## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS

- Business casual attire acceptable as it can be hot.
- Cars, Vans, SUVs should park at **least 6 ft. away from each other.**
- RV's should park at **least 15 ft. away from another vehicle** and face same direction in their area.
- Overnight parkers refer to **Reservation Form**; arrivals must be by **9:00 PM** for setup due to darkness.
- Electricity is not available on the site nor are there sewer hook-ups.
- **Quiet time** - generators are to be shut off between **11:30 PM** and **6:30 AM**. Exceptions are at the discretion of the day's Show Chair.
- Canopies (**Pop Up Tents**) are not permitted outside of Parking areas in respect to any possible storms.
- This is a self clean-up weekend. You are required to take care of your business.
- No grooming tables, exercise pens permitted under the tents housing rings.
- If crates are necessary for multiple entries from the same handler, they should be brought near the ring no sooner than 15 minutes before the breed's judging, placed as far as possible from the judging and removed from the tent within 15 minutes upon completion of that breed's judging. Otherwise crates are not permitted under the tents housing the rings in respect of all exhibitors.
- Smoking is not permitted under the tents housing the rings or the covered all-breed grooming area.
- Club Officers, Show Chairman and Chief Ring Steward will not exhibit dogs at these events.
- The health, safety and life of any dog on the grounds is paramount to other property and privacy rights. All vehicle owners on the grounds waive their right to legal actions or damages should it be necessary to rescue dogs from the confines of an overheated vehicle.
- The Irish Setter Club of Ohio reserves the right to substitute any non-available trophy with one of equal or greater value.
- Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the single dog entry class at Independent Specialties. The winner of each of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed, if not previously defeated.

**Veteran Class:** Class for dogs and bitches that are seven (7) years old or older on the day of the show

**Hunting Class:** Class for dogs and bitches that have achieved the ISCA, VC, VCX titles or the AKC Junior, Senior or Mater Hunter Titles

**Field Trial Class:** Class for dogs and bitches that have placed in a REGULAR stake at an AKC member or licensed Field Trial, other than puppy

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**STUD DOG CLASS** is for Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require it's disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules. AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS** same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get where appropriate.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class

A castrated male may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

## Sweepstakes

The Irish Setter Club of Ohio sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters, who on the day of the show will be six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes classes MUST also be entered in a regular class. The Sweepstakes will be judged after the morning regular classes and prior to the afternoon regular classes

## Veteran Sweepstakes

The Irish Setter Club of Ohio Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters who on the day of the show will be seven (7) years of age and over. Veteran Sweepstakes entries need not be entered in a Regular Class. The Sweepstakes will be judged after the morning regular classes and prior to the afternoon regular classes

### SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS

#### VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

*The Following Classes Are Offered For Dogs and Bitches*

75% of the Total Entry fee for the Sweepstakes will be divided as follows:

(Except in a class where there are not four entries, in which case the money set aside for prizes not awarded will be added to the 25% of the entry money, all of which will be used for expenses of the Sweepstakes)

### THERE WILL BE COMPETITION FOR:

#### Best Bred-By-Exhibitor (AM Show)

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will elect a Best Bred-by-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of breed Competition on judging unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor Class are eligible for the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

#### Best Puppy (PM Show)

During the course of Regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Class winners of the 6 mos and under 9 mos and the 9 mos and under 12 mos. classes. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition judging unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. **Example:** an entry from the Puppy Classes is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dogs undefeated in a Puppy Class are eligible for Best Puppy Competition. If the first place winner is not present, the second place winner may not compete.

#### Awards of Merit

At the judge's discretion, up to three Awards of Merit may be awarded. The designation of an Award of Merit acknowledges that the Irish Setter was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed and indicates recognition of an exceptional animal who could on another day, merit a top award.

### **Points For Reserve Winners Dog or Reserve Winners Bitch Available**

The Irish Setter Club of Ohio awards at its Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winner's Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Specialty is held. The Irish Setter Club of Ohio awards at its Specialty a three point major to Reserve Winner's Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five point major in the division where the Specialty is held.

### **Master Class**

**Novice Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**Open Class** - shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**Master Class** - will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

# AKC® Code of Sportsmanship and Civility

Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884—the year the American Kennel Club (AKC®) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

An AKC Event Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in an event. There is no Event Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes, or Special Attractions. A \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each entry in 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy and each entry in FSS Open Shows. These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**RETURNED CHECKS / INVALID CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check and credit card. Subsequent returned checks and credit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refunds made for cancellation of entries before the closing date will be subject to a \$3.00 administrative/processing fee per entry.

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

**The show giving club, the Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.**
