

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex.

Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

#### VETERAN SPECIAL ATTRACTION

Saturday, November 8, 2025 BEST OF BREED AND BEST IN SHOW

Competition is offered for dogs and bitches seven (7) years and older (divided by sex) from the Best of Breed Veteran through Best Veteran in Show. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to compete. Veteran Best of Breed will be judged following their regular classes in each breed.

# Leonberger Club of America Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

**Note:** Winners from Veteran Classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed competition. If a dog is entered in both Veteran Class and Best of Breed and is defeated in Veterans, the dog CANNOT be shown in Best of Breed.

**Veteran:** A Class for dogs and bitches who are at least Seven (7) Years of Age or Older on the day of the show. Entrants in this class may be spayed or neutered.

# 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition Leonberger Club of America - Saturday

#### Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

# **Pee Wee Competition**

#### Southern Colorado Kennel Club

SATURDAY at Noon • JUDGE: Mr. Bob Eisele

**ENTRY FEE:** FREE – Day of show entry only, limited to 20 entries

Entries close 11:30 am, November 8, 2025

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience—no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation Rosette and each dog will receive a squeaky toy to commemorate the experience!

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show the bite.

# 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

#### Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

#### Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B- matches at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event
  including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging
  schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.

- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers 'organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current
  assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age
  and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner
  Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

# JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs

Master Class

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.** You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.





ATTENTION: There is limited free Open Grooming in the Palace of Agriculture but there will be NO electricity available. NO generators allowed inside buildings. NO sharing of electricity with Reserved Grooming. Violators will be expelled from the building. Open Grooming spaces will be marked, please be considerate of others and take only what space you need. Stacking of crates is encouraged. Roping off or saving of space in Open Grooming will not be allowed. FREE GROOMING WITH ELECTRICITY & COVER is available on the north and south side of the Obedience and Rally building, the Livestock Pavilion – in the covered animal pen area directly across from the Event Center.

#### PROCEDURE FOR OVERNIGHT CAMPING

ALL CAMPERS MUST ENTER THROUGH **GATE 6** ON SMALL AVENUE TO GET INTO THE FACILITY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 AM AND 8:00 PM. ALL OVERNIGHT CAMPERS MUST CHECK IN WITH RV HOST TO OBTAIN A CAMPING PERMIT TO BE VISIBLE IN THE WINDSHIELD. SECURITY WILL BE CHECKING FOR PROPER PERMITS EACH NIGHT. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED BY SECURITY IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THE PROPER CREDENTIALS TO CAMP.

The Reserved Parking area East of the Event Center is for the Superintendent, judges, and Show Committee workers only and a Parking Permit is required.

#### Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 2:00 pm Wednesday. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

Clean up in the ring & on the show grounds is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Ring Stewards will be glad to hold your dog while you clean up. There will be an indoor exercise area inside the Event Center as well as several clean-up stations located throughout the grounds - PLEASE use them.

Electrical & water outlets on the outside of the Event Center building may NOT be used for any purpose.

**NO PARKING** of any kind will be allowed on the west side of the Event Center, building side - violators will be towed at the owner's expense.

NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE BUILDINGS - NO VAPOR CIGARETTES ALLOWED. There will be **NO** exercise pens allowed in the conformation, obedience or grooming buildings. No private exercise pens allowed within 10 feet of any entrance.

There will be **no grooming** of dogs in the conformation ring or obedience ring buildings. Short term crating allowed in the conformation ring building 10 minutes before and after ring times and only in the designated areas. Violators will be removed from the building immediately - this will be strictly enforced.

The Show Committee reserves the right to move, arrange or assign grooming setups in both the open and reserved grooming areas.

Please be considerate of fellow exhibitors and do not block the areas designated for loading and unloading. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.

Dog bathing facility available in the Southwest Motors Event Center locker room - warm water and bath tub available - look for the signs. Facility will be open from 6:00 am until 8:00 pm each day and exhibitors are required to clean up after bathing their dog(s). This area will be monitored at all times and exhibitors will be held responsible for non-compliance. Human bathing facility located in the SW corner of the Carnival lot or in the Horse Show area. Please see show committee member for directions

No space will be provided for unentered dogs at these shows. No unentered dogs or puppies will be allowed in the building. Failure to comply will result in charges being brought before the Show Committee.

Pursuant to Chapter 10, Section 3 of Rules Applying to Dog Shows, the show veterinarian shall have complete authority to excuse any dogs that have been admitted to the show which he/she considers may endanger the health of other dogs.

SCKC will not tolerate the double handling of any breeds by any person at any time. Any person who attempts to aid or to interfere with any dog in the ring may be subject to action by the Show Committee. The Show Committee reserves the right to make such other regulations as they may deem necessary (not to conflict with AKC rules) on the day of the show.

The use of foul or abusive language will result in a hearing of the Event Show Committee. Please obey all NO Parking and Handicapped Parking signs – violators will be towed at owner's expense.

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.

- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for the first entry and \$3.50 for each additional entry at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 5). A \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy. \$2.00 Event Service Fee will be required for each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
