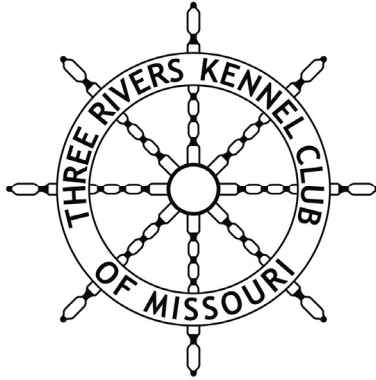

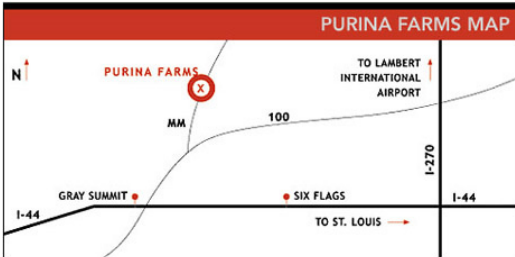

Coursing Dogs: For dogs and bitches that have received an AKC Lure Coursing Field Trial title. Entry in this class is not eligible for Winners Dog/Winners Bitch

Awards of Merit

Otterhounds Only, For Saturday

JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT: At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the judge at her discretion may choose up to 3 of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not eligible for Awards of Merit.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Otterhounds & Pharaoh Hounds Only, For Saturday

STUD DOG CLASS: for Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud dog is entered in another class, The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS (SATURDAY ONLY) same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. A castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

BRACE CLASS (SATURDAY ONLY) The entry fee for a Brace as a UNIT is \$25. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No 1", "Brace No 2", etc.

*There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex.
Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.*

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Indicate Sweepstakes and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes."

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Otterhounds who are 7 years and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in a Regular Class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered Veteran Sweepstakes. Indicate Sweepstakes and age division on the regular entry form under "Additional Classes."

****Please note: Professional Handlers may only show dogs in any sweepstakes class that are owned or co-owned by them.**

AKC Policy is specific in stating that individuals judging sweepstakes or futurity classes are ineligible to exhibit on the day that they judge. This can be found on page 3 of the Rules, Policies and Guidelines for Conformation Dog Show Judges.

Exhibiting and Handling (P) Conformation Judges and household members (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows) may not exhibit any breed and judge on the day of, three days before and the three days after an assignment within 200 miles of the assignment.

Effective January 1, 2009 Sweepstakes and Futurity Judges may not exhibit on the day(s) they judge. Sweepstakes/Futurity judges will continue to be allowed to exhibit the day before and the day after they judge. A multi-day specialty is considered one event, and the restriction will apply for the duration of the event.

Please be advised "exhibiting" applies to the individual personally handling any dogs AND any dogs owned or co-owned by the individual, regardless of who handles them. In addition, judging policies affecting exhibitor eligibility apply to all members of the same household. As a result, the spouse would be ineligible to exhibit on the day he would judge sweepstakes classes.

If an individual has a dog that you bred but you are not the co-owner, that dog may be exhibited in the regular breed classes only. That dog would be ineligible to be entered to you.

Requirements for Puppy Sweepstakes

Sweepstakes is open to all Pharaoh Hounds at least six (6) months of age and under twenty-four (24) months of age on the day of the show. May be a Champion of Record as of the day of closing. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Specialty Class at the regular entry fee. Entries shall be made at the same time, on the same entry form as Regular Classes. Indicate

your "Sweepstakes" Class and age division in the space for "Additional Classes"

Puppy Sweepstakes Classifications

Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes", stating age division in the space for "Additional Classes".

In her professional handling career, Laura consistently maintained a low-number, high-quality client list. Specializing in rare breeds and challenging dogs, she has piloted multiple dogs to Best in Show, Best in Specialty Show, Group wins, #1 rankings and more.

Scotia dogs have earned well over 100 titles: in the show ring, hunt tests, field trials and NAVHDA (North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association); in agility, tracking, obedience and rally. Her dedication to breeding dual purpose dogs reflects a stated goal of preserving the all-weather, rugged, sound-minded gun dog the breed's founders envisioned.

Laura started in dogs competing with an All-American dog in 4H. Later she competed in AKC Junior Showmanship with a Clumber Spaniel. She earned her spending money in high school training field trial Labs with games of baseball to improve their blind retrieves, teaching Clumber Spaniels how to swim and German Wirehaired Pointers to retrieve to hand.

Her background as a newspaper reporter, marketing rep and researcher/writer for audio driving tours has served her well in her side projects. Her current adventure as host of the PureDogTalk podcast lends her particular combination of skills to this exciting exhibitor education platform.

At the age of 13, I showed my first dog at an AKC dog show. This sport of showing dogs became a family activity. The Cabral family's kennel, Briarfield Dalmatians, bred and showed for 27 years. Those formative years helped to build the foundation my career was built upon.

To learn as much as possible about structure, temperament, grooming, and presentation, I apprenticed with four (4) AKC professional handlers for a total of eleven years. After 35 plus years, I look forward to the next chapter in the dog fancy; being an AKC judge. As of January 2023, AKC approved me for my 10 initial breeds permits, half in the Working Group. Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

USE OF RAMPS

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotto Romagnolo, Retrievers (Nova Scotia Duck Tolling, Spaniels (American Water), Spaniels (Boykin), Spaniels (English Springer), Spaniels (Field), Spaniels (Welsh Springer), Grand Basset Griffon Vendéen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs, Basset Fauve de Bretagne (Misc), Norrbottenspets (Misc).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Miniature Bull Terriers.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp, or on a table: Mudi.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Spaniels (Clumber), Spaniels (Sussex), Basset Hounds, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, and Keeshonden.

This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4–6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In emergency situations where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds. **Please Check www.AKC.org for updates to this list. (eff 6/28/23)**

An FSS Open Show is an informal American Kennel Club sanctioned conformation event at which Championship points are not earned but rather Certificate of Merit (CM) points are awarded to this introductory AKC conformation suffix title. The FSS Open Shows are events at which dog clubs, judges, stewards, and exhibitors and their dogs gain experience needed for licensed events.

All of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows will apply to sanctioned FSS Open Shows, except where otherwise stated in these Regulations which are subject to amendment by the AKC Board of Directors.

- Dogs must be at least 4 months of age on the date of the event.

The following breed classes will be offered at the FSS Open Shows:

(All Classes Divided by Sex)

4-6 Month Puppy Class • 6-9 Month Puppy Class • 9-12 Month Puppy Class
Bred By Exhibitor Class • Open Class

- Miscellaneous breeds will be considered equivalent to a Group.
- The Miscellaneous Class winner will compete with the Group winners for Best in Show.
- FSS breeds will be considered equivalent to a Group.
- The Best FSS winner will compete with the Group winners for Best in Show.

FSS Open Show Entry Restrictions

- Dogs less than 4 months of age are ineligible to be on the grounds of licensed or member shows during AKC events.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol (including rabies vaccination) in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.
- No judge or any person residing in the same household with a judge shall exhibit or act as agent or handler at an FSS Open Show at which they are officiating as judge and dogs owned wholly or in part by such judge or any member of their household shall be ineligible to be entered at the show. Subject to the foregoing, members of a judge's immediate family who no longer reside in the same household may enter or handle a dog at a show if the judge is not officiating over any competition, including a group class or best in show, for which the dog is entered or may become eligible.
- No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- The show chair is required to be a member of the show-giving club.
- The show results and event service fee of \$2.00 per entry must be submitted to AKC Event Operations within seven (7) days of the event.
- Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered in this competition.
- FSS Open shows must be judged by judges that have an AKC judges number.
- Judges are expected to comply with Rules Applying to Dog Shows and Rules, Policies, and Guidelines for Conformation Dog Show Judges except as follows:
 - Breed standard disqualifications (i.e. color, height, full dentition, etc.) need not be considered in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy classes and male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified or excused in the 4-to-6 Month Puppy class but the judge's book must describe the condition.
 - In all other classes, male puppies without 2 fully descended testicles need not be disqualified

but should be excused and the judge's book must describe the condition and Certificate of Merit points withheld.

- The speed of judging expectation is reduced to 20 dogs per hour in order to accommodate puppies and inexperienced exhibitors. Judges should interact and encourage exhibitors in order to make their exhibiting a positive experience.
- Judges may ask exhibitors if they prefer to open their dog's mouth for examination. However judges have the authority to personally open the dog's mouth.
- No protests against dogs for height, weight or any other breed specific disqualification may be entertained at FSS Open Shows.
- A dog with a disqualifying condition or behavior shall not be disqualified but shall simply be excused for the day. The judge may only disqualify dogs for attacking in the ring.

Ribbons and Trophies

Ribbons for classes, Groups and Best in Show will be as follows:

- First Prize – Rose • Second Prize – Brown • Third Prize – Light Green • Fourth Prize – Gray
- Best of Breed – Orange • Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed – Lavender
- Best in Show – Pink & Green

All trophies or prizes offered must be awarded for outright award to the owner of the dog.

Certificate of Merit

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs competing in their breed. Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds will be awarded points toward the Certificate of Merit (CM) title based on the total number of dogs competing in their sex. Group winners will be eligible for the points based on the total number of dogs that competed in the Group. Best in Show will be eligible for the points based on the total number of dogs that competed in the show.

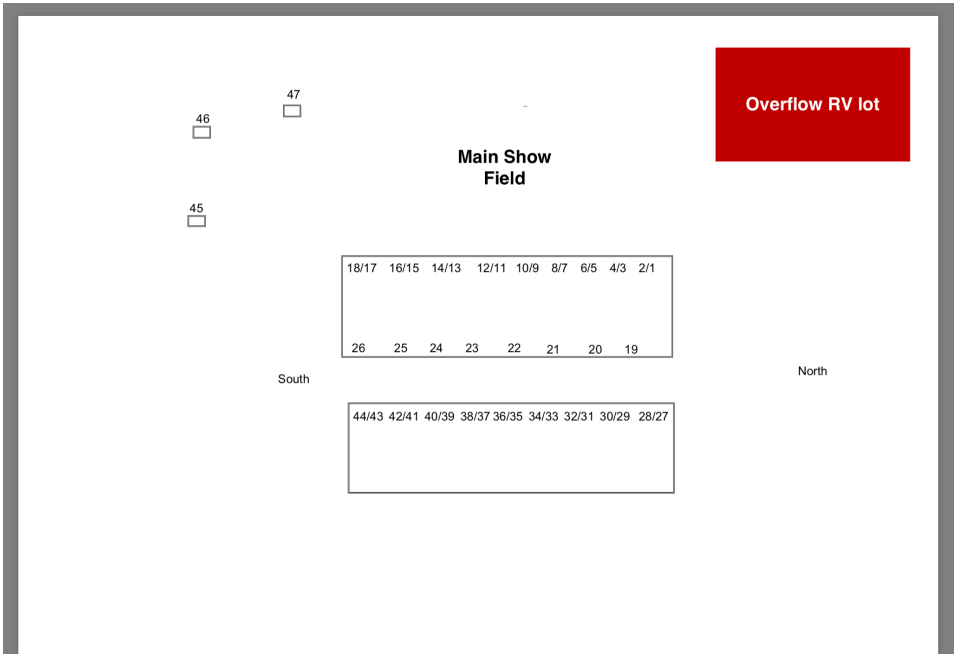
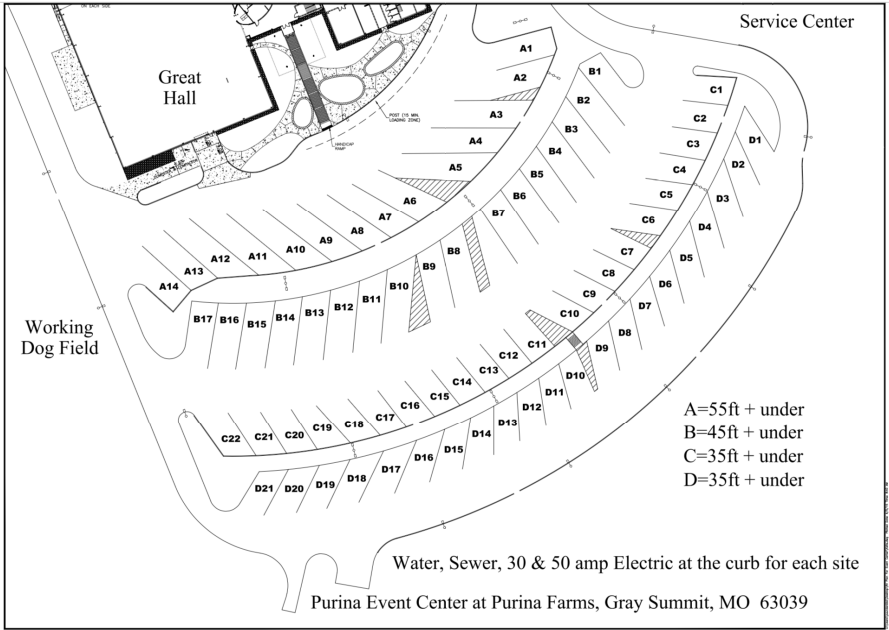

Attention Exhibitors

The Show site is available to exhibitors from 3 PM to 6 PM Thursday, September 14, 2023 and after 6 AM on Friday, September 15, 2023. Set up for Three Rivers reserved grooming & free grooming in the Gateway Hall is available Thursday, September 14, 2023 from 3 PM to 6 PM. Set up for Three Rivers reserved grooming in the Great Hall will be available Thursday, September 14, 2023 following the completion of the National Specialties. Dogs and all equipment must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show Judging of the Three Rivers Kennel Club of Missouri show on Sunday, September 17, 2023.

A security guard will be in the building overnight on Thursday, Sep 14, Friday, Sep 15 and Sat, Sep 16, so dogs may be left in the Purina Event Center overnight on those evenings. In accordance with AKC policy, each dog that is left in in the facility overnight must be identified with a tag stating the owner/agent name and where they can be reached in case of an emergency.
