### Best of Breed Competition

#### Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

**Veteran 7-10 yrs** – Class for dogs and class for bitches 7 years old and under 10 years.

**Veteran 10 yrs & over** – Class for dogs and class for bitches 10 years old and over.

**Veterans Note:** If a dog is entered in both Veteran Class and Best of Breed and is defeated in Veterans, the dog can NOT be shown in Best of Breed. Veterans may be spayed or neutered.

#### Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries National Specialty Only

**Stud Dog Class** – Class for Stud Dogs and no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Entry only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition. Notation must be made on entry form.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class (two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner)** – The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for “Brace Class Only”. In making entries for “Brace Class Only”, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, “Brace Class”. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, “Brace No. 1”, “Brace No. 2”, etc.

*As the judge’s decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.*

## **\*\*Points Available for Reserve\*\***

The Havanese Club of America, Inc. will award at its *National Specialty* a three point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Havanese Club of America, Inc. will award at its *National Specialty* a three point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

## **Puppy Sweepstakes (National Specialty Only)**

The Sweepstakes is open to all Havanese who are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All Havanese entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class at the regular entry class fee. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form, under Additional Classes. The classes will be divided by Age and Sex, and winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes.

## **Veteran Sweepstakes (National Specialty Only)**

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Havanese who are 7 years and older on the day of the show. All Havanese entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class, Veterans Class, or Best of Breed, at the appropriate entry class fee. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form, under Additional Classes. The classes will be divided by Age and Sex, and the class winners will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best Veteran in Sweepstakes.

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.
