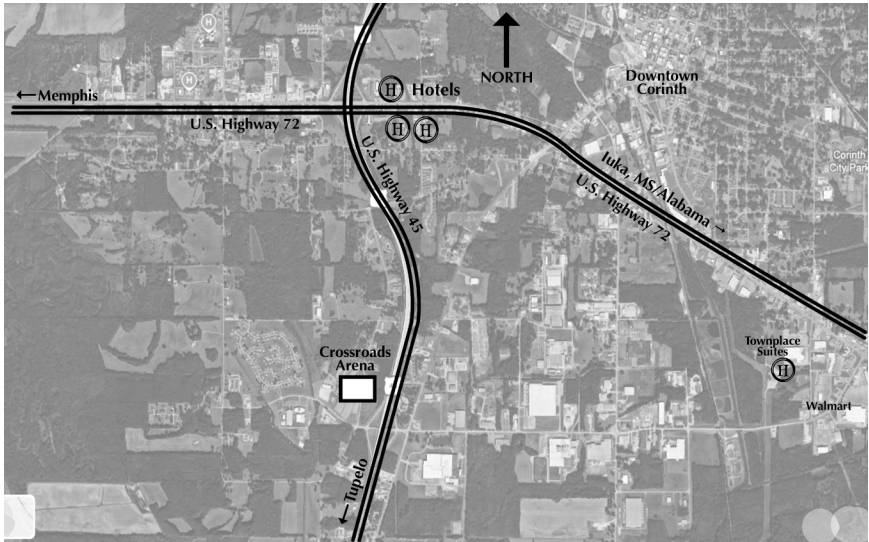

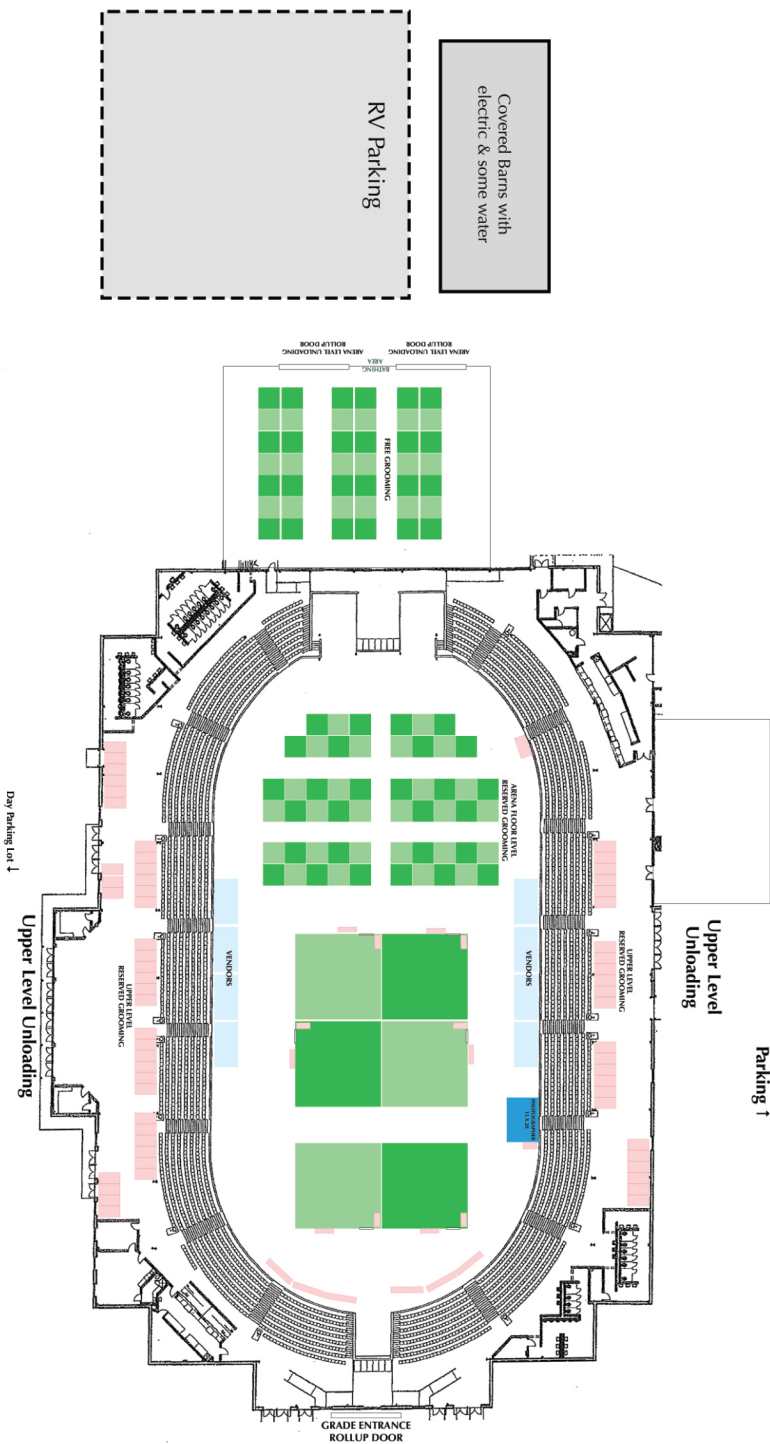

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition

The above classification is provided for all breeds (and varieties). Additional divisions, (i.e. age, color, or weight) are in the breed list and must be indicated on the entry.

Open Class Divisions

Retrievers (Labrador): Black, Chocolate, Yellow

Dachshunds: Open Miniature - 11 lbs. and under and 12 months of age or older; Open Standard - Any Other Eligible Dachshund.

Boxers: Brindle; Fawn

Doberman Pinschers: Black; AOAC

Giant Schnauzers: Black; Pepper and Salt

Great Danes: Black; Blue; Brindle; Fawn; Harlequin; Mantle; Merle

Boston Terriers: Under 15 lbs.; 15 lbs. & over

Collies (Rough): Blue Merle; Sable & White; Tri-Color; White

Shetland Sheepdogs: Sable & White; AOAC

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex. Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 yrs • Open Junior 9 & under 12 yrs

Novice Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs • Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 yrs

Novice Senior 15 & under 18 yrs • Open Senior 15 & under 18 yrs

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B- matches at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

- There is no elevator in the Arena. Please make arrangements to handle small flights of stairs for access to rings and grooming.
- There are both arena level access doors, and access doors to second floor for unloading to grooming.
- Dogs may be left in the building overnight on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights. All owners or handlers leaving dogs overnight in the building MUST leave a clearly visible card with emergency cell-phone contact information near the crated dogs. A guard will patrol the building and the RV parking lots throughout the night. However, the Cluster members assume NO liability for any animals or equipment left in the building overnight.
- Crates must be stacked. No private exercise pens in the building.
- Grooming is permitted only in designated areas. Observe all aisles as marked and keep them clear.
- For the convenience of exhibitors, crates and tables are allowed close to the conformation rings in designated staging areas 15 minutes before and after scheduled ring times and during the judging or for photographs.
- The Show Committee will tour grooming areas each morning and inspect crates. Any owner whose crates are soiled is subject to an Event Committee Hearing if not cleaned and taken care of immediately.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.
- Exhibitors should have a copy of their proof of rabies vaccination available upon request.
- Dogs may not be left unattended in vehicles, unless the vehicle is specially-equipped with adequate air-conditioning (e.g., motorhomes and recreation vehicles) and personnel, in accordance with current AKC regulations.
- All persons attending this Cluster hereby waive any claim for damages against Tupelo Kennel Club, Memphis Kennel Club, or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- All driveways must be kept open for access by emergency vehicles.
- No smoking in the building, covered arenas, dog bathing area.
- Leave flashers on while loading or unloading. No parking is allowed in the loading and unloading areas. 10 minute unloading strictly enforced.
- All RVs must park in the designated RV parking areas
- No parking on the grass
- Building will be available on Thursday at 2 PM, or after setup is complete
- For safety reasons no one, except for club members, vendors and Cluster staff, is permitted to bring equipment or dogs into the building until setup is complete.
- No saving of space for others is permitted. The Event committee will monitor excessive use of space in order to provide a good experience for all exhibitors.
- Building will be open at 6 a.m. prior to the events and will be locked at 10 p.m. on Thursday through Saturday nights.
- Mats or tarps are not allowed on the concrete in crating areas, except a stress-relief mat at each grooming table.
- Any dog displaying signs of illness (e.g., excessive coughing) will not be allowed in the building.
- Exhibitors are expected to observe all posted signs and to clean up after their dogs both inside and outside the building. Plenty of trash cans and waste buckets are distributed throughout the site. This is a SELF-CLEANING show! Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their setups.
- No private exercise pens in the building or in the North Parking Lot.
- Shavings or other comparable materials used in private exercise pens in the parking lots must be swept up, bagged and deposited in a dumpster prior to the individual's leaving the show. NO shavings or other comparable material may be placed on grass or dirt.
- Dogs must be removed from the building by 6 p.m. on Sunday night
- The show building will be open for Vendors at 9 a.m. Thursday.
- Please leave grounds in the condition that you found them. Place all trash in bags and deposit in the trash containers before leaving.

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

An AKC Event Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in an event. There is no Event Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.
