26" on Saturday.

Qualifying score required for all prizes

A Dark Green Qualifying Ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a Qualifying Score

"Dog" means either sex

Transfers will be allowed per AKC regulations

PLEASE NOTE: Refund of entry fees (less \$10 per entry) for bitches entered in Obedience or Rally that come in season after the closing date of these shows may be obtained provided that a veterinarian's certificate and a request in writing is received by the Show Superintendent 30 minutes before the start of regular judging.

Obedience and Rally Trials - Entries for Golden Retrievers only will be accepted until closing; all other breed entries will be put on a waiting list. At closing entries from other breeds will be accepted into the trial in order of receipt until the limit is reached.

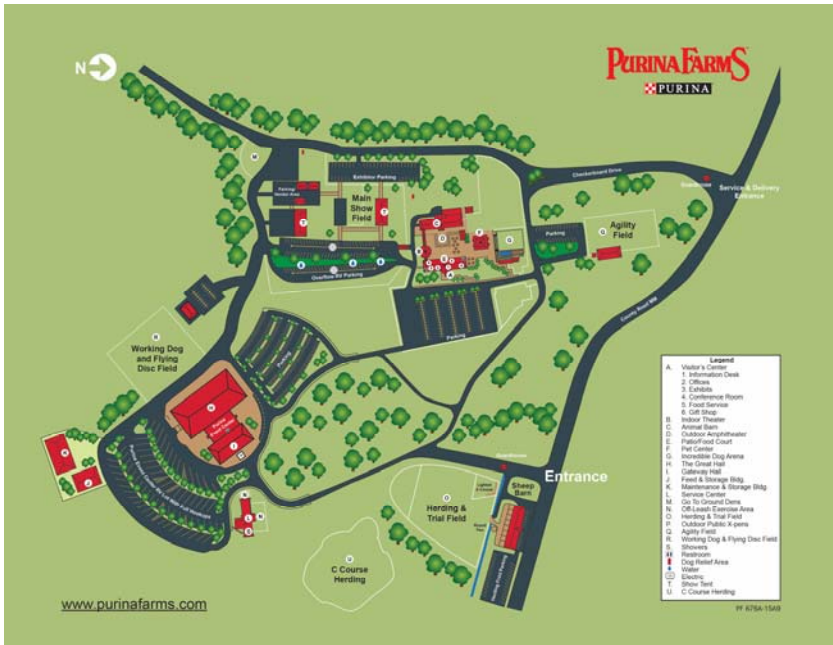
## Attention Exhibitors

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel and show grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels or the show site can result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same. All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the show grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the show-giving club and its Show Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No dogs wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "a correction may be made in the sex of a dog, or a dog may be transferred from one division of the Puppy Class to another or between the Puppy and Twelve to Fifteen Month Class at a show prior to judging, and except that dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for a show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show."

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All prizes offered by the Golden Retriever Club of Greater St Louis are through the generosity of its members and friends.
