



A three point major to Reserve Winners Dog and Bitch if the Regular Class Dog and Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Specialty Show is held.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As Specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Variety if undefeated in any other class Veteran Classes. Open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older; neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in **Competitive Veterans Classes** at independent specialties. Veteran classes divided as follows: 7 years & under 9 years • 9 years and under 11 years • 11 years and older

Field Trial. Open to dogs or bitches that have placed in an AKC member or licensed field trial.

Dual Champion. Open to dogs and bitches that have earned both an AKC Conformation Championship as well as an AKC Field Trial Championship.

Per AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8, Field and Dual Champions may be shown if neutered or spayed.

BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (ADDITIONAL) INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

In accordance with AKC rule Chapter 11, Section 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch class. As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog Class - For stud dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud dog must be entered in the appropriate Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based upon their merits. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class - For two dogs of the same variety and at least one common owner. Dogs do NOT have to be entered in another class at this show. The entry forms must be marked accordingly in the space for Classes as Brace. If more than one Brace is entered by one or more common owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. Dogs comprising each brace must be named at time of entry.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Sweepstakes Eligibility: Any purebred dachshund, individually registered with AKC, 6 months and under 18 months of age and entered in a regular class at this show. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate 'Sweepstakes' and age division on the regular entry form under 'Additional Classes.'

Classes for dogs and for bitches, divided by coat variety:

Puppy, 6-9 months Puppy, 9-12 months Junior, 12-18 months

Best of Variety and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety (open to first place winner in each class to be judged separately in each variety).

Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes will be chosen from the Sweepstakes Variety and Best of Opposite Sex in Variety winners.

PARADE OF VETERANS (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

This non-competitive parade is open to any dachshund that is 7 years of age or older and not entered in any other class at the show. Please submit a short history (150 words or fewer) of your veteran with your entry form. This history, if within the correct number of words, will be included in the catalog and read during the parade. Histories longer than 150 words will not be in the catalog.

OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIALS

DCA will refund entry fees (less \$10.00) in Obedience & Rally for bitches who come in season after entries close provided a veterinary certificate is presented to the Show Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of regular judging.

Veteran: The Veteran Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least seven years old on the date of the trial.

Brace: The Brace Class will be for two dogs that are eligible under these regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person but will be handled by one handler. If more than one Brace is entered, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be designated "Brace No 1, Brace No 2," etc. Dogs comprising each brace must be named at time of entry.

Team: The Team Class will be for four (4) dogs & four (4) handlers that are eligible under these regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person. If more than one Team is entered, the dogs comprising EACH Team must be designated "Team No 1, Team No 2," etc. Dogs comprising each brace must be named at time of entry.

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

PURINA FARMS GUEST RULES

Grooming, Security and Overnight Crating:

The Event Center will be available to exhibitors Monday, May 11, 2026 starting at 9:00 am and continuing through 10:00 pm. Building Hours are 6:00 am through 10:00 pm Tuesday, May 12, 2026 through Friday, May 15, 2026. Building Hours for Saturday, May 16, 2026 are 6:00 am through 6:00 pm. *Dogs and all equipment must be removed from the Event Center no later than 6:00 pm Saturday May 16, 2026.* Dogs may be left overnight in the Reserved Grooming Room as there will be overnight security in the Event Center beginning Monday, May 11, 2026 at 10:00 pm continuing through Saturday, May 16, 2026 at 6:00 am. Any dog staying overnight in the building must have a notecard on its crate clearly displaying a cell phone number of the owners and/or handler in case of emergency. Guests may not be in the Event Center after the building closes for the night at 10:00 pm.

Property Access and Building Hours: The front Purina Farms entrance/exit gate is manned daily by a security guard from 6a.m. – 6p.m. to allow access to the property. Gates may be closed outside of these hours, but access to and from the property is still possible by pushing a call button at the gate or calling security at 636-221-1428 or 314-982-2217. The exit gate automatically opens to allow guests to leave.

Clean-up: Guests are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. This includes properly disposing of waste and using designated relief areas and the public x-pen area on the East side of the Gateway Hall for all elimination needs. Designated stations throughout the facility should be used appropriately (i.e. watering station should not be used for waste or other materials and bathing tubs should not be used for cleaning crates.)

Vehicles: Guests may not bring or use motorized vehicles on the property unless a medical condition requires the use of one. Documentation must be presented upon request by Purina Farms staff. An organization can rent motorized vehicles for use to help shuttle their participants around the property Golf carts may not be parked on sidewalks. Designated golf cart parking is available in the North parking lot of the Purina Event Center.

Vendors: Vendors must abide by all Purina Farms guest rules in addition to the guidelines outlined by the organization renting the facility. Vendors must start moving out of the event area at most 30 min after the end of the event. Vendor set-ups can't be left in the event area in-between events unless otherwise pre-approved by Purina Farms Manager. Vendor trailers must be parked in a designated parking spot.

Grooming: 20 amps of electric service available per assigned space. No grooming in the Great Hall - Day crating only. Rubber caps for the tables are available if tables appear they will damage the flooring.

Food and Beverage: Need to be purchased through the on-site food service and catering company. No outside food or beverage, or outside food service/catering company, is allowed on the Purina Farms property (unless organization receives written permission from Purina Farms management). Any violation will be reported to the AKC or the appropriate sanctioning entity of the event.

Crating: Crating in The Great Hall is determined by the organization hosting the event. It will not be dictated or enforced by Purina Farms. All crates must be on a solid type of matting that won't allow liquids or other substances to seep through on to the floor.

Dogs: No dogs are allowed, except for service dogs: in the Checkerboard Café, on the second floor of the Purina Event Center (unless given prior permission) and in any restroom or human bathing area. All dogs are required to be on-leash at Purina Farms at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged.) No dogs should be left unattended in the off-leash exercise areas or the public outdoor x-pens around the property.

Parking: No parking is allowed in the following areas: Fire lanes, inside either Hall (No vehicles are allowed to drive inside either hall) or on the sidewalks leading into either Hall except where loading and unloading is designated. In addition, no driving is allowed on sidewalks. Driving or parking on any grass at Purina Farms is prohibited. All guests must abide by the 15-minute unloading/loading parking time limit designated around the Purina Event Center.

Supplies: Duct tape may not be used in the building. Only painter's tape and gaffer's tape can be used on the floor and walls of the facility.

General: No helium balloons in either hall. Balloons can be used in the Founder's Room (with approval from Purina Farms management). No glitter, confetti or candles allowed in Purina Farms facilities. Public intoxication is prohibited at Purina Farms. Please drink responsibly. No exercise pens allowed around the front and back of the Purina Event Center or the grassy area adjacent to the East side of the Gateway Hall. Overall, exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged. Any exercise pens on designated grassy areas should not have a flooring/covering to prevent damage to the grass. Shavings may not be used on any grass around Purina Farms.

All organizations shipping items to Purina Farms should ship to "Purina Event Center Warehouse, 320 Checkerboard Loop, Gray Summit, MO 63039." Boxes must be clearly marked for the organization. Organizations ship at their own risk. Receiving charges apply.

All guests and their dogs must remain on the part of the property owned by Purina Farms. Trespassing on Purina Animal Nutrition property is forbidden. Purina Farms and Purina Animal Nutrition are not affiliated. Property map showing divisions can be provided upon request.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times when on the grounds (including the Purina Farms Visitor Center and especially on the balcony at the Purina Event Center).

Guests accept personal liability with respect to any claim made in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dogs or dogs in their possession.

No selling of puppies, kittens, dogs or cats on the premises.

Smoking, including the use of electronic cigarettes, is prohibited in buildings.

Weapons of any kind, illegal drugs and fireworks are not permitted on the premises.

Purina Farms logs all lost and found items and stores them in a locked area.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
