

There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex. Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B- matches at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

Master Class

Novice Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

Reserved spaces are limited on the main and especially the second floors. When the spaces on the second floor have been assigned, all other requests will be assigned spaces on the main floor.

The Batesville, MS Fire Marshal has specific requirements for the use of extension cords as follows: Exhibitors are required to provide their own extension cords.

Extension cords shall be a UL listed assembly (with tag) rated for the load connected:

- 1: Dryers plus equipment totaling 1500 watts or less require a UL Listed extension cord assembly rated for 15 amps.
- 2: Dryers plus equipment totaling more than 1500 watts require a UL Listed extension cord assembly rated 20 amps.

Each extension cord assembly shall terminate with a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) device for personnel protection.

Spot inspections will be conducted by the Batesville Fire Department for compliance with these requirements.

Non-compliance with these requirements could result in a citation from the Fire Department.

DOG DAYS OF SUMMER CLUSTER BATESVILLE CIVIC CENTER CAMPING

All sites will be assigned and marked by the camping committee on a first come, first served basis. There will be no prepaid reservations. Payment is required for overnight parking. **There are only 18 available Premier Parking spots with full hook-ups.** Full hook-up, 50 amp and generator sites will be assigned on a first come basis. A limited number of handicap sites are available. Upon arrival, handicap proof must be available. Full hook-up sites are the sites furthest away from the building; no handicap sites are available in the Premier parking spots with full hook-ups. Premium Parking is \$300.00 for 4 night minimum.

In addition to full hook-ups, there will be 8- 50 amp locations without water or sewer. They are allocated on a first come, first serve basis. The 50 amp charge is \$260.00 (minimum charge) for four (4) nights. **THE 50 AMP SPOTS ARE TO PARK VERTICALLY TO THE BARN BETWEEN THE LINES.**

Only one electrical plug per RV spot. If using more than one per RV spot, the charge will be for the number of plugs at the same RV rate.

When all hook-up and electrical sites are allotted, the assignment will be made in the general South Parking lot where there is no electricity or water. **All RV spots are assigned in the South Parking Lot Only. WHEN USING GENERATORS, AN EXHAUST EXTENSION IS REQUIRED.** The exhaust extension must be directed up as a safety precaution. **General RV parking without water and electricity will be a charge of \$20.00 per night-south parking lot only. No RV parking in the north parking lot.**

NO PARKING ON GRASS IN ANY AREA INCLUDING PREMIER SPOTS UNLESS PERMITTED BY SHOW STAFF.

There is space available for vehicles that will not be parked overnight at no charge in the North parking lot only - marked "Day Parking Only – Self-Contained and Box Trucks". (There is no charge for these areas). **NO EX-PENS ARE ALLOWED IN THE NORTH PARKING LOT.** Contact the RV parking attendant for directions for daytime parking of large vehicles.

All vehicles must be removed from the parking areas by 8:00 pm Sunday unless special arrangements are made for RV parking overnight on Sunday night.

Back by popular demand, last year many pups/dogs competed in the Ragtime Ratter introduction showing much promise and interest in ratting. Again, this year Ragtime Ratters, a BHA Club, is offering an introduction to the Barn Hunt Association novice course, a time for pups/dogs that have never met a rat and the opportunity to run a barn hunt course. PLUS, a wonderful time for pups/dogs with barn hunt titles to unwind after a demanding day!

Description: Barn Hunt: Ragtime Ratters Intro is a ratting event providing the pup/dog an opportunity to scent a rat cage/tube in a safe, fun, positive setting, an extra sensory experience. The introduction is designed to evaluate the pup/dog for his/her ratting/scenting instincts and to further their barn hunt career.

Eligibility criteria: Any size pup/dog may participate, 6 months or older.

Tubes: On course there will be one empty tube, one litter tube and one rat tube.

Course: Designed with multiple tiers of straw/hay and a tunnel in a 24' x 24' fenced area.

Rats: Hand raised and protected from injury.

Start times: 9:30 am – 4:00 pm, participants are encouraged to pay/sign-up; if a ring conflict, they may return to run up to 4:00 pm on the day of payment.

Rules: The handler and pup/dog will enter the start box; the time starts when the handler releases the pup/dog into the fenced area. After one minute, the handler may assist the pup/dog in locating the rat. The Judge may encourage the pup/dog to locate the rat and engage. The Judge calls the “find” and determines the official time when the pup/dog locates the rat no greater than 2-3 minutes. *(Note: some variation from BHA's official rules).*

Costs: \$10 per pup/dog, depending on your pup/dog; runs may be repeated at the same cost.

Location: In the covered arena/pavilion, on the west side of the convention center.

Participation ribbons are awarded on Saturday and Sunday for successfully locating the rat on the course.

This event is non-sanctioned by the BH Association and AKC.

Dog Days of Summer Cluster Rules

- No outside food or beverages may be brought into the Batesville Civic Center building, except items for babies. Of course, bait, food and water for dogs are permitted.
- No smoking in the building, covered arenas, dog bathing area.
- Leave flashers on while loading or unloading. No parking is allowed in the loading and unloading areas. **10 minute unloading strictly enforced. Exhibitors with small dogs and/or small amounts of loading equipment are encouraged to use the ramps at the East and West entrances (front & back of the civic center). Proceed from the entrances to the elevator at the southwest corner to go to the lower level for reserved grooming.**
- All RV's must park in the designated RV parking areas in the South Parking lot only.
- No parking on the grass
- RV Parking Lots are in the south parking lot only.
The show grounds for RV parking will be available until after **12:00 PM on Tuesday**. If you are arriving in the Batesville area prior to this date, you are directed to go to **John Kyle State Campground**, 27550 MS-315, Sardis, MS 38666, 662-563-4936. Another wonderful option for RV's is the **Roundabout Campground** (16 mile from Civic Center), 750 Hwy 6 West, Oxford MS Phone 662-371-0496. Roundabout Campground is a new luxury campground. Check their website at <https://www.roundaboutoxford.com/>
- Building will be available on **Wednesday at 2:00 PM, or after setup is complete**. For safety reasons no one, except for club members, vendors and Cluster staff, is permitted to bring equipment or dogs into the building until setup is complete.
- No saving of space for others is permitted. The Event committee will monitor excessive use of space in order to provide a good experience for all exhibitors.
- Building will be open at **6:00 AM** prior to the events and will be locked at **10:00 PM** on Wednesday through Saturday nights.
- Grooming is permitted only in designated areas. Observe all aisles as marked and keep them clear.
- **Mats or tarps are not allowed on the concrete in crating areas, except a stress-relief mat at each grooming table.**
- For the convenience of exhibitors, crates and tables are allowed close to the conformation rings in designated staging areas 15 minutes before and after scheduled ring times and during the judging or for photographs.
- Dogs may be left in the building overnight on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights. All owners or handlers leaving dogs overnight in the building **MUST** leave a clearly visible card with emergency cell-phone contact information near the crated dogs. A guard will patrol the building and the RV parking lots throughout the night. However, the Cluster members assume **NO** liability for any animals or equipment left in the building overnight.
- Any dog displaying signs of illness (e.g., excessive coughing) will not be allowed in the building.
- Exhibitors are expected to observe all posted signs and to clean up after their dogs both inside and outside the building. Plenty of trash cans and waste buckets are distributed throughout the site. Please immediately notify a member of the Event Committee or a member of the Custodial Crew, if liquids need mopping.
- Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining clean conditions in and around their setups.
- No private exercise pens in the building or in the North Parking Lot.
- Shavings or other comparable materials used in private exercise pens in the parking lots must be swept up, bagged and deposited in a dumpster prior to the individual's leaving the show. NO shavings or other comparable material may be placed on grass or dirt.
- Dogs must be removed from the building by **6:00 PM on Sunday night**.
- See additional rules and notices under **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS and Special Instructions**.

Please leave grounds in the condition that you found them. Place all trash in bags and deposit in the trash containers before leaving. The Batesville Civic Center provides an exceptional site for dog shows and we want to be able to continue using it in the future.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at **2:00 pm on Wednesday, or after setup is complete**. The show building will open for vendors at **9:00 am on Wednesday**, vendors should consult their contracts regarding specific move-in instructions and times. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

All vehicles must be removed from the parking areas by **10:00 pm, Sunday**, unless special arrangements are made for RV parking overnight on Sunday.

An elevator is located at the southwest corner arena. Access to and from the arena floor is marked with signs.

Dogs may be left in the building overnight. The security guard will be present in the building and will patrol the RV Parking area throughout the night. Exhibitors **MUST** leave a 3x5 Inch card with an emergency contact (cell) phone number prominently displayed near the dogs crated overnight. Building will be opened at **6:00 am** prior to events and will be closed at **10:00 pm** on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday nights. Dogs must be removed from the building by **6:00 pm on Sunday**.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

GROOMING will be in designated areas. No grooming will be allowed in any other areas of the buildings except the designated areas. All crates must be stacked. No private exercise pens in the building or in the North Parking Lot. Areas near and between the conformation rings are for temporary crating only.

The Show Committee will tour grooming areas each morning and inspect crates. Any owner whose crates are soiled is subject to an Event Committee Hearing if not cleaned and taken care of immediately.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.

Exhibitors should have a copy of their proof of rabies vaccination available upon request.

Dogs may not be left unattended in vehicles, unless the vehicle is specially-equipped with adequate air-conditioning (e.g., motorhomes and recreation vehicles).

All persons attending this Cluster hereby waive any claim for damages against Greater Shelby Kennel Club, the Kennel Club of North Mississippi and the Memphis Toy Dog Club or their members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5 to under 9 years of age at all shows offering Pee Wee. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian. Release forms will be available at the show.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word "judge" will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience - no Junior will be "judged" but rather will be mentored with the age appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation **Rosette** and each dog will receive a squeaky toy to commemorate the experience!

The Judge should explain the process of showing the dog to the Junior and the responsible adult in the ring including breed specific presentation. Depending on the size of the dog and the child, the adult may be asked to lift a table breed on or off the table, or the Club may mandate that the adult should do it regardless. Neither the youngster nor the adult should be asked to show the bite.

Entries close at the Superintendent's Office, **Noon, June 3, 2026** or when the numerical limit is reached. **On-site entries** will be accepted on Friday and Saturday until **11:00 am** at the Trophy Table or when the numerical limit is reached.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.

- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

An AKC Event Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in an event. There is no Event Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
