### From I-75: Heading South

Take Exit 143 (FL-78/Bayshore Rd. exit), towards North Fort Myers/Pine Island Rd./ Cape Coral. Keep left to take the ramp toward Lee Civic Center, turn left onto Bayshore Rd./ FL-78, Civic Center is 3.16 Miles on the left.

### From I-75: Heading North

Take Exit 143 (FL-78/Bayshore Rd. exit), towards North Fort Myers/ Pine Island Rd./ Cape Coral. Merge onto Bayshore Rd./FL-78 (merging to the right) Civic Center is 3.06 Miles on the left.

*To get into the park outside of those hours, PLEASE use Gate 2, 17634 Old Bayshore Road (not Bayshore Rd.)*

**WHAT'S NEW?** SCREWORM: All warm-blooded domestic animals originating from an Infested Zone and being imported into FL must be accompanied by an OCVI documenting that all animals listed on the OCVI have been treated by an authorized administrator with an effective treatment for NWS. The OCVI must (1) state "All animals listed on the OCVI have been inspected and are free from screwworm larvae infestation.", and (2) document the treatment provided, including treatment date, route of administration, and medication administered. The OCVI will be valid for five (5) days from the date of inspection. Any animal with non-infested wounds must have wounds topically treated with a product effective against NWS, and have documentation included on the OCVI. A FDACS Certificate of Animal Movement with permission number obtained at least two (2) days before the importation date is also required. (2) All warm-blooded animals originating from outside an Infested Zone but from an infested state or high-risk county must be accompanied by an official CVI (OCVI), valid for five (5) days from the date of inspection, and include the statement, "All animals listed on the OCVI have been inspected and are free from screwworm larvae infestation." (3) Rescue and shelter dogs and cats originating from states with confirmed CWS detections are prohibited from entering FL until further notice. NOTE: As of July 10, FDACS classifies the following TX counties as Infested Zone Counties: Andrews, Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Blanco, Brewster, Brooks, Cochran, Coke, Concho, Crane, Crockett, Dimmit, Duval, Edwards, Frio, Gaines, Gillespie, Hildago, Irion, Jeff Davis, Jim Hogg, Kerr, Kendall, Kimble, Kinney, LaSalle, Llano, Loving, Mason, Maverick, McMullen, Medina, Menard, Pecos, Presidio, Reagan, Real, Reeves, Runnels, Schleicher, Starr, Sterling, Sutton, Terrell, Tom Green, Upton, Uvalde, Val Verde, Ward, Webb, Winkler, Yoakum, Zapata, and Zavala; and the following NM counties as Infested Zone Counties: Chavez, Eddy, Lea, and Roosevelt. Updated date: July 10, 2026.

**FOR DOGS HELD OR CRATED IN THE BUILDING, YOU MUST PURCHASE A PAID GROOMING SPACE, BE IN THE DESIGNATED FREE GROOMING AREA, OR BE IN THE RINGSIDE AREA (30 MINUTES ONLY).**

**GROOMING AND CRATING** – Please understand that space is limited and we NEED to have all aisles clear of standing dogs, chairs and equipment.

There is **NO GROOMING or HOLDING OF DOGS ALLOWED** in the building except in designated Grooming, Crating or ringside areas. Limited free grooming space is available. Stackable crates only in Free Grooming area. Dogs may not be in the ringside areas for more than 30 minutes prior to and after judging. Dogs not immediately showing should not be brought to ringside. Crates, tables, equipment and chairs **MAY NOT** extend beyond the taped areas.

**WHAT'S NEW?** To accommodate our handlers/exhibitors needing extra space to crate dogs in air conditioning indoors, we have more than doubled our Free Grooming areas with some free grooming areas adjacent to the paid Grooming spaces. For those handlers/exhibitors needing extra space to keep crated dogs, please use the Free Grooming Space. In all Free Grooming areas, all crates must be stacked and each crate **MUST** have a label on it with the owner/handler's name and contact phone number. Show committee reserves the right to move crates and equipment to accommodate more exhibitors



**NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN THE BUILDING!**

**Please have crate tags on all crates with dog name, contact information and phone number.**

Dogs may be left unattended in your Reserved grooming area until 8:00 PM.

**Reservations will be given on a first come basis.** Indoor grooming spaces are LIMITED, so make your reservations early! You will receive an email confirmation of your reservation.

**You are responsible for keeping your grooming area clean. Please sweep up hair after you complete your grooming so that it does not blow to other areas of the building or grooming area. And don't forget to get rid of trash. We MUST keep the area clear of dog hair so that we are allowed to come back to the facility. ANYONE not cleaning up after their dog grooming may be subject to a Bench Show Hearing. PLEASE! THIS IS IMPORTANT.**

*There will be Puppy, Bred By Exhibitor, & Open Classes for each of the Miscellaneous Breeds in each sex. Puppy and Bred-By classes will be divided by age if all-breed classes are divided.*

Winners from these classes will compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each breed. Each Miscellaneous Best of Breed winner shall be eligible to compete for Best in Miscellaneous Class. All entries for Best in Miscellaneous Class shall be made after judging of the individual Miscellaneous breed classes. In the event that the owner of a dog designated Best of Breed shall not exhibit the dog in the Best of Miscellaneous Class Competition, no other dog of the same breed shall be allowed to compete. There shall be no further competition for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class. Ribbons shall conform to Chapter 5, Section 2 of AKC Rules.

## **Master Class**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - will be for boys & girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.**

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

**WHAT'S NEW?** The NOHS competition will be held in the p.m. Shows.

**TWO ALL-BREED SHOWS - SATURDAY PM • SUNDAY PM**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

**"DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE  
OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE  
ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING  
THIS COMPETITION."**



All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes. The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as*

**RAMP OPTIONAL BREEDS:** At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including group and Best in Show judging.

## 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition (Each Day)

### Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

### Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed, or member dog shows or conformation B matches at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.

- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

An AKC Event Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in an event. There is no Event Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis. Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
