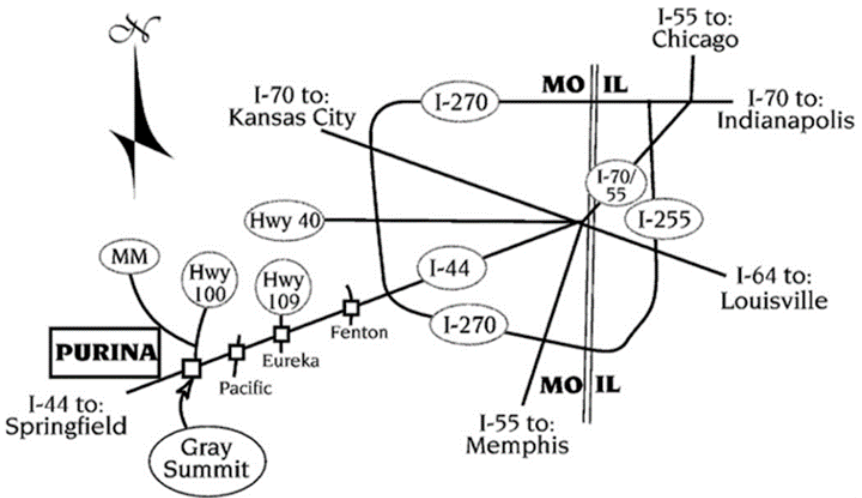

## Versatility Challenge Sept 8th - Sept 12th 2024

To encourage our multi-talented Curly-Coated Retrievers, the CCRCA is sponsoring a Versatility Challenge. CCRCA events happening September 8th through the 12th are eligible. Owners of participating Curlies must be members of the CCRCA. Curlies may be handled by members or nonmembers in any of the events. Curlies need to receive a ribbon in a Field Event (Upland WCs, Retriever WCs), receive a qualifying score in a performance event (Obedience, Rally, Agility or Dock Diving) and receive a ribbon in a conformation event (Sweepstakes/Regular or Non-Regular Classes/BOB).

Curlies who complete the versatility challenge will receive a rosette at the banquet and will be featured in the specialty issue of the Commentator. Visit the Specialty section of the CCRCA.ORG website for rules and entry information.

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

**Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs**

**Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs**

**Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Master Class**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.**

### Best of Breed Competition

#### **Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries**

The following non-regular classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Winners of the Veterans and Working Retriever classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed Competition if undefeated in any other class at this show.

#### **Veteran Class**

**Veteran (7 yrs & Under 9 yrs) • Veteran (9 yrs & Under 11 yrs) • Veteran (11 yrs & Older)**

Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to enter Veteran classes

#### **Working Retriever Class**

A Class for Dogs/Bitches that have a placement or Judge's Award of Merit (JAM) in an AKC licensed or member club Field Trial, an AKC Hunting test title, an AKC Upland title or a CCRC Working Certificate title (WC, WCX, WCQ, UWC or UWCX). The field title must be earned by date of entry. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to enter Working Retriever classes.

#### **Versatility Class**

A class for dogs/bitches of any age. Dogs/Bitches may be spayed/neutered or otherwise altered.

**Winners of the versatility classes are not eligible for Best of Breed Competition.** This class was created for Dogs/Bitches entered in the Versatility Challenge that are not eligible for regular/non-regular classes.

#### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)**

*Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.*

**STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH CLASS:** Each entry is allowed two get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch. The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch MAY be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**BRACE CLASS** (Two dogs of the same breed, one or more common owner) – The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time the entry is made. If a dog which is to be part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog using the individual, regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2."

## Special Attractions

BEST OWNER-HANDLED - the owner-handled box must be checked when entering

BEST PUPPY IN PUPPY CLASSES - must be entered and win a Puppy class; Puppy (6 mos. & under 9 mos.), Puppy (9 mos. & under 12 mos.), or Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy (6-12 mos.)

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR – must be entered and win a Bred-By Exhibitor class: Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy (6-12 mos.) or Bred-By Exhibitor Adult

BEST VETERAN - must be entered and win a Veterans class

BEST WORKING RETRIEVER – must be entered and win a Working Retriever class

**\*\*Points Available for Reserve\*\*** *The Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog/Bitch if the Regular Class entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.*

### AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may select, at his/her discretion up to 6 dogs/bitches to receive Judges' Award of Merit Rosettes offered by the Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America, Inc. These awards are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

**CRUFTS QUALIFICATION 2025** The Curly-Coated Retriever Club of America will consider the classes at this National Specialty Show as a designated International Crufts Qualifying Show. Recipients of the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Bred-By Exhibitor and Award of Merit will receive a Crufts eligibility Qualifying Award Certificate to enter the Crufts Dog Show at the National Exhibition Centre (NEC) in Birmingham, England, United Kingdom. # AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport:

conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for the first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor the Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging.

Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.**

**PUBLICATION RIGHTS** By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
