AWARDS OF MERIT

The judge may, at her discretion, recall into the ring up to 10% of the total entry, dogs/bitches to receive Judges' Award of Merit Rosettes offered by the Trinity Valley Belgian Sheepdog Club. These Rosettes are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS – SHOW SITE

The Event Center will be available to exhibitors on Friday, April 6, 2018 from 3:00pm to 9:00pm; 6:00am to 10:00pm Saturday, April 7, 2018 through Friday, April 13, 2018. The Event Center will open at 6:00am on Saturday, April 14, 2018 and **All exhibitors are asked to remove all dogs and items from the building immediately upon completion of BOB judging on Saturday, April 14, 2018.**

There are NO night time security personnel on site. NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the building overnight.

CRATING & GROOMING: Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms. NO Ex-Pens allowed inside building at any time. **NO CRATES MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY ON THE FLOORING SURFACE IN THE GREAT HALL. THERE MUST BE PLASTIC OR A RUG UNDER THE CRATE. ALL GROOMING TABLES MUST HAVE RUBBER OR PLASTIC CAPS ON THE END OF THE LEGS OF THE TABLE.** No cones are allowed inside building.

- RV parking in the upper lot of the Events Center will be available 3:00 PM on Thursday, April 5, 2018. All RV and Day parking vehicles must vacate the RV Parking area by 9:00 AM on Sunday, April 15, 2018. Lower RV lot is available 3:00 PM on Thursday, April 5, 2018.

- **All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. NO day parking on Level A, B, C or D - RV parking lot.** All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

- **NO SMOKING (including electronic cigarettes) IN ANY OF PURINA FARMS BUILDINGS.**

- **NO EX-PENS** allowed on the grass around the Events Center or in the Event Center. This includes the Gateway Hall.

- **No Ringside crating in the Great Hall-** With the exception of the Agility, Obedience and Rally Trials.

ALL CRATES MUST BE PLACED ON A RUG OR MAT IN THE GREAT HALL.

- All food and beverages must be purchased through the on-site food concession. Purina prohibits exhibitors bringing their own food or beverages into the Event Center. The Checkerboard Café is located close to both the Great Hall and Gateway Hall and offers a wide selection of food including daily specials and comfortable seating for 60 people. Violators will be reported to the AKC.

- **ACCESS** - The front Purina Farms entrance/exit gate is manned daily by a security guard from 6a.m. – 6p.m. to allow access to the property. Gates may be closed outside of these hours, but access to and from the property is still possible by pushing a call button at the gate or calling security at 636-221-1428 or 314-982-2217. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave.

PARKING: Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No Ex-Pens or Crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed on grass areas. No cones allowed in parking areas. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

- **Overnight RV** parking is by reservation only. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense. Refer to information in the RV Parking Reservation Form.

- **Day Parking** in the RV parking area is prohibited. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense.

- **Day Only Parking** is limited to the designated hard surface parking lots.

- **Handicapped** parking is available in areas marked.

- **All dogs** must be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged).

- **Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

- **Rabies Vaccination Certificate** - Missouri requires you to have proof of current rabies vaccination with you. Tags are not accepted.

- **TVBSC, Purina, the Superintendent/Event Secretary** and their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility or liability for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or spectators, their family, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

EXHIBITORS & GUESTS

No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance."

These are separate divisions of Purina and are not part of the show grounds. No person or dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center. There are no baby strollers allowed inside the building. No cones allowed inside building. No firearms allowed on Purina Property. No helium balloons allowed in either Hall. No glitter or confetti allowed in the facility. No Duct Tape to be used in the facility. Only painter's tape or gaffer's tape may be used.

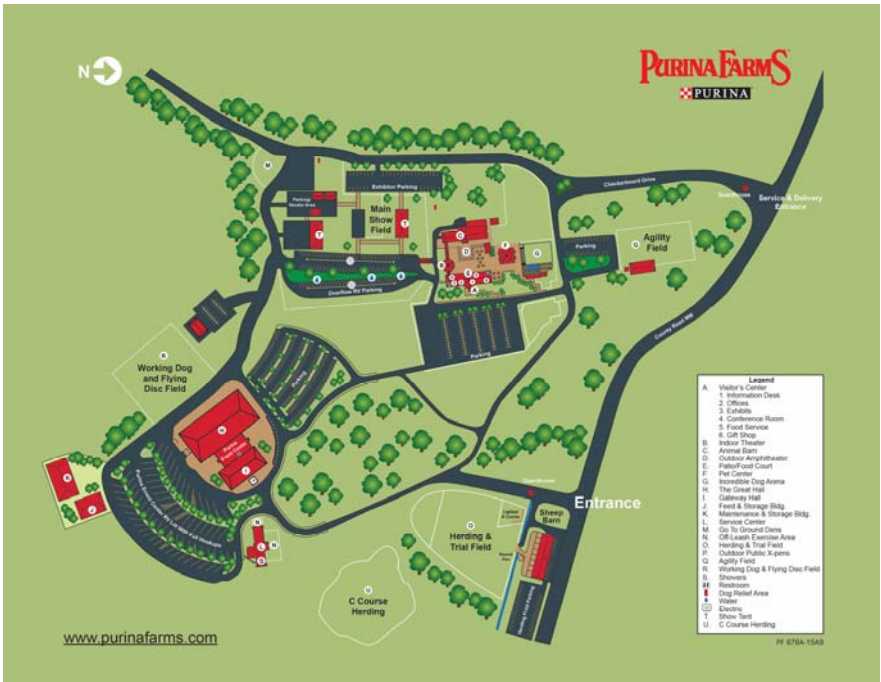

Fax Machine entries for this show will be accepted up to closing time (central time zone). Both sides of entry form must be submitted. For MasterCard/Visa card holders ONLY. A \$4.00 charge will be added to **each** entry. Be sure to include the cardholders name, address, card number, expiration date & signature. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge will be added.

Fax number: (888) 685-8989. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible FAX entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 4).

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
