Introducing our Judges

We have tried to select judges who you as exhibitors would like to show under. To familiarize you with these judges in case you do not know them, we are including a brief biographical sketch for each.

James E & Anne Marie Taylor - Jim & Anne Marie are celebrating their 50th Anniversary this summer They have two sons and five grandchildren. Jim Owned a residential construction business and they are currently in the process of restoring a 119 year old mansion to its former beauty. The house has been accepted to the National Historical Registry. Ann Marie graduated from University of Michigan with degrees in Applied Science/Dental Hygiene, Secondary Education Earth Science, Physical Geology, Biology/Anatomy & Physiology and Health/Public Health Education. She worked as the Genessee County Head Start/Early Head Start Services Coordinator.

Jim & Anne Marie have owned, bred and shown Akitas since 1974. They bred their first litter in 1991 out of their Am/Can Ch Michiko O Ryan, TT, ROMPX. Michiko is still the top producing bitch of AKC champions. They have bred "Best in Show" and "Best in Specialty" as well as "Register of Merit" Akitas. Most of their champions were breeder/owner handled.

The Taylors have also co-owned Alaskan Malamutes, BISS Martina won the Alaskan Malamute Club of America National Specialty in 2013 & 2015 as well as the Top 20 competitions in 2013, 2014 & 2016. Their GCh Clarence lives with them and assisted Anne Marie as her Registered Service Dog after her back surgery in 2017. What a blessing! Gotta love Working Dogs!

The Taylors are approved to judge the entire Working and Herding groups. They have judged overseas including in Russia, Canada, China and Ireland.

Wendy Sorrell – I grew up in the Portland, Oregon area where my mother raised and showed German Shepherd Dogs and Pembroke Welsh Corgis. I have been exhibiting in conformation since 1964. I have owned, bred, and successfully shown Akitas under the Subaru prefix since 1979. My husband Mark and I, along with our three Akitas, Moved to East Tennessee in the Fall of 2020 from Washington State.

My involvement in the sport of purebred dogs has been a lifelong one. The highlight of my judging career was the opportunity to judge at the 2014 Akita Club of America National Specialty where I was invited to judge over 100 class animals. I am approved to judge Akitas, Alaskan Malamutes, Siberian Huskies (permit status) and hope to add Samoyeds and Doberman Pinschers within the year. The northern spitz breeds are of special interest to me and I have studied the Siberian since 1980. Over the years I have had the opportunity to evaluate litters, follow young Siberians as they grew out to full maturity and veteran years, help present youngsters in the ring and appreciate the Siberian in their homes as the great pack dogs they are.

Thank you to the membership of the Siberian Husky Club of Middle Tennessee. I am honored to be given this excellent opportunity.

Bridget J. Brown – My late husband, Jack and I have been Boxer breeders since the early 1970's. We have bred over 33 champions, finished 75 champions, and bred 1 Dam of Merit and 3 Sires of Merit. I worked for BellSouth/AT&T for 45 years and retired in 2015. After judging our Boxer National Futurity and Top 20, I decided to pursue all-breed judging, focusing on the Working Group. I currently have 2/3 of the Working Group and 3 Sporting breeds. I have been judging Siberians for several years and so enjoy and appreciate this breed. I continue to educate myself on the breeds I am entrusted to judge. This is your breeding stock and I know how important my decisions are for the future of your breeding programs. I am honored to be asked to judge your specialty.

Kim Griffith – Kim was first introduced to the world of conformation in the late 1960's with his parents' Newfoundland dog Barney. From that affinity he has continued handling dogs, apprenticing under the Great Sporting Dog Handler Dick Webb, amongst others, before going out and becoming known for handling top dogs in the Sporting, Working, and Herding Groups.

He has bred Newfoundlands, Golden Retrievers, Australian Cattle Dogs, and Smooth Fox Terriers, and now back to his roots, he once again breeds and shows Newfoundlands with wife Gigi under the kennel name of Oceano. His passion for the breed has been rewarded with many titled Working Dogs, titled Obedience Dogs, Champions, and Versatile Newfoundlands, along with top show dogs and Regional and national Specialty winners.

His many years in the Sport has led him to judging those breed he is familiar with and understands, in the pursuit of our common goals ... that of finding the best examples of the particular breed in terms of type, structure, and soundness.

Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and/or photocopies without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Entry Forms must be signed. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Any award won by dogs with invalid entries because of insufficient funds will be rescinded.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 are required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee and Event Service Fee are collected by the Show Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording and the Event Service Fees are collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These AKC fees are included in the Entry Fees stated in this premium. This Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

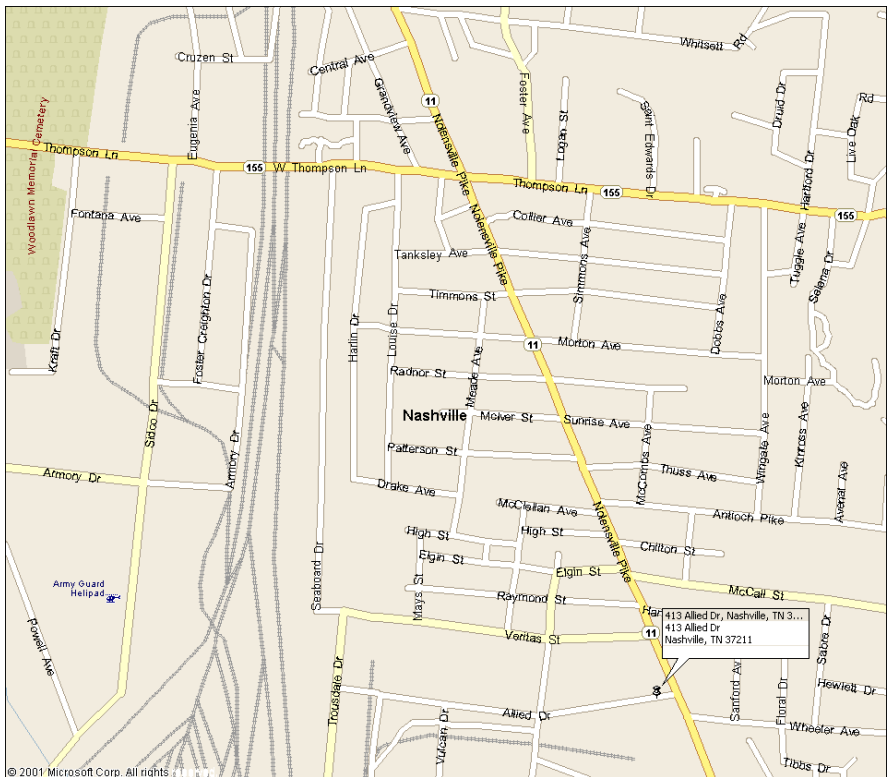
HOTELS AND MOTELS
