## Best of Breed Competition

### NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES (for Dogs and Bitches)

#### Veterans

Veterans 8 Years & under 11 Years • 11 Years & Older

Each Veteran Class Winner is eligible for Best of Breed Competition, provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class  
Chapter 11, Section 8, neutered dogs & spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veteran Classes.

#### Herding Titled

Herding Titled (Dogs/Bitches must be intact)

This class is offered to honor those dogs and bitches who have distinguished themselves in the job for which the Belgian Tervuren was bred. Dogs and bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC herding titles (HT, PT, HS, HSAd, HSAC, HSBd, HSBs, HSBC, HSCs, HI, HIAd, HIAc, HIBd, HIBs, HIBc, HICs, HX, HXAd, HXAs, HXAc, HXBd, HXBs, HXBc, HXCc, HC) by the close of entries. Herding Instinct Certificates do not meet the eligibility requirements of this class. Entries must be intact (no spayed or neutered bitches/dogs allowed), and may or may not have a Championship. Winners will be eligible to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class.

### NON-REGULAR (Additional) CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Please Note: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition with the Stud Dog class being an 'Additional Entry' or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the Regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard of the Breed.

**Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog but substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class:** A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry and Must be entered in another conformation class. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace unit must be so designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. PLEASE SUBMIT BRACE ENTRIES TOGETHER.

The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring approximately 10% of all dogs/bitches eligible for Best of Breed competition, to be awarded an American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. Gold Medallion.

These Awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry.** *Junior Handler Identification Number may be obtained by calling the AKC Judges Department at (919) 233-9767*  
Entry blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

The Honor Parade is limited to dogs and bitches not entered in any regular or non-regular (including Veterans) Conformation class. Honor Parade entrants may be entered in Veterans Sweepstakes and/or Performance events. A Show Secretary, Show Chairperson and any Specialty Judge who has completed their assignment may enter their eligible Tervuren in the Honor Parade.

*Per ABTC Guidelines*, the **Rescue Parade** is limited to dogs and bitches that have been placed through the Belgian Tervuren Rescue Inc or other rescue organizations and having their status as Tervuren established by an AKC number or ILP number. All Rescue dogs shall be altered. Dogs that have been "rehomed", returned to the breeder and/or through the breeder has found a new home, are not eligible for the Rescue Parade. Rescue dogs are not eligible to compete in any Conformation event at the National, but may be entered in any Performance event as well as the Rescue Parade. There is no age limitation.

## **Policy on Standard of Behavior by ABTC Members Attending National (and other) Specialty Shows**

The ABTC has an excellent history of maintaining its Specialty headquarters and show site in good condition. Rings, grooming areas and hotel rooms occupied by its members are expected to be left with no appreciable damage, and as clean as possible, after the Specialty is over. As a measure of insuring that this standard will be met, the Club, as a matter of policy sets forth the following standards of behavior.

1. No dogs should be left uncrated in a hotel room in the absence of the room occupants at any time.
2. Dogs that constitute a nuisance to other occupants of the hotel by continual barking or howling, may subject their owners to being removed by the hotel.
3. There will be **no** grooming of dogs in the hotel rooms. Grooming will be permitted only in the areas set aside for that purpose.
4. No Dogs should be washed in hotel bathtubs and hotel towels should not be used on dogs for drying them or any other purpose.
5. The external and internal premises of the hotel and show site shall be kept free of debris and feces caused by the presence of dogs attending the Specialty.
6. The Club will provide a committee to inspect rooms upon member checkout, either separately from, or in concert with, designated members from the hotel staff. Should any room or its contents exhibit signs of unusual wear or damage because of the presence of a dog or dogs, the occupant of that room may be held up to censure by the Club and shall recompense the hotel for all damages. Offenders may be censured, held in suspension of membership or expelled from membership in the ABTC should the circumstances warrant.
7. While the ABTC cannot assume legal responsibility for the actions of individual persons attending one of its national specialties, it does assume ethical responsibility for their actions. it will make every effort to assure that any offending person make redress to the hotel or show site in the event that he/she is responsible for damage to the premises.
8. The ABTC urges its members to carefully inspect their rooms prior to checkout.

**All members of the ABTC are expected to adhere to these Standards.**

### **The Specialty Committee additionally requires that:**

1. Exhibitors are not to bring litters of puppies to the Show Headquarters.
2. Non-ABTC members attending the **2018 National Specialty** will adhere to these standards.
3. All dogs will be on a leash at all times.

By exhibiting at the National Specialty, you are agreeing to abide by the rules established by the show committee and the host hotel. Failure to follow these rules will result in removal from the host hotel.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS – SHOW SITE

The Event Center will be available to exhibitors on Friday, April 6, 2018 from 3:00pm to 9:00pm; 6:00am to 10:00pm Saturday, April 7, 2018 through Friday, April 13, 2018. The Event Center will open at 6:00am on Saturday, April 14, 2018 and **All exhibitors are asked to remove all dogs and items from the building immediately upon completion of BOB judging on Saturday, April 14, 2018.**

There are NO night time security personnel on site. NO DOGS will be allowed to remain in the building overnight.

**CRATING & GROOMING:** Grooming and crating in designated areas only. Bathing of dogs limited to bathing area, located next to grooming area. No dogs allowed in bathrooms. NO Ex-Pens allowed inside building at any time. **NO CRATES MAY BE PLACED DIRECTLY ON THE FLOORING SURFACE IN THE GREAT HALL. THERE MUST BE PLASTIC OR A RUG UNDER THE CRATE. ALL GROOMING TABLES MUST HAVE RUBBER OR PLASTIC CAPS ON THE END OF THE LEGS OF THE TABLE.** No cones are allowed inside building.

- RV parking in the upper lot of the Events Center will be available 3:00 PM on Thursday, April 5, 2018. All RV and Day parking vehicles must vacate the RV Parking area by 9:00 AM on Sunday, April 15, 2018. Lower RV lot is available 3:00 PM on Thursday, April 5, 2018.

- **All exhibitors MUST abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Event Center. NO day parking on Level A, B, C or D - RV parking lot.** All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

- **NO SMOKING (including electronic cigarettes) IN ANY OF PURINA FARMS BUILDINGS.**

- **ACCESS** - The front Purina Farms entrance/exit gate is manned daily by a security guard from 6a.m. – 6p.m. to allow access to the property. Gates may be closed outside of these hours, but access to and from the property is still possible by pushing a call button at the gate or calling security at 636-221-1428 or 314-982-2217. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave.

**PARKING:** Exhibitor and visitor parking will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center. Vehicles are limited to one parking space. No Ex-Pens or Crates allowed on blacktop, but are allowed on grass areas. No cones allowed in parking areas. All vehicles must leave their headlights on while unloading. NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED NEXT TO BUILDING OR IN ANY ROADWAY. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

- **Overnight RV** parking is by reservation only. Violators will be asked to move or be towed at owner's expense. Refer to information in the RV Parking Reservation Form.

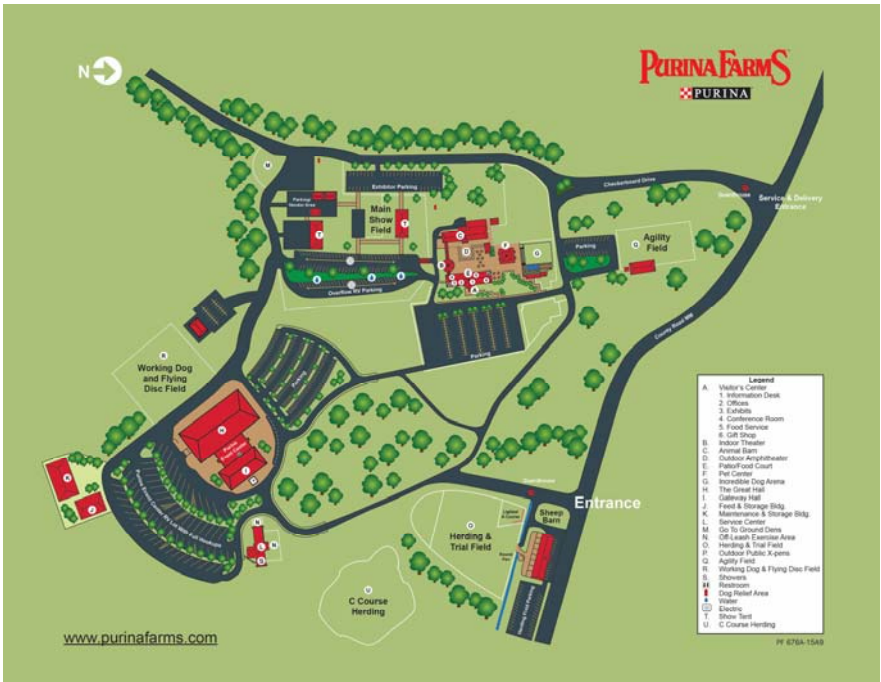

- Reservations are **REQUIRED** for all RVs at this site. Any rig not on the RV chair's paid reservation list may be locked with a boot or be subject to being towed at the owner's expense.
- All RVs and accompanying cars must have visible parking tags provided by the organization hosting the event or Purina Farms security. No sharing of hook-ups with non-paying RVs. Vehicles without proper documentation will be asked to move or leave depending on the circumstance. Purina Farms reserves the right to tow any vehicle without proper documentation at the owner's expense.
- All RV overnight guests are asked to check-in upon their arrival with a member of the organization hosting the event if during normal hours of operations, or with Purina Farms security by calling 636-221-1428 to be escorted to their RV spot.
- Please note that quiet hours on the property are 11p.m. – 6a.m. RVs coming or going during these hours should be respectful of other campers and be as quiet and non-disruptive as possible.
- Only cars (max of 2 OR 1 car and a tow vehicle) affiliated with the RVs parked in the spots will be allowed to park in the same spot in the RV lot. Any cars not affiliated with the RVs in the spots will be asked to move or be towed at the owner's expense.
- RVs must fit within the designated spots and **CAN NOT** block roadways. Any RVs extending beyond the limits of the spots will be asked to unhook or move, depending on the circumstance.
- In case of a medical emergency in the RV lot in the evening or after hours, guests needing medical attention should leave the lights on their RVs allowing the response team to easily identify the appropriate vehicle.
- Grilling is permitted in the RV lot, but guests should let the coals burn out overnight, bag them the next day and put them in a trash barrel. For safety reasons, no campfires are allowed on the property.
- Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their spaces. Discharge onto the grounds is not permitted. Anyone abusing this privilege may forfeit future parking spaces and could be subject to disciplinary action by the Event Committee, including expulsion from this and all future trials.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
