Entry Fees

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for the first entry in Rally and \$3.00 for each additional entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

OBEDIENCE/RALLY ENTRIES

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. Bitches in heat may be withdrawn and the entry fee (less \$10.00 per class entered to cover expenses already incurred by the club) returned upon the request of the competitor. Request must be made 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial with a veterinarian’s letter.

The Club will permit a transfer to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a Transfer must be made in writing and presented to the Superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Transfer forms will be available at the Superintendent’s Table. **For Obedience & Rally Trials**, transfers will be allowed provided the class is available and the transfer will not make a judge go over limit. (FYI “available” means a class cannot be created at the Trial. If, for instance, there is no Utility A class - with a judge’s book and a place on the schedule - no one can transfer to Utility A). The same is true of Rally transfers. **For Conformation classes, transfers must be made no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of judging on Monday, September 20, 2021.**

Note: Per AKC rules, your dog’s age for Regular & Non-Regular Conformation entry is calculated as of Tuesday, September 21, 2021 for the 2020 Specialty & Friday, September 24, 2021 for the 2021 Specialty.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

Veterans 8 years & under 10 years • Veterans 10 years & under 12 years • Veterans 12 & older

*Chapter 11, Section 8 "Rules Applying To Dog Shows" provide that a neutered male or a spayed bitch may be entered as a veteran. Winners of the above classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition.

Spayed and neutered animals may enter.

Winners of these Non-Regular classes, if otherwise undefeated, may compete for Best of Breed.

The Keeshonden must be judged on the ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging.

Bred By Exhibitor Requirements

All dogs entered in the Bred By class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record, and an owner or co-owner of the dog.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: Non-Regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed.

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won either of these classes.

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered in one of the Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or, if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed competition. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the dog show rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed.

Brood Bitch Class - same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Stud Dogs & Brood Bitches may be Spayed or Neutered.

Brace Class – Two dogs of the same breed/variety, regardless of sex, and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc.

KCA FUTURITY / MATURITY STAKES 2020 / 2021

The purpose of the 2020 / 2021 KCA Futurity / Maturity Stakes is to incorporate the classes which would have been held in 2020 with those which are to be held in 2021.

FUTURITY STAKES

The futurity stakes will be open only to puppies from litters nominated and bred by members of the Keeshond Club of America and members of its affiliated clubs, co-owners included. Entrants need not be owned by the breeder. All Futurity entrants must also be entered in a regular class in the Specialty Show. The entry blank shall be marked "Also Futurity." An additional entry fee of \$6.00 is required.

To incorporate those eligible for the 2020 futurity with those eligible for the 2021 futurity, four classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Futurity 2021

Puppy: Born July 15, 2020 – October 14, 2020

Junior: Born April 15, 2020 - July 14, 2020

Intermediate: Born January 15, 2020 – April 14, 2020

Senior: Born October 15, 2019 – January 14, 2020

The entire amount of fees collected will be divided as follows:

10% Expenses

25% to the Breeder in Best in Futurity

15% to the Breeder in Best Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity

The remaining monies in each class will be divided and paid to the owner as follows:

First 40% Second 30% Third 20% Fourth 10%

MATURITY STAKES

The Maturity Stakes will have 3 classes instead of the usual 2 classes. The Senior Maturity class includes ONLY those dogs that were entered in Futurity in 2019. All Maturity entrants must also be entered in a regular class in the Specialty Show. Indicate your maturity class in the space provided for "Additional Class." An additional fee of \$6.00 is required.

Maturity 2021

Junior: Born May 15, 2019 – October 14, 2019

Intermediate: Born October 15, 2018- May 14, 2019

Senior: Born October 15, 2017 – October 14, 2018

25% to the Breeder in Best in Maturity

15% to the Breeder in Best Opposite Sex in Best of Maturity

The remaining monies in each class will be divided and paid to the owner as follows:

First 40% Second 30% Third 20% Fourth 10%

Futurity and Maturity in 2022 would follow the same pattern allowing for year adjustments and 2023 will be back to the system used prior to 2020.

Obedience & Rally

Include jump height on entry form for classes requiring jumps.
Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers with multiple dogs in the same class.

“Dog” refers to either sex

Qualifying Score required for All Awards in Regular and/or Optional Titling Classes

Obedience/Rally Ring Size: 40’ x 50’

Obedience Trial (Both trials)

Obedience classes with jumps will run short to tall on both days.

Veterans (Tuesday only)

Veterans is for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial, exercises performed and judged as in the Novice class.

Brace (Friday only)

Brace class is for two dogs shown unattached or coupled working in unison at all times, handled by one handler. Separate official entry forms needed for each dog entered. Please identify other entries comprising the unit on the entry form. Single entry fee applies to the unit.

Rally Trial (Both trials)

Rally classes with jumps will run tall to short on both days.

Rally Teams Novice (Thursday only)

Rally Teams Novice is a team of any 4 dogs by either a single handler or multiple handlers that run the course individually back-to-back with team time running continuously. Total possible score of 400 points (100 per dog). Each dog requires an entry fee. Separate official entry forms needed for each dog entered. Please identify other entries comprising the unit on the entry form.

****Points Available for Reserve****

The Keeshond Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winners (Dog & Bitch) if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

CLASSIFICATION OF JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes - are each divided by age. A Junior class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

The Intermediate class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Per the AKC Action dated April 9, 2020, Junior Handlers who turn 18 on or after March 31 may compete until October 31. This will encompass the qualifying period for both the AKC National Championship (ANC) and Westminster.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF A DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S):

There will be an administrative fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of a dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Junior Showmanship was an additional entry and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

During the event, the Breeders Education Committee will collect generic information on the sex, height, and number of dogs wicketed and will compare to results from wicketing at the 2019 KCA National. A summary will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

RESERVED SEATING

TOP KEESHOND EVENT

The purpose of the Top Keeshond Event is to provide a single competition, judged by three unannounced judges, for the top-ranking Keeshonden during the previous calendar year. It is an opportunity to showcase and appreciate some of the best dogs the Keeshond fancy has to offer, and is intended to be both educational and enjoyable, serving to advance knowledge and appreciation of the breed.

To be invited to participate in the Top Keeshond Event, a dog must be ranked in the top 25 Keeshonden for the previous calendar year. In addition, if the top 5 ranking bitches do not appear on the previously stated list, they will also be deemed eligible to compete. Tabulation for eligibility will be based on Keeshonden defeated as a result of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex wins from January 1 through December 31 of the year preceding the competition.

The extraordinary circumstances of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic which resulted in the cancellation of the 2020 KCA National Specialty originally scheduled for April of 2020, the qualification criteria for the 2020-2021 Top Keeshond Event have been modified to include the Keeshonden ranked in the top 25 for both the calendar years of 2019 and 2020.

THE FORMAT FOR THE 2020-2021 TOP KEESHOND EVENT:

Each entrant will be given a specific ring time. Entrants will be judge in groups of three, allowing opportunity for each of the three judges to individually perform a hands-on examination, followed by each entrant being judged on movement by all three judges simultaneously. The grand finale will feature the introduction of each of the TKE entrants as they circle the ring to their chosen musical selection, followed by the announcement of the Top Keeshond Event Winner.

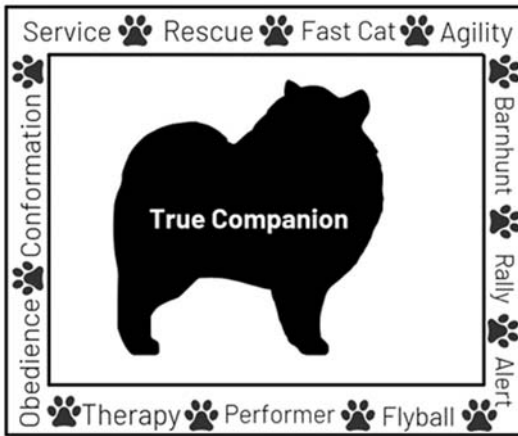

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed. **CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent/Event Secretary and the Clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO FLEXI LEADS, No Halti-type collars, or pinch collars on the show grounds.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Clubs and the Event Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club Rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Keeshond Club of America & Heart of America Keeshond Club and the Superintendent/Event Secretary are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows. The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committees will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS EVENT hereby waive any claim for damages against the Clubs, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

FOR THE WELL-BEING of all exhibitors & dogs, the Show Committee reserves the right to limit the use of generators in some areas.
