

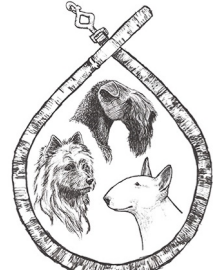

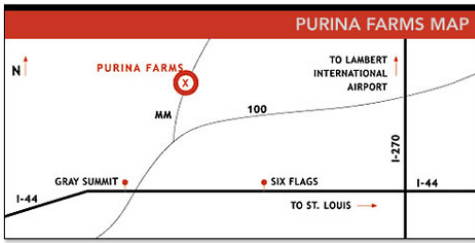

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS is for Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Offspring only to be judged based on their merits. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Conformation Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Conformation Class (*other than the Stud Dog Class*) at this show.

BROOD BITCH CLASS same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Product for Get where appropriate.

A castrated male may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS two dogs of the same Breed or Variety of Breed with one or more common owners and both dogs must be entered in another class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class

Best Puppy

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos and under 9 mos and the 9 mos and under 12 mos. classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will elect a Best Bred-by-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

Best Veteran

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the winners of the Veteran Classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed competition judging unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Veteran Class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Veteran Class are eligible for Best Veteran Competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete.

Award of Merit

May be given to one dog and one bitch, at the discretion of the judge to outstanding entries in final consideration for Best of Breed. All of those in Best of Breed Competition are eligible except Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch and Best of Winners, as the judge has already found them worthy of merit by the virtue of their win.

Award of Merit

Award (s) of Merit may be given at the discretion of the judge to recognize quality dogs and bitches in Best of Breed competition. REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER:

1. **Dogs entered must be presented in groups of 3, in which at least two of the three dogs entered must be from different litters.**
2. **The breeder entering the trio must be a breeder of record on all three dogs, and must be the first handler for the trio.**
3. **Dogs entered must be six months of age or older. Altered dogs and bitches are eligible to compete.**

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS:

1. You, the breeder, do not have to own any of the dogs, however, you **must** be one of the breeders of all three dogs. You must handle the first dog.
2. The dogs entered in this class do not need to be entered in any other classes.
3. With permission from the judge, the breeder (first handler) can have a "runner" (someone to move the dog in the ring) if one is needed. It is requested that the breeder handle during the table exam him or herself, even if the second person must assist in getting the dog on and off the table. So, if you are disabled or otherwise unable to show your own dog, you are allowed to have an assistant move and/or lift your dog in the ring.
4. Each dog will have a handler with a number, all dogs will be pre-entered and listed in the catalog. **Questions:** contact Linda Freeman at LMFreeman1959@gmail.com.

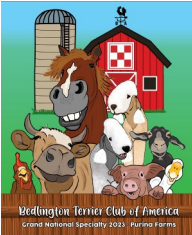

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotto Romagnolo, Retrievers (Nova Scotia Duck Tolling), Spaniels (American Water), Spaniels (Boykin), Spaniels (English Springer), Spaniels (Field), Spaniels (Welsh Springer), Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Spanish Water Dogs, Norrbottenspets (Misc).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ramp, or on a table: Mudi (Misc).

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Spaniels (Clumber), Spaniels (Sussex), Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In emergency situations where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

Your space will be identified by a card on the floor with your name. Exhibitor will be able to access their Reserved Grooming spaces as of **3:00 PM** on Wednesday, **May 31, 2023**.

Unreserved Grooming Spaces (free spaces): Limited free grooming space will be available on a first come, first served basis beginning at **3:00 PM** on Wednesday, May 31, 2023. This area of free grooming space, within the Gateway Hall (Grooming Building) of the Purina Event Center, will be clearly marked. Exhibitors are required to stack crates and limit the number of grooming tables to maximize space.
