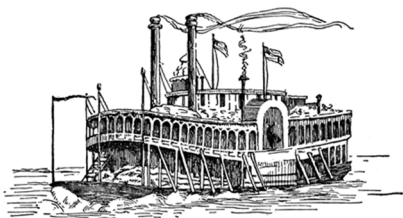

**IMPORTANT COVID-19
INFORMATION**

An inherent risk of exposure to communicable diseases exists in any public place. Communicable diseases can be extremely contagious and/or lead to severe illness and death. The Kentucky COVID restrictions have been lifted, but may change as the CDC communicates their recommendations. For anyone who has entered or attending any event being held on the grounds including judges, exhibitors, vendors and others; this is the notice to the change of restrictions. Judges are to adhere to the applicable state, local, facility and club guidelines in place at the time the event is held. If the guidelines for all of the regulatory parties allows individuals to not wear masks and the premium does not require masks, judges may not require exhibitors to wear masks in the ring. However, we strongly suggest that if your judge is wearing a mask in the ring, that all entering the ring should also wear a mask.

NOTICE

We will allow dogs and equipment in the building overnight. With this in mind, we will limit the number of grooming tables to one grooming table per four (4) dogs entered. We will expect that crates be stacked and use of chairs limited. This rule will be strictly enforced in order to provide adequate space for all attending. The show committee reserves the right to move, arrange or assign grooming set-ups. No roping off or saving space. We are offering this policy to keep you and your dogs safe and cool. PLEASE DO NOT ABUSE YOUR USE OF SPACE! If you can groom at your vehicle and limit the amount of equipment brought and left in the building to a minimum, it will be greatly appreciated. Overnight security will be provided.

The use of pop-up tents or exercise pens in parking spaces will not be permitted.

Back doors are unlocked at 6am daily and locked at 10pm.

Lobby is unlocked daily at 7am.

Directions to the Show

From Evansville, IN: Take Highway 41 South through Henderson, KY. Take Exit 12 towards Owensboro. Go approximately 23 miles, then take Exit 24B towards Owensboro/Downtown. Proceed 1/8 mile where road will dead end at this point. Turn right towards downtown. This road will become a one-way street (4th Street) heading east. Follow 4th Street to Frederica Street, turn left on Frederica. Proceed two blocks, make another left on West 2nd Street. Show site will be on right approximately two blocks from the Frederica intersection.

From Bowling Green: Take I-165 North to Owensboro. At end of parkway, take ramp Exit 70B towards Owensboro. Follow bypass to the Frederica Street (Hwy 431) Exit 14. At the bottom of the ramp, take right on Frederica Street heading north. Follow Frederica Street to West Second Street, turn left on West Second Street. Show site will be on right approximately two blocks from the Frederica intersection.

From I-64: Take Dale Exit (Hwy 231 South) towards Owensboro. Follow Hwy 231 South into Owensboro (Approximately 30 miles). Stay on 231 South/US 60 Bypass to Exit 14, Frederica St/US 431. At bottom of ramp, go right on Frederica heading north. Follow Frederica to West 2nd St. Left onto West 2nd St, show site will be on right approximately two blocks from the Frederica intersection.

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, and Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex. Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS AND CLASSIFICATION

(Offered for Chesapeake Bay Retriever Supported Entry Saturday, August 26, 2023)

Professional handlers may only show dogs for which they are an owner of record

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Chesapeake Bay Retrievers who are 6 months but less than 18 months old on the day of the sweepstakes. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Chesapeake Bay Retrievers who are at least 8 years of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. Entrants do not need to be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Entrants may be altered.

Open to all Miniature American Shepherds who are six months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show and who are not Champions of Record with AKC. Dogs must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form.

The following classes and Sweepstakes Shows will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Puppy, 6 Mos & Under 9 Mos • Puppy, 9 Mos & Under 12 Mos
Junior, 12 Mos & Under 15 Mos • Junior, 15 Mos & Under 18 Mos

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS AND CLASSIFICATION

Open to all Miniature American Shepherds who are seven years of age or older. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Dogs entered in **Veteran Sweepstakes may be spayed or neutered.**

The following classes will be offered for both dogs and bitches.

7 years & Under 9 Years • 9 Years and Over

BRED BY EXHIBITOR SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS AND CLASSIFICATION

Open to all Miniature American Shepherds who are six months of age or older. Dogs must be bred and owned by the Exhibitor. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs
Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs
Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

USE OF RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotto Romagnolo, Retrievers (Nova Scotia Duck Tolling, Spaniels (American Water), Spaniels (Boykin), Spaniels (English Springer), Spaniels (Field), Spaniels (Welsh Springer), Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, Basset Fauve de Bretagne (Misc), Norrbottenspets (Misc).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition:

Spaniels (Clumber), Spaniels (Sussex), Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In emergency situations where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. **Please Check www.AKC.org for updates to this list. (eff 6/28/23)**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,* household members and current assistants to professional handlers** may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

RV parking will be available beginning at 12:00 noon (CST), Wednesday, August 23, 2023. You must be parked by a cluster member during the hours of 12:00 noon and 10:00pm, Wednesday, August 23, 2023 and 6:00am to 10:00pm daily, thereafter. Contact Sheril Ray via text only (615) 405-1652 upon arrival.

RV Parking will be available on a reservation only basis. There are 28 spaces on pavement with electrical hookups (30 & 50 amp) available in the Regular lot, one block south of the Convention Center, between Locust and Cedar Streets, entrance at W. 4th Street at \$45.00 per night, and 13 spaces along the streets in front of the convention center (Locust, Walnut and Second Streets) at \$65/night also with 50 & 30 amp electrical hookups. Slides cannot be used on the traffic-side if parking on Second Street per the city. All spaces have access to water to fill fresh water tanks. conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
