The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be a combined class for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Class open to only Weimaraner puppies. Best of Breed 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy

Entry and Eligibility requirements include: (For further information see www.AKC.org)

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and AMATEUR STATUS requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

Entry Fee: \$15.00 including AKC recording fee of \$2.00 for each dog. These fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Entries will close Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at the address shown on entry form.

NEITHER BRACE, NOVICE NOR AMATEUR-OWNER HANDLER CLASSES ARE OFFERED

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR CLASS

Shall be for dogs that are:

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;
- Not Champions on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the show;
- The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any classes for which a dog from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. Entering and showing dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If at the end of the 90-day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

AWARDS OF MERIT

A maximum of Three (3) Judge's Awards of Merit Rosettes shall be available for presentation by the Breed Specialty Judge to the Weimaraner he/she holds in high regard. **Weimaraner's** available for these awards shall be selected from the Best of Breed entry, plus Winners Dog and Winners Bitch, along with the Winners of the Veterans. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch and Best of Winners awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition, including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, are eligible for an Award of Merit.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES (all specialties)

Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch

Open to dogs and bitches 7 years old and over. Classes are divided by age: 7 years and under 10 years, 10 years and under 12 years, 12 years and older. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows. Only winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed competition.

TO EXHIBITORS:

SWEEPSTAKES: Both Friday AM and Friday PM shows

Sweepstakes is open to all Weimaraner dogs and bitches 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. There is a \$25.00 entry fee per dog. The Sweepstakes Class must be specified in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form. Thirty percent of the entry fee is retained by The Greater Charleston Weimaraner Club to defray expenses. Seventy percent is allocated toward cash prizes. Each dog or bitch must be entered in one of the regular classes at this show, i.e., Friday AM Sweepstakes must be entered in Saturday AM Specialty and Friday PM Sweepstakes must be entered in Saturday PM Specialty.

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Weimaraner dogs and bitches 7 years old or over on the day of the show. They do not need to be entered in another class. There is a \$25.00 entry fee per dog. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Sweepstakes Classes. The Veteran Sweepstakes Class must be specified in the "Additional Class" space on the entry form. Thirty percent of the entry fee is retained by The Greater Charleston Weimaraner Club to defray expenses. Seventy percent is allocated toward cash prizes.

Best Dog in Veteran Sweepstakes, Best Bitch in Veteran Sweepstakes will win a trophy. The Greater Charleston Weimaraner Club offers rosettes for first place awards, and ribbons for second through fourth place in each class. Rosettes are offered for Best Puppy Dog in Sweepstakes, Best Puppy Bitch in Sweepstakes, Best Dog in Veteran Sweepstakes, Best Veteran Bitch in Veteran Sweepstakes. AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box in the owners' area on the entry form to qualify)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.

The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.

Dogs exhibited by professional handlers on the day of the event are not eligible for this competition. Dogs exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler on the day of the event are not eligible to enter this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to the Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs or the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.*

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parY-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
